Instructions

I) Submit completed application along with an Abstract or Artist's Statement

An **abstract** (up to 500 words) is a succinct overview of your project and should address the following:

- 1) identify the challenge/problem you are seeking to explore/solve
- 2) put your work in context and briefly reference previous work in this area
- 3) briefly explain fundamental terms or information needed to understand your project
- 4) your approach or methodology to pursue your research or creative inquiry
- 5) your research or creative/artistic outcome
- 6) *optional*: include a link or image as needed to support your project abstract

An **artist statement** (up to 500 words) is a succinct overview of your project and should address the following:

- 1) Content consisting of main themes or issues
- 2) Formal description of the work
- 3) Historical, theoretical, and/or cultural precedents and inspiration for the work
- 4) Description of materials and/or techniques and how these relate to and support the content of the work
- 5) How the individual work or series function together to create a body of work as a whole

II) Registration Confirmation Once the application is approved, both the student and faculty mentor will receive confirmation that the student is registered to present at the Spring Undergraduate Research and Creative Inquiry Days on either **Tuesday, May 2** or **Friday, May 5** (based on student preference indicated in this application).
