- your proposal's title
- an abstract of no more than 250 words
- a short 50-word bio

Please review your name, affiliation, title and abstract for spelling and grammar.

If you wish to propose a panel with multiple papers, each presenter must submit a paper individually, noting as part of the abstract that it is part of a panel and listing the names of their co-panelists. Then the organizer should email jburg@svc.edu stating that you intend to present together.
