

**APPLICATION FOR ENGL 8100
DIRECTED STUDY**

ENGL 8100 – Directed Study is a course designed for specialized research for doctoral and advanced master’s students. The course should be designed in conjunction with an instructor, and the subject matter and/or critical approach should be in that instructor’s area of specialization. The Director of Graduate Studies must approve all 8100 applications. ENGL 8100 can be used to satisfy program area requirements.

Pleased be advised: Students in the MA programs will be limited to ONE Directed Study (8100); students in the MFA and PhD programs will be limited to TWO Directed Study courses. Under special circumstances, doctoral students may petition the graduate committee to take a third Directed Study, but under no circumstances may any student take four.
