

**THEME:** PLANNING FOR THE FUTURE

**TITLE:** JOB INTERVIEW

**OBJECTIVES:**

1. To practice job interviewing.
2. To discuss body language and the messages we can send.
3. To discuss future career goals.

**MATERIALS:**

1. Paper and pencil to record.

**INSTRUCTIONS:**

1. Ask the group whether anyone knows what career they want in the future.
2. Ask students what they would wear to interview for a job in that career. Talk about body language.
3. Ask students what questions they think they would be asked at a job interview. Write down these questions
4. Ask a student to volunteer to be the interviewer (this student will read the interview questions generated from the group). Tell them you will be role playing an interview.
5. Role play the interview with you as the first applicant (you may want to do some things wrong for the students to catch).
6. Break from the role play and discuss what went well and what needs improvement.
7. Repeat the role play and incorporate the improvement suggestions.
8. Ask the students to role play themselves. Take turns having each be the interviewer and the applicant. After each role play discuss as a group what went well and what can be improved.
