



School of Archaeology in Abruzzo (Italy)-summer program 2022

Dear colleagues,

<u>Application is now open</u> for the international School of Archaeology in Abruzzo (Italy)-2022 summer program, organized by University of Pisa (Italy).

The Archaeological summer school in Abruzzo is a part of a multi-faceted research program that aims to reconstruct the history of human occupation in central Italy during the Neolithic period.

The school program arises from the desire to offer students, from all over the world, the chance to participate in current research, allowing them to live an important experience of personal and professional grow.

Our aim is to increase awareness and competencies of the students about archaeological and methodological issues through an intensive program:

- morning: field activities at Rio Tana, the most ancient Neolithic site of central Italy
- afternoon: field activities/ experimental activities/laboratories/surveys

During the school student will be involved in **experimental activities** focused on the manufacturing and use of Neolithic lithic products and could participate at **Surveys** organized with the aim to investigate the neighbour territory and the possible lithic outcrops used by the Neolithic groups.

School Partners: Superintendence of Archaeology, Fine Arts and Landscape of Abruzzo, ICCOM-CNR U.O.S. of Pisa and INGV of Rome.

To notice:

Every year the School of Archaeology organize a call for a financial grant: One of 1000 Euro grant, sponsored by the University of Pisa, is available to meritorious students from developing countries (defined by the World Bank).

To ask the grant is necessary:

- apply to the school
- send all documents required for the inscription
- send a cover letter where the student briefly explains the grant request.

The deadline for request grant is 18 March 2022

Name: School of Archaeology in Abruzzo (Italy)-summer program 2022

Where: the school will take place in the area of Fucino in Abruzzo, a region of central Italy

Dates: from July 10th to 30th, 2022

Deadline: April 8th, 2022

Costs includes: academic program, housing (shared rooms), meals, Resident Director, orientation, transportation to/from dig site, lab fees and official transcripts.
