<i>Module or subject you score well, and the factor(s) that contributed to the outcome?</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • "I believe the reason I was able to score well for these mods were because I <u>had a genuine interest</u> for what was being taught which made me read up more about the subject, allowing me to have a better understanding." • "<u>I took time to practice more</u> and also to clarify my doubts, which allowed me to understand better." • "I believe that the factors that led me to doing well for my modules previously, were <u>interests and the teaching delivery of the educator</u>, and they often go hand in hand."
