Urban Design?

This package of patterns can be used as a guide for many urban design problems. Good urban design consists of many elements. These elements work together to produce form. What is attempted here is a guide for designers to use to overcome urban design problems.

This package is to be used in the following format:

- Locate your design problem from the [Urban Design Problem Index](#).
- View the image of good urban form for your design problem and take note of the elements contained in the image.
- Click on any element in the image and learn why that element is needed to achieve good urban form.
- Scroll down the page and read about the elements that are needed for good Urban design.

The index contains many possible urban design problems. Chose your problem and view a possible solution to overcome your design problem. The solution lies in the elements of the selected problem. The answer lies in the combination of different patterns. The patterns will demonstrate that good urban designs contain many elements which the built environment must contain.
