Enabling or disabling Files on Demand

Tap on the blue cloud in the bottom right corner of your Windows device. Next, tap on the settings gear, tap on settings, and under the Sync and Backup menu from the left, scroll down to Advanced settings, and tap on the tick, you will see the Files on Demand feature. For the settings to keep more documents in the cloud, tap on the Free up disk space button.
