- Preparation for PhD



## **COURSEWORK MASTERS**

- Chinese Studies
- ELL: Language Studies, Literary Studies
- Southeast Asian Studies (including JDP with ANU)
- Psychology: Master of Clinical Psychology, JDP with University of Melbourne
- Econs: Applied Economics
- Social Work: Master, Graduate Diploma



### **RESEARCH PROGRAMMES**

#### <u>Masters</u>

- Minimum 4 modules, includes Graduate Research Seminar
- Modules at 5000/6000 level
- ≤ 25% MCs may be at level 4000
- Thesis (max 30,000 words)

#### <u>PhD</u>

- Minimum 6 modules , includes Graduate Research Seminar
- Modules at 5000/6000 level
- At least half of modules must be at level 6000
- ≤ 25% MCs may be at level 4000
- Thesis (max 80,000 words)

Note that there are minimum requirements to meet for continuation & graduation

### **Admission Requirements:**

- An Honours Degree (at least 2<sup>nd</sup> Class Upper) or Equivalent in a Relevant Discipline
- Research Proposal (for Research Programmes)
- Academic References





### **Financial Assistance Schemes**

Scholarships (Phd & Masters): NUS Research Scholarship (\$1,500 - \$2,500 Monthly Stipend)

NUS Graduate Scholarships For ASEAN Nationals (\$1,350 Monthly Stipend) for Candidates Pursuing Designated Masters Coursework Programmes. (Only for Citizens or Permanent Residents of ASEAN except Singapore)

### **Financial Assistance Schemes**

 A limited number of Graduate Tutor Assistantships/Graduate Researcher Assistantships which cover tuition fees\* and provide a monthly salary of \$1,800 (GTA)/\$1,500 (GRA) (CPF payable for Singapore Citizens and Permanent Residents) will be awarded to research students.

- Salary, not scholarship
- Renewable each year





### **Additional Support**

#### Fieldwork:

- Covers Airfare, Daily Allowance & Other Research-related Expenses
- Up To S\$3000 For MA Students (Overseas) Or \$1500 (Local)
  Travel Grant for Conference Attendance or Participation:
- MA: up to S\$2,000 per candidature (Competitive)
