Amidst increasing societal expectations of public health coverage for new and often expensive health technologies, the Leadership Development Programme (LDP) aims to provide senior regulators, health policymakers and practitioners a comprehensive perspective of applying health technology assessment (HTA) to advance universal health coverage (UHC). Topics covered will include priority benefit setting, value tools to generate evidence to improve efficiency and equity in UHC policies, engaging with the private sector and pricing negotiations. This LDP will be supported by case studies including funding for dialysis, digital therapeutics and vaccinations, and involve site visits in Singapore to leading health systems and innovator organisations. Subject experts from renowned institutions such as the World Health Organization, United Nations Development Programme, Ministry of Health, Singapore, London School of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine, Imperial College London and Saw Swee Hock School of Public Health will also share their invaluable experiences with you.

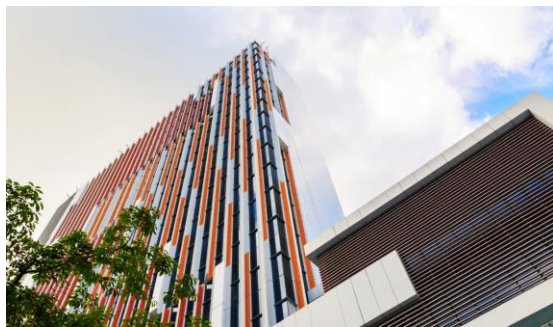
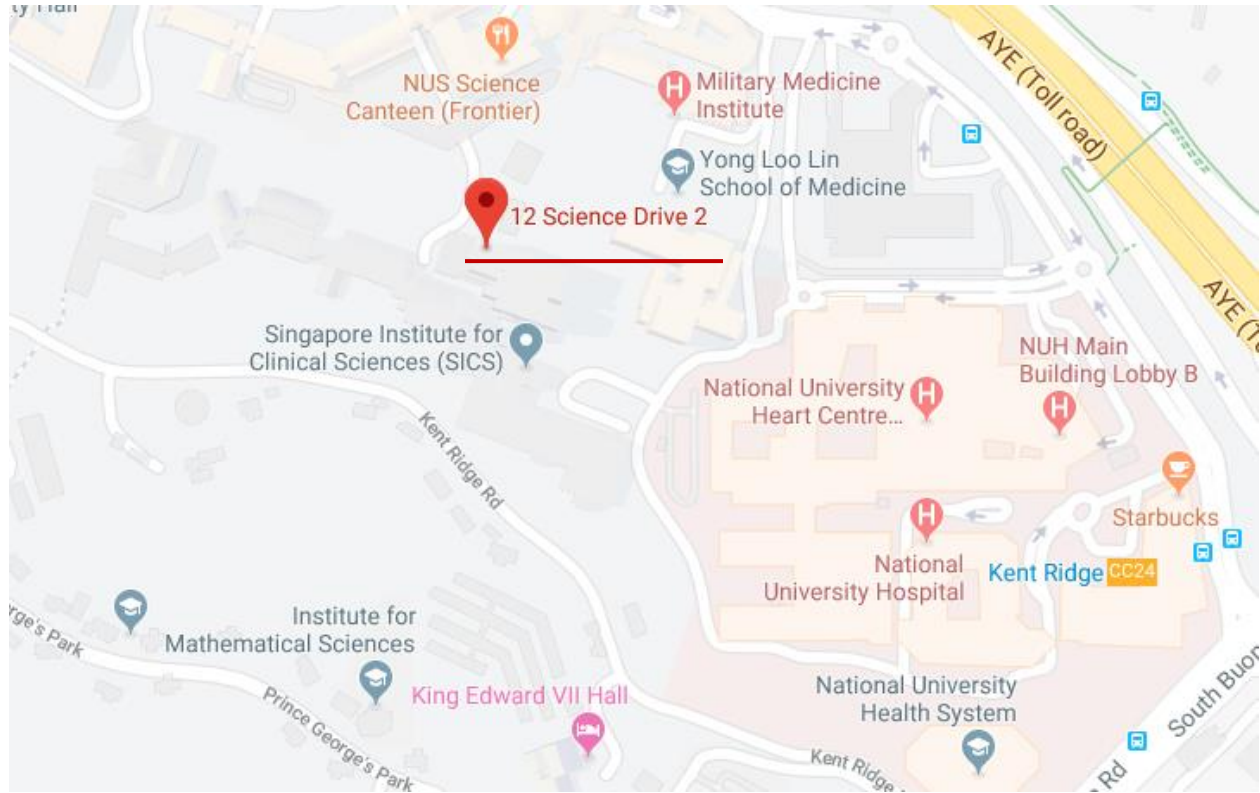

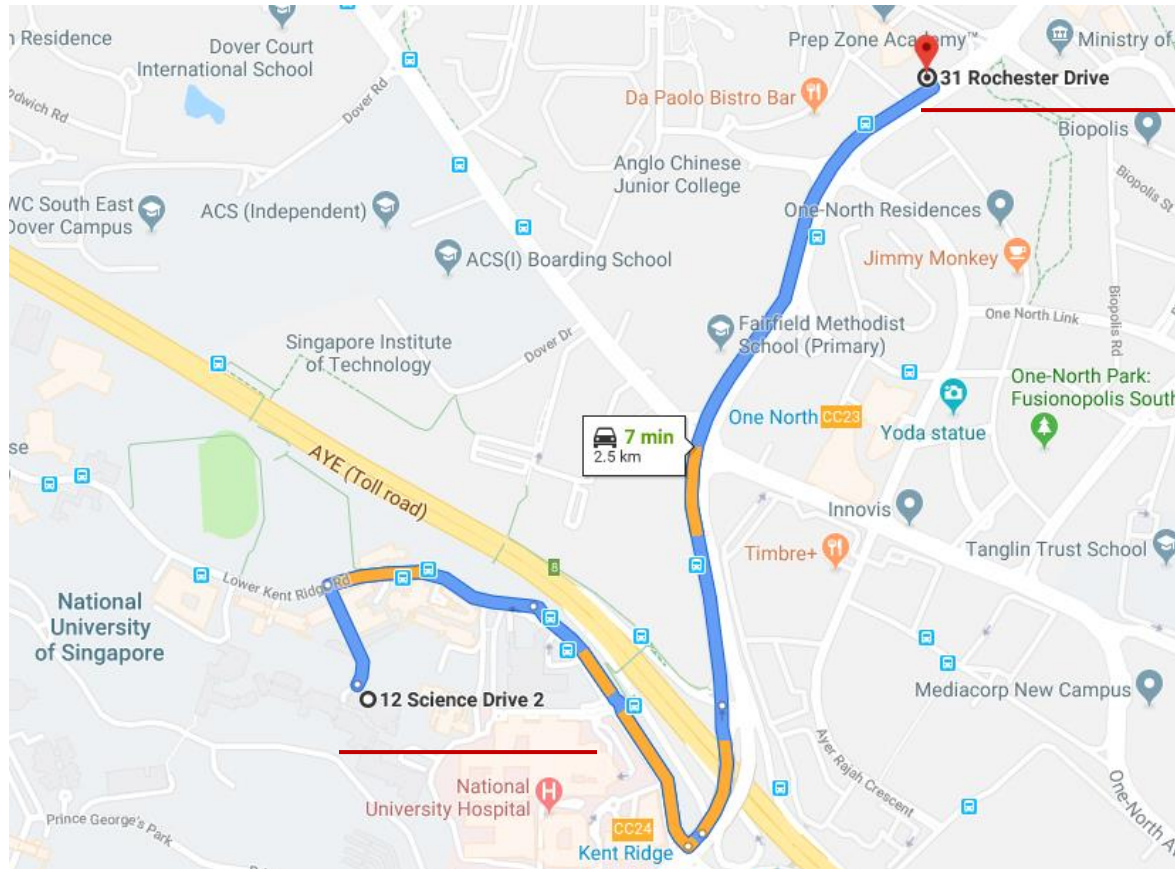
How to get there?
