

# Exploring the Egyptian Revolution of 2011

1

User clicks on the Egyptian protests story in the my channels page, which then shows the summary of the channel and gives a link to explore the storyline.

On launch, the storylines app starts playing the 1st video in the main timeline on the TV screen. No filters have been selected at this point. The popup bubble gives a short description of the video and shows the source from which the video comes (bbc in this case).

Now that the viewer has watched a couple of videos, she wants to go deeper into the story. The user then selects the filter for "Muslim Brotherhood". This brings up a storyline from the main timeline which contains only those bubbles which have Muslim Brotherhood associated with them.

The user then adds a few more filters to the current storyline. This results in more bubbles coming up on the storylines.

Now the user selects one of the bubbles in the 1st week of February. The popup for this bubble shows a basic summary of what events occurred on this day, and lists the sources from which video content is available.

User gives the storyline a name and saves it. The storyline shows up in the Playlists section at the bottom right.
