Using Our Partner Libraries

Healey Library patrons have several options for connecting with additional library networks and accessing a broad array of research materials:

Boston Library Consortium (BLC)
On-site borrowing privileges at Boston-area academic libraries with a BLC card. Apply for a BLC card at Healey Library’s Circulation Desk.

Boston Public Library (BPL) eCard
Any resident or student in the state of Massachusetts may apply for a BPL eCard and access BPL’s electronic resources remotely. Upgrade to a full BPL card for even more resources.

Electronic Books
The library subscribes to a wide range of scholarly eBook collections. Find eBooks in the Healey Catalog by entering your search terms, then selecting eBooks from the drop-down menu labeled "Filter Your Results." You may also search or browse individual eBook collections from our eBook Research Guide: umb.libguides.com/ebooks

Print Books
Search the entire book collection (along with videos and print journals) through the Healey Library Catalog. The majority of our print books are housed in the Main Stacks on the 8th and 9th floor of the Library. umb.edu/library/catalog

Use the Library's *Full Text Finder* to search or browse thousands of electronic journal, magazine, and newspaper titles to which the Library subscribes. umb.edu/library/journals

Print Journals
The Library maintains a legacy collection of print journal titles on the 6th floor. Use the Healey Library Catalog to search for a journal and select *Journal Title* from the pull-down menu labeled "within." umb.edu/library/catalog

Film & Media
