





I sing with my class about the lion.




We sit in our seats because our teacher is ready to start the class.

The teacher reviews the schedule for the day.







My teacher calls me to the front of the classroom to find my name tag.




We talk about the weather and use a calendar to find the date.




The teacher asks us math questions during the lesson.
