Samuel Kortum is the James Burrows Moffatt Professor of Economics at Yale University, Fellow of the Econometric Society, and Member of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences. He serves as Director of the Cowles Foundation for Research in Economics and on the Board of the NBER. Before joining Yale, he was a professor at Boston University, the University of Minnesota, and the University of Chicago where he was an editor of the *Journal of Political Economy* from 2008-2012. Kortum received his bachelor's degree from Wesleyan University and Ph.D. in Economics from Yale. He and long-time collaborator Jonathan Eaton were awarded the Frisch Medal in 2004 for their paper "Technology, Geography, and Trade" published in *Econometrica*. In 2018 they received the Onassis Prize in International Trade. In addition to international economics, Kortum has published research on economic growth, innovation, and firm dynamics.
