Jan to Mar (3 Months)	<p>Community Attachment</p> <p>Learning Outcome:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To understand community leadership through community attachment with PAYM’s network i.e. Youth Executive Committees, Youth Chapters and Teens Network Clubs • Co-organise a project with community attachment mentors to gain hands-on experience in serving the community <p>Note: This community attachment is different from internship. Participants are not required go to the organisation every day.</p> <p>In terms of commitment, participants are required to attend monthly meetings organised by community attachment mentors and help out at events organised by their mentors. During the attachment period, participants are required to co-organise a project with their mentors as well.</p>
Feb	<p>D.I.S.C Workshop at NACLI</p> <p>Learning Outcome:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Understanding yourself and others using DISC
Mar (0.5 Day)	<p>YOUTHSpeak on Budget 2014</p> <p>Learning Outcome:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Participants will gain insight on the budget initiatives and discuss issues concerning youths with fellow participants
Mar	<p>Sharing of Experiences and Graduation Ceremony</p>
