Hurricane season begins on June 1st and ends on November 30th. Broward College has a multi-layered alert system approach to emergency communications should a storm threaten South Florida. The [Broward College Alert](#) system (**BC Alert**) is used to distribute emergency notifications and includes telephone calls, emails, text messages and social media posts. For the **BC Alert** system to be most effective, users should review their contact information and update, as necessary. You can do it from the above link.
