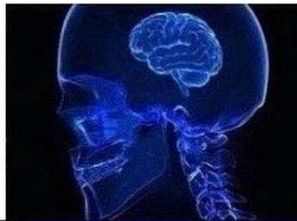


There's a double meaning to this meme as we do not know the identity of the doctor - could be Nagel or a physicalist:
