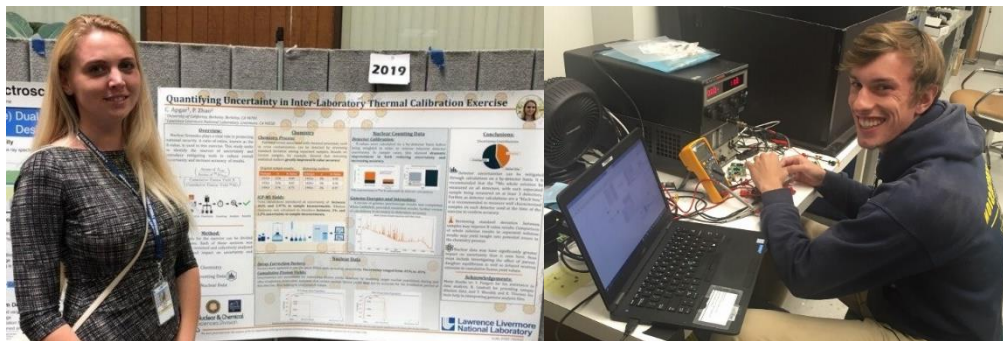


Summer Internship in Nuclear Science and Security



The Lawrence Livermore National Laboratory (LLNL) Glenn T. Seaborg Institute (GTSI) summer internship programs have offered graduate students the opportunity to engage in practical research experience to further their educational goals for over 20 years. The 2021 Seaborg Institute Nuclear Science and Security Summer Internship Program will give graduate students (and senior undergraduates) an opportunity to work at LLNL for 8 weeks, carry out research under the supervision of a staff scientist, attend a weekly lecture series, interact with other students, present their work in poster format at the end of the program, and meet Federal Sponsors from the Department of Defense's Defense Threat Reduction Agency (DTRA). The goal of this year's program is to facilitate the training of next generation scientists to solve critical national problems in the fields of nuclear science and security. **Note that this assignment is for a full-time position during the summer academic break and will be run remotely with limited in-person opportunities.**

This Internship Program is supported by DTRA which enables the Department of Defense, the United States Government and International partners to counter and deter weapons of mass destruction and improvised threat networks. Dates & Location: June 14 - August 6, 2021. LLNL is located in Livermore, CA - 40 miles east of San Francisco.

Requirements: The successful applicant must be a U.S. citizen and currently enrolled in a M.S. or Ph.D. graduate program or a senior undergraduate student. Applicants are required to submit a CV/resume and a 250 word statement of research interests. Application materials should be submitted via the link below. Students considered for the summer internship will need to provide 1 letter of recommendation, as well as their graduate/undergraduate transcripts upon request.

Financial support: LLNL offers a generous salary depending on year in school and reimbursement for travel to and from LLNL.
