I. Outcome Measures Baseline Data

Using the codes provided in “HTN Outcome Measures Codes” (found at www.alpgc.org/htn under the “Data Resources” menu), ask your IT department to generate a report for the following two measures:

O2. SMM (excluding transfusion codes alone)

Denominator: All qualifying pregnant and postpartum people during their birth admission ____

Numerator: Among the denominator, those who experienced severe maternal morbidity, excluding those who experienced transfusion alone ____

O3. SMM among people with Preeclampsia (excluding transfusion codes alone)

Denominator: All qualifying pregnant and postpartum people during their birth admission with preeclampsia ____

Numerator: Among the denominator, those who experienced severe maternal morbidity, excluding those who experienced transfusion alone _____

▪ Time period: Reported as quarters

○ January – March 2022

Note denominators and numerators change with each race/ethnicity category:

▪ Ex: Measure O2. SMM by **Native Hawaiian/Pacific Islander**:

○ Denominator: All qualifying pregnant and postpartum **Native Hawaiian/Pacific Islander** patients during their birth admission

○ Numerator: Among the denominator, all **Native Hawaiian/Pacific Islander** patients who experienced severe maternal morbidity, excluding those who experienced transfusion alone
