STADIUM INFORMATION

- Location:* We are located at the intersection of 25th St and Twin City Hwy/Jefferson Dr.
- Address:* Port Arthur ISD Memorial Stadium

- Seating:* The stadium seats approximately 10,000 guests. Wheelchair accessibility and viewing are on both sides.
- Playing Field:* The playing surface is Field Turf. Rubber infill allows the surface to look and play like natural grass. Water drains through the field to provide an excellent surface during inclement weather. Players can use grass, rubber molded or screw-in cleats.
- Scoreboard:* The stadium features a regulation scoreboard with a state-of-the-art video board and sound system.
- Locker rooms:* The home and visitor team's locker rooms, officials dressing area and the athletic office is in the field house on the north end of the stadium
- Press box:* The press box is two levels which includes an elevator. Press/scouting area is located on the first level with a seating capacity of 20. Visitor coaches' room is located on the first level with a seating capacity of 10 each – Rm. 100. Home coaches' room is located on the second level with a seating capacity of 10 each – Rm. 201. We have Broadcasting/Radio Suites booths located on the second level with a seating capacity of 3 in each booth – Rm 207. Data lines are provided. The public-address announcer and scoreboard booths are located on the first level – Rm 103 with a seating capacity of 6 each. The open-air filming decks are located on the second level at each end of the press box.
- Parking:* Parking is free of charge
- Tickets:* **Home and Away tickets will be available for purchase online every Monday at 8:00am the week of the game until Friday at 3:30pm. The link is through hometown ticketing on Port Arthur ISD website. Click on quick links – tickets – get tickets next to the game you plan on attending and follow the steps.**

TICKETS WILL BE SOLD ON THE NIGHT OF THE GAME AT HOME AND VISITOR TICKET BOOTH STARTING AT 5:30PM.

FOOTBALL TEAM INFORMATION

- Buses:* Both team buses enter parking lot gate by the **Twin City Hwy/Jefferson Dr.** entrance and unload inside fenced area, north end of Memorial Stadium.
Team buses will park along the designated area beside the field house. The **home dressing room** is located on the northeast end of the field house. The **visitor dressing room** is located on the northwest end of the field house. Our management team or Police Officer will assist you in parking your buses. Video equipment and field communication can be moved to the press box by the elevator; located underneath the home side stands area. No sharp edge video equipment or table and chairs without a flat surface to sit on is allowed on the field. Training and field equipment vehicles will use the entry gate located in south end of the stadium to unload equipment. Vehicle will not be allowed to stay inside the stadium during the game. Our management team will assist and give guidance.
- Coaches:* Home and visitor coaching booths are located on the 2nd level of the press box. **Each team will provide their own headphones, Coach Comm. headsets will require the antenna to be placed outside the booth and the antenna wire to feed through the pass through in the wall. An antenna wire is available if needed.**
- Field Area:* Food, drinks, gum, **sunflower seeds**, gummy candy, red colored beverages, glass bottles, pop-up tents or tobacco **is PROHIBITED at all times** around or on the field areas.
Visiting team will warm up on the south end of field, home team on the north end.

BAND, DRILL TEAM, CHEERLEADERS AND OTHER SUPPORT GROUP INFORMATION

- Buses:* All auxiliary buses turn left at the 25th St. light and enter parking lot gate by the **25th Street** entrance and park on the south side of the stadium. Visiting team enters stadium through the southwest gate, and sits in section C. The home team enters stadium through the southeast gate and sits in section Q. Band equipment trucks and buses will be parked by our management team.
Because of the expected size of the crowd please ask your bands to not spread out so that we can give everybody in attendance a place to sit.
- Due to artificial turf, flaming batons, similar acts, or any type of equipment with sharp edges is prohibited on the field.
- During halftime ceremonies only, the band director and his assistant and the director of the drill team or designees are allowed in the Press Box – First Level - Rm 103.
- Half Time Activities: 28 Minutes. 14 min per school time limit.
- Signs:* No signs will be hung on the press box area. All signs must be removed at the end of the game. Tie on signs is preferred. Tape may be used but must be removed after the event and placed in trash cans. Students should refrain from using violent words including death or kill.

SCHOOL ADMINISTRATION INFORMATION

- Passes:* All district passes, will be accepted. We will admit the card holder plus one guest (not families)
All THSCA, THSADA passes will be accepted.



PORT ARTHUR I.S.D. MEMORIAL STADIUM RULES & REGULATIONS

Welcome to Port Arthur I.S.D. Memorial Stadium. It is our hope that you will find our facility safe and enjoyable, where we can all appreciate and applaud the efforts of each group.

Listed below are the rules and regulations we ask that you follow while in our facility. We do appreciate your observation of these guidelines:

1. Gates will open **60 minutes** to game time for spectators. The **home gates** are located on the northeast side of the stadium. The **visitor gates** are located on the northwest side of the stadium. **All Fans will be required to empty their pockets and go through the metal detectors.**
2. Spectators will not be allowed to leave the stadium and return once the game has started unless they have a valid reason.
3. State laws and school district policies will be in effect concerning alcoholic beverages and controlled substances.
4. No outside food, drink, backpacks, coolers etc. may be brought into the stadium; this does not apply to team, band, drill team or cheerleaders.
5. Food, drinks, gum, **sunflower seeds**, gummy candy, red colored beverages, glass bottles or tobacco **is prohibited at all times** around or on the field areas. **NO FOOD OR DRINKS ALLOWED ON THE FIELD**
6. The use of tobacco products in any form is prohibited on all school district property. (State Law)
7. Only emergency vehicles may be parked inside the stadium. No vehicles of any kind are allowed to drive on the field surface, including trailers and golf carts.
8. No loitering will be permitted. Spectators must sit in the stands and keep off the rails. Aisles should be always kept clear. **Students may not cross to the other side of the stadium.**
9. Live animal mascots are not allowed within stadium. Mascots are to stay on their side of the field up to the hash marks except for GSL presentation and halftime performance. Cheerleaders and members of uniformed groups can visit with the performing groups on the other side.
10. Releasing of balloons, **CONFETTI**, paper of any kind, **SILLY STRING**, powder, powder-like substance, or airborne items is **NOT** allowed on the field.
11. Air Horns and other artificial noise makers (excluding whistles) will be permitted.
12. Pop up tents are prohibited in the stands and on the field
13. No **BARBEQUE PITS, FOOD TRUCKS** or any type of outside equipment is allowed inside the stadium
14. Uniform student groups may form victory lines from each dressing room to entrance of the field.
15. Only authorized personnel will be allowed on the field or in the field house area before the game, at halftime, or after the game. Everyone must stay outside the player's box which is located from 25 yard line to 25 yard line.
16. **School photographers, newspaper reporters, and school video crews are not allowed in the bench area during the game. Boundaries are 25 yd line to 25 yd line unless walking through the team box to the other side.**

Only official press photographers or photographers representing school involved shall be permitted along the sidelines. These photographers are to bring letters with them of introduction from their principals or athletic directors. Letters may be exchanged at the ticket office for SIDELINE PASSES for the game involved. Only two student photographers from each school shall be permitted along the sidelines at any one time.

Ticket Booths: Open 60 minutes prior to the start of the game. The home ticket booth is located on the northeast side of the stadium and the visitor ticket booth is located on the northwest side of the stadium. **All fans must empty their pockets and walk through the metal detectors before entering the stadium. All bags will be checked.**

- Rules:**
- (1) No outside food, drink, backpacks, coolers, yeti cups, glass bottles etc. may be brought into the stadium.
 - (2) Releasing of balloons, **CONFETTI**, paper of any kind, **SILLY STRING** powder, powder-like substance or airborne items is **NOT** allowed on the field. Food, drinks, **gum**, **sunflower seeds**, gummy candy, red colored beverages, glass bottles or tobacco **is prohibited at all times** around or on the field areas. **NO FOOD OR DRINKS ALLOWED ON THE FIELD**

 - (3) Fans are not allowed in the dressing room area.
 - (4) No pop-up tents are allowed in the stands or on the field
 - (5) No barbeque pits, food trucks or outside equipment allowed inside the stadium.
 - (6) No smoking, tobacco use or vaping in or around the stadium.
 - (7) Law prohibits firearms, pocketknives and weapons of any kind.
 - (8) To re-enter the stadium, you must purchase another ticket.
 - (9) No spectators are allowed on the field at any time.
 - (10) Please keep the aisles at the concourse level clear.
 - (11) No standing or loitering in the concourse level and concession stand area
