## YOUR MEDICINE: Atenolol \_\_\_\_mg

<u>Why am I getting this medicine?</u> You have high blood pressure. High blood pressure is dangerous if not treated. It can cause strokes and heart attacks. You can die from having high blood pressure that is not treated.

**Take 1 tablet first thing every morning.** You do not have to eat before taking the tablet.

<u>What will I feel when I take this medicine?</u> Sometimes there are side effects from taking this medicine. A side effect is something you might feel that is not normal. Some side effects from taking Atenolol happen as your body gets used to the medicine and could include dizziness, nausea, hands/feet feeling cold, and lightheadedness.

Some side effects do not happen very often but can be very serious. Call 911 or go to the Emergency Room immediately if you develop: hives; swelling of the face, lip, tongue, or throat; have trouble breathing or, have severe dizziness.

## What else do I need to know?

- 1. You must take this medicine every day even if you feel well.
- 2. You must refill this medicine every month.
- 3. Do not smoke or use any tobacco product.
- 4. If you visit a different doctor's office, medical clinic, or the emergency room, you must tell them you have high blood pressure and are taking Atenolol.
