### File Status Information

#### White cloud with blue borders icon

Indicates that the file is **only** available when connected to the internet.

#### White icon with green borders and checkmark icon

Files with this status badge mean the files are available offline, you can open them **without an internet connection, and they take over local storage space.**

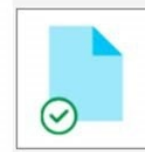
#### Solid green with a white checkmark icon

This badge is only on files marked as **"Always keep green check files on this device,"** which are always available.

### Enabling or disabling Files on Demand

Tap on the blue cloud in the bottom right corner of your **Windows device.** Next, tap on the **settings gear**, tap on settings, and under the **Sync and Backup menu** from the left, **scroll down to Advanced settings**, and **tap on the tick**, you will see the **Files on Demand feature.** For the settings to keep more documents in the cloud, **tap on the Free up disk space button.**
