INCORPORATING ITCHYQOL-MINI INTO
STANDARDIZED DERMATOLOGY OUTCOME MEASURE
FIHR APP

Up to 30% of Americans will have chronic itching. It is thus important to ask questions to ascertain how itch affects quality of life. A previous class has developed a FIHR app to incorporate standard dermatology outcome measures (SDoM) into a general dermatology visit. Patients are given a tablet with the SDOM questions, which are imported into Cerner. We propose to add itch-specific questions if patients are itchy. These questions are from a validated itch measure called the ItchyQoL.
