This livestock show will showcase the talents of special needs youth from across Angelina County. Participants will be paired up with their 4-H/FFA show buddy to exhibit their animal and walk away with the pride of knowing they can succeed in the show ring.

Q: What animals will be used?

A: 4-H and FFA buddies will volunteer their animals (goats, lambs, rabbits, pigs) for the purpose of the show. This will provide the buddy valuable community service experience, as well as the honor of helping the exhibitor be a part of something as special as the Angelina Youth Fair.

Q: Will there be an entry fee for exhibitors?

A: No

Q: How many exhibitors can be expected?

A: There will be a limit of 30 exhibitors. This will allow coordination of animals, prizes, and volunteers.

Q: What will the exhibitors receive?

A: Every exhibitor will be awarded a blue rosette ribbon and a t-shirt. They will also have the opportunity to have their photograph taken with the animal in front of the Youth Fair backdrop.

Q: What paperwork will be required?

A: Liability releases are a standard for all exhibitors involved in the Youth Fair, and will be used for this event. Other paperwork would include entry forms for the participants and volunteers. These entry forms are available online.

Q: When would the show take place?

A: The show will take place on Friday, April 19 at 3:00 in the swine show arena.
