

PTS Bicycle Helmet Sales

Definition and Purpose

Parking and Transportation Services (PTS) encourages students, faculty, and staff to travel to, from, and within campus using alternative transportation, including biking, to reduce traffic congestion, limit the need for automobile parking, and preserve the environment.

Helmet use is strongly encouraged for all persons biking on and to/from campus to improve the safety of biking on campus.

Rules and Regulations

- Helmets may be purchased by GT faculty, staff or students from PTS.
- Payment options are credit, debit, check or BuzzFunds.
- Helmets are available in medium and large sizes.
 - Medium fits head circumference (measured one inch above eyebrow) of approximately 21 to 23 inches, or 54 to 58 centimeters.
 - Large fits head circumference (measured one inch above eyebrow) of approximately 23 to 24 inches or 58 to 61 centimeters.
 - The helmets also have an adjustable knob in the back and adjustable straps.
- Helmets may be purchased Monday-Friday from 7:30 am – 5:00 pm at the PTS Customer Service Center, located at 770 Spring Street, Atlanta, GA 30332, inside the E81 Tech Square parking deck.

Restrictions

- Georgia Tech nor Parking and Transportation Services are liable for any incidents or injuries related to the helmets sold at PTS.
- No refunds will be issued on helmets purchased.
- The helmets are warranted by our supplier for one year from sale date. Contact information is available upon request (email commute.gatech.edu).
