


## Daily Coronavirus Student Screening

For **Parents/Guardians**, please complete the student screening on behalf of your child to assess their ability to physically report to school.

This screening **must be completed daily** by students or their parents prior to arriving at a bus stop or, if driven, arriving on school grounds.


Using an Internet browser please navigate to the **PowerSchool Portal** login page.

**Daily Coronavirus (COVID-19) Student Screening Form** English

This screening must be completed daily by students or their parents prior to entering school buildings.

Please answer the following questions on behalf of SAMPLE, STUDENT to assess their ability to physically report to school. If you answer YES, then STUDENT must be kept home. The parent/guardian must immediately report their status to the attendance secretary following normal procedures for reporting absences.

**Risk Factors**

1. Has STUDENT tested positive for COVID-19 in the last 14 days?
2. Has STUDENT knowingly been in contact with or had exposure to anyone in the past 14 days who tested positive for COVID-19 or has/had symptoms of COVID-19?
3. Is STUDENT waiting for results of a COVID-19 test that was administered because they were experiencing symptoms or were exposed to or in contact with someone who is COVID-19 positive?
4. Does STUDENT have a temperature of 100 degrees or higher?
5. Is STUDENT experiencing any flu or flu-like symptoms including but not limited to, acute respiratory illness, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, fatigue, fever, chills, sore throat, muscle aches or pain, nausea or vomiting, diarrhea or loss of smell/taste?
6. Has STUDENT traveled internationally or to a state which currently has a travel advisory issued by New York State in the last 14 days? See link: <https://coronavirus.health.ny.gov/covid-19-travel-advisory>
