

# ACCIDENTS

- ❖ Report any injury or accident to Campus Safety at 954-201-HELP (4357)
- ❖ If it is an emergency, use the Emergency Phone located in the lab room on the instructor's counter.
- ❖ Report the incident to the Laboratory Manager and Associate Dean.
- ❖ First Aid/Burn Kits are by the telephone in the prep room.
- ❖ Emergency Spill Response Equipment and PPEs are located in each laboratory room in the labeled cabinet. Fire blankets and extinguishers are located in each lab and prep room.



# ACCIDENTS CONTINUED

## Exposure to a Hazardous Chemical

- ❖ Eye Contact – flush with water for 15 minutes.
- ❖ Skin Contact – remove contaminated clothing and immediately get under shower.
- ❖ Inhalation – get the victim to fresh air and restore normal breathing.
- ❖ Ingestion – consult the SDS to determine whether to “dilute” the chemical, or induce vomiting.
- ❖ Get medical attention immediately.

\*Safety Showers – 30 gallon per minute minimum flow for at least 15 minutes.

\*Eyewash Fountain – 0.4 gallon per minute for at least 15 minutes.
