Emergency Department Guide

Ask women ages 15-45 years if they have been pregnant in the 6-8 weeks.

If yes, add postpartum complications to your differential.

Patients who delivered within the last 6-8 weeks are at risk for postpartum complications, including :

Hemorrhage

Preeclampsia/Eclampsia

Infection/Sepsis

Cardiomyopathy

Embolism or Stroke

Mental Health Disorders

Substance Use Disorder/Overdose
