


Ideas in Mathematics: Embedding Behavioral Supports



Many students experiencing mathematics difficulty tend to struggle with paying attention and may not be focused on the math to the extent needed to learn and be successful.

Embedding behavioral supports can help...



Procedures

- Reinforce the behavior you want to see
 - Operationally define the behavior
 - Communicate the definition and expectation with the student
 - Collaboratively decide on a reinforcer




There is no such thing as a universal reinforcer. Take time to find out what your student needs for reinforcement!

Example Strategies


Keep a Tally

Students can earn tally marks for desirable behaviors and completing tasks and are rewarded after a period of time based on the number of points.



Puzzle Pieces

Students can earn puzzle pieces for following expectations and completing tasks and are rewarded when the puzzle is complete.
