The Singapore-MIT Alliance (SMA) Graduate Fellowship at SMART provides:

- Up to four years of **full tuition** at the student's home university;
- a monthly stipend of **S\$3,200**;
- a scholarship allowance of up to **S\$12,000** to help cover the expenses associated with a six month research **residency at MIT**;
- and **co-supervision** by **MIT** and **NTU/NUS** faculty.

There is NO bond associated with this fellowship.

In order to be eligible for an SMA Graduate Fellowship, a student must:

- have graduated with an undergraduate degree with first class or second-upper (or equivalent);
- be an incoming PhD student not currently matriculated;
- have a research interest that fits within one or more of the projects currently being carried out in SMART Interdisciplinary Research Group (IRG)s:

- ❖ **BioSystems and Micromechanics (BioSyM)**
- ❖ **Center for Environmental Sensing and Modeling (CENSAM)**
- ❖ **Future Urban Mobility (FM)**
- ❖ **Infectious Diseases (ID)**
