

Title: Distance Math Social Media Manager

Description:

Over 1,200 high school students from across Georgia enroll in courses through the Distance Math Program (DMP) every year. Students in this program complete courses while still in high school through distance education and through Dual Enrollment.

The DMP is seeking an undergraduate student who has a passion for social media marketing and distance education to help us promote our program to high school students across Georgia.

As a Social Media Manager you will work in a team of School of Math faculty members and student assistants to highlight DMP initiatives, events, milestones, and alumni.

As a Social Media Manager you will help us reach out to the high school student community to do the following.

- Engage with the GT campus and high school student communities to create social media content that highlights DMP initiatives, events, and milestones.
- Interact with DMP alumni who are current GT students to create engaging profiles of their accomplishments and the impact the DMP had on their education.
- Develop content that adheres to Georgia Tech's brand guidelines, including specific color palettes and fonts.
