

ETA:

Three recommendations are required for this application. Recommenders should be able to speak to your ability to teach English in a classroom and adapt to living and working abroad based on your intellectual, professional and personal preparation. Those you select to complete the recommendation form should be able to speak about your preparation for Fulbright based on observing your work as a teacher, mentor, leader or student in the classroom, at your job (if your job deals with your ability to lead, manage, or teach), or you in a community engagement or volunteer setting. **At least one** recommender needs to be non-academic, such as a coach, supervisor, or mentor.

They cannot be related to you. They must write in English (if you are asking someone from abroad, then have them translate their letter into English or have another official translation which means done by someone who is not you).

For this grant, recommenders complete an online recommendation form through the Fulbright portal. Once you have identified your recommenders, you will input their information into the Fulbright system to generate the form. The Office of Nationally Competitive Awards will keep your recommenders apprised of internal and external deadlines for submitting completed recommendation forms.

Study/Research:

This grant requires **three** letters of recommendation. These formal, academic letters should be written by individuals who have worked with you in academic or professional settings and can speak to your qualifications and ability to carry out the research project or program of study that you have proposed. Recommenders should also be able to speak knowledgeably about your ability to positively represent the US abroad.

They cannot be related to you. They must write in English (if you are asking someone from abroad, then have them translate their letter into English or have another official translation which means done by someone who is not you).

Once you have identified your recommenders, you will input their information into the Fulbright system. The Office of Nationally Competitive Awards will keep your recommenders apprised of internal and external deadlines for submitting letters of recommendation.
