ROBUST PATIENT PORTAL

Some of the biggest complaints today by patients surround the disconnect that they feel between them and their practice along with the inability to access their data easily. Patient portals were supposed to be the solution, but by most accounts that has not proved to be the case. While a step forward in some regards, patient surveys still indicate a great disconnect in the patient experience. Furthermore, portals have sometimes proven to be too confusing for patients, or have just not provided enough longstanding value. As some studies have shown that while upwards of 83% have logged in and used portals before, only 25% of those patients would be inclined to use them again.

PROJECT OBJECTIVES

I really want a team to take this idea and run with it - no idea is too big in this case. I also would like some real outside the box thinking, so not merely looking at existing patient portals and thinking "how do I improve this", but rather "how do I make something fresh and new beyond the constraints of existing portals?".
