A few points about my expectations:

The notes can be in bullet format and have occasional typos. What I'm looking for is breadth and depth of the conversation. As a group, did you cover all of the assigned readings? Did you understand the material (or at least attempt to work through it together?)

Each of the statements don't necessarily identify who said what (although they can). Students will not receive individual grades for each meeting. You're allowed to have an "off" day where you don't contribute as much.

Instead, the bulk of an individual grade will be determined through the mid- and end- of semester reflections. This will give a general, semester-long impression of each group member's participation. If you chronically don't show up prepared, or don't contribute, or miss a meeting, it will show in your reflection.
