
THE NATURAL MINOR SCALE PATTERN

As you know, the pattern LA Ti Do Re Mi Fa Sol LA is called the Natural

Minor Scale. LA is the key center. LA is home base.

Just like the Major Scale (and other scales), the Natural Minor Scale is made up of a combination of half steps and whole steps. The order in which the half steps and whole steps appear is different in each kind of scale. The Natural Minor Scale sounds different from the Major Scale because the order in which the half steps and whole steps occur is different.




The pattern of the Natural Minor Scale is:



Remember, Ti-Do and Mi-Fa are always each a tiny interval of a half step.
