Here in Georgia, our campus clubs have come together to

- Reached more than 5,000 students to help them register and turn out to vote in the federal and runoff elections! Young Georgia voters turned out in huge numbers! We saw a 14 percentage point increase from 2016 to 2020!
- Raised over \$730 for Panther pantry and got 240 petition signatures against anti-homeless architecture as part of our campaign against Hunger and Homelessness.

As an intern you will spend 10-15 hours a week attending trainings, recruiting volunteers, and working on projects and campaigns that will make your community better. You'll attend weekly trainings and run campaign events.
