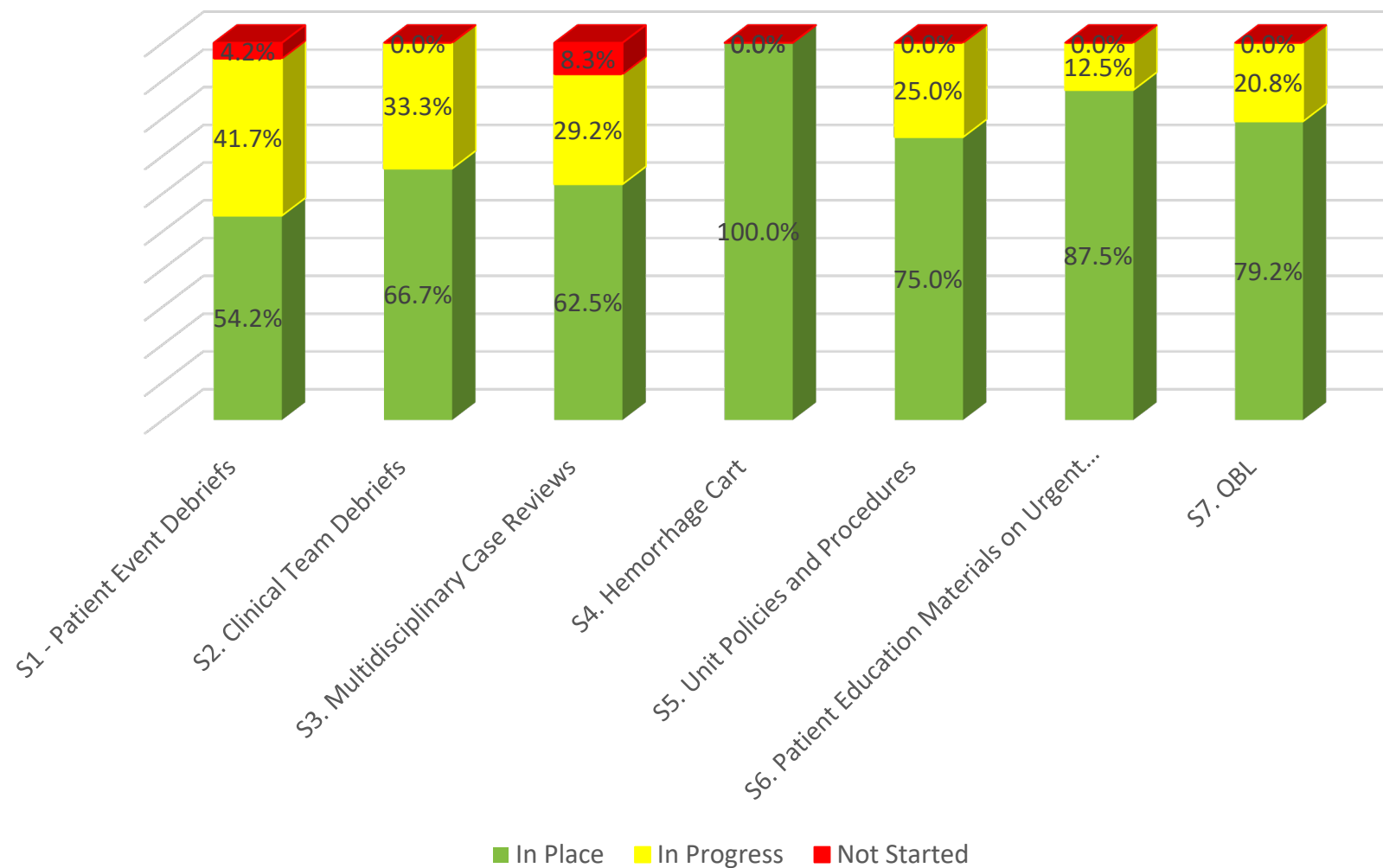

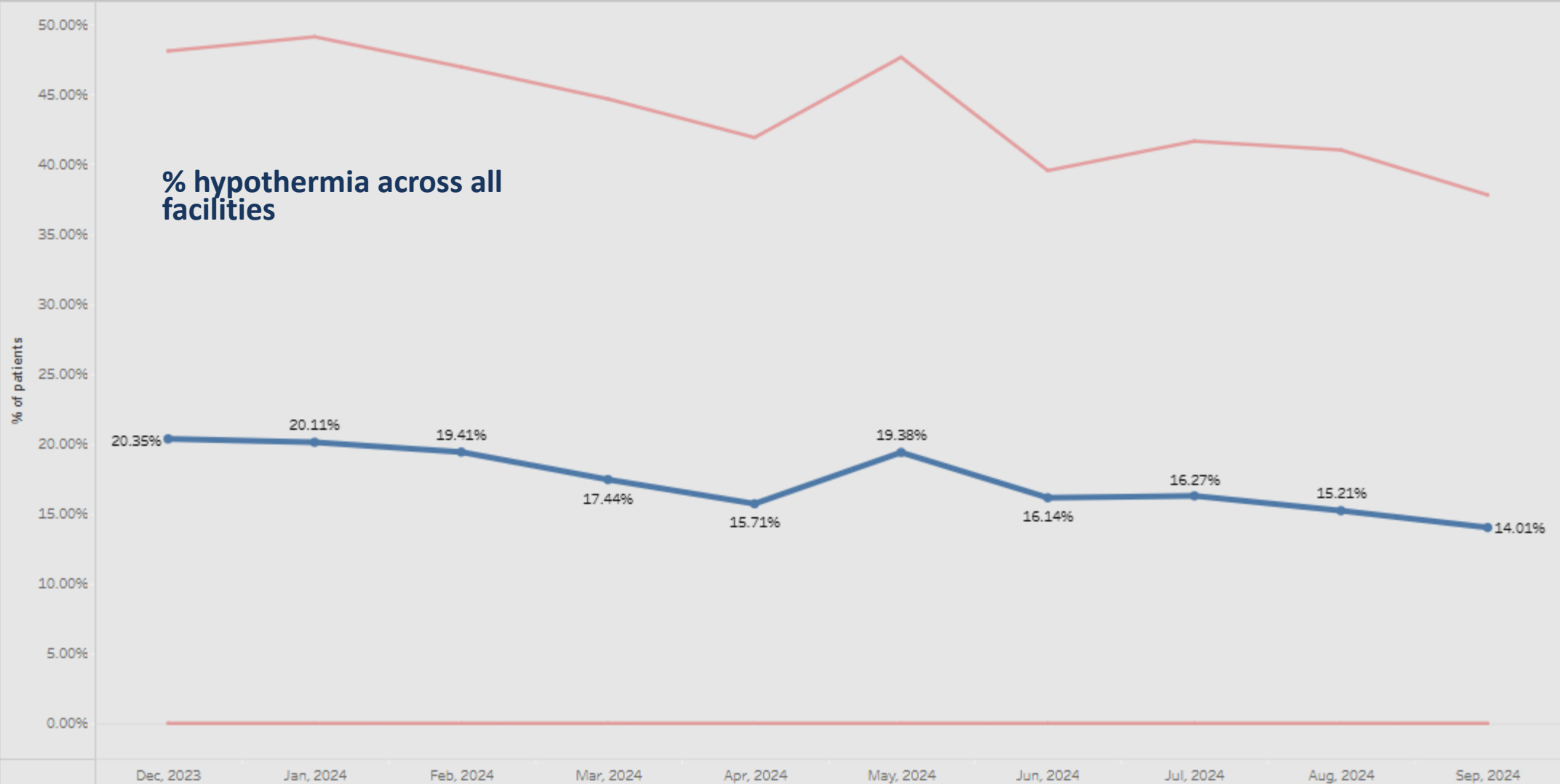

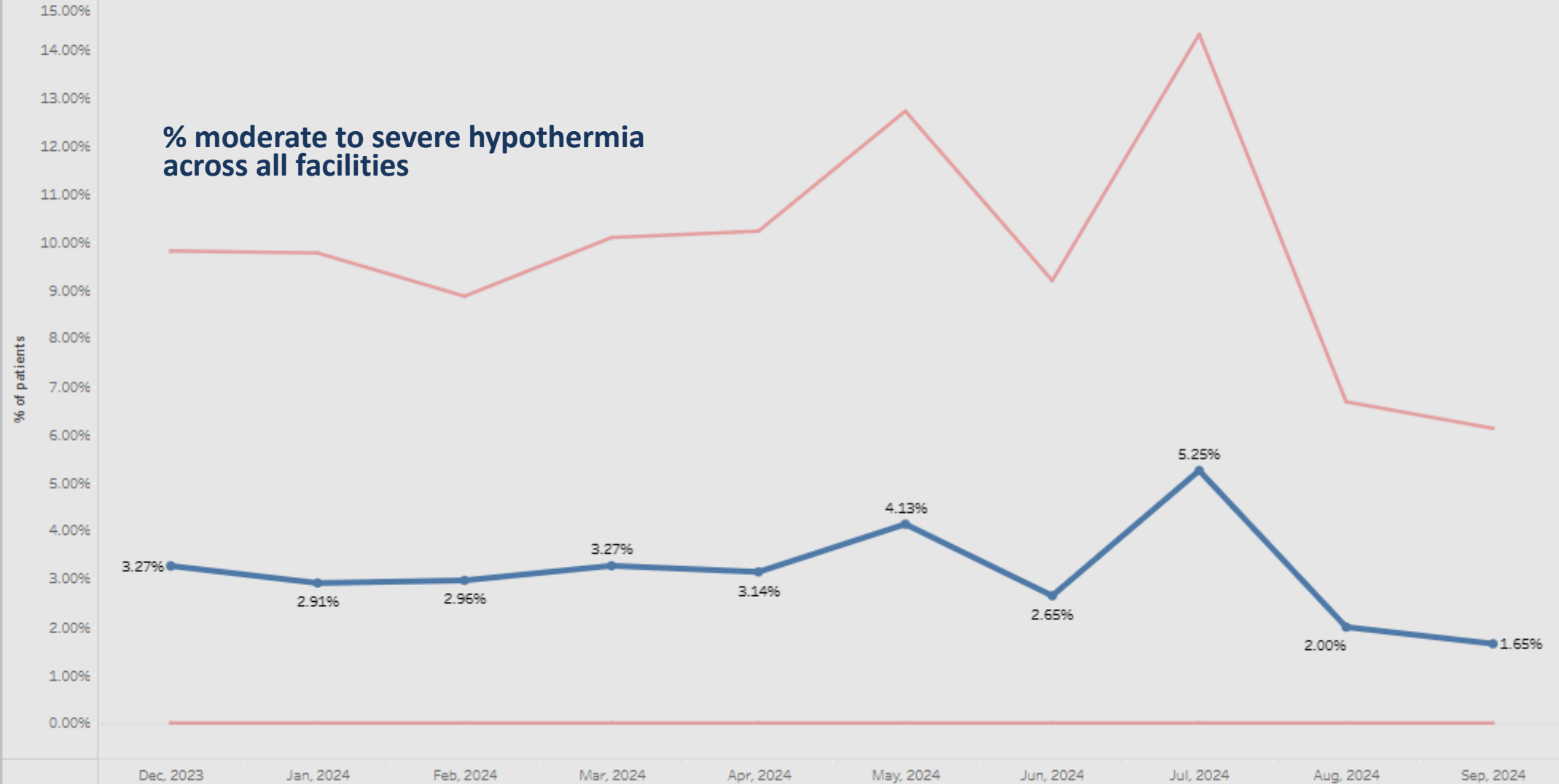

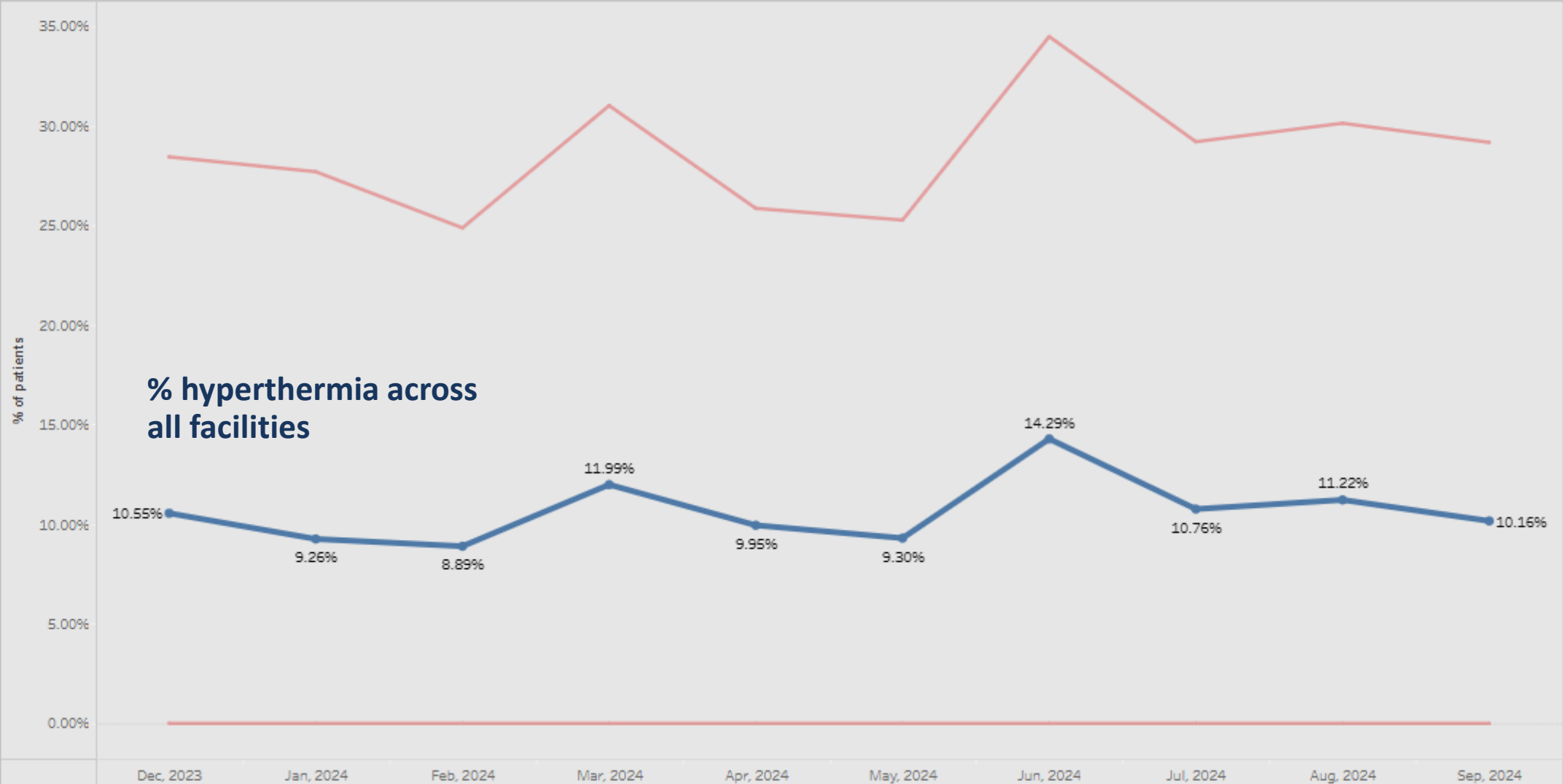

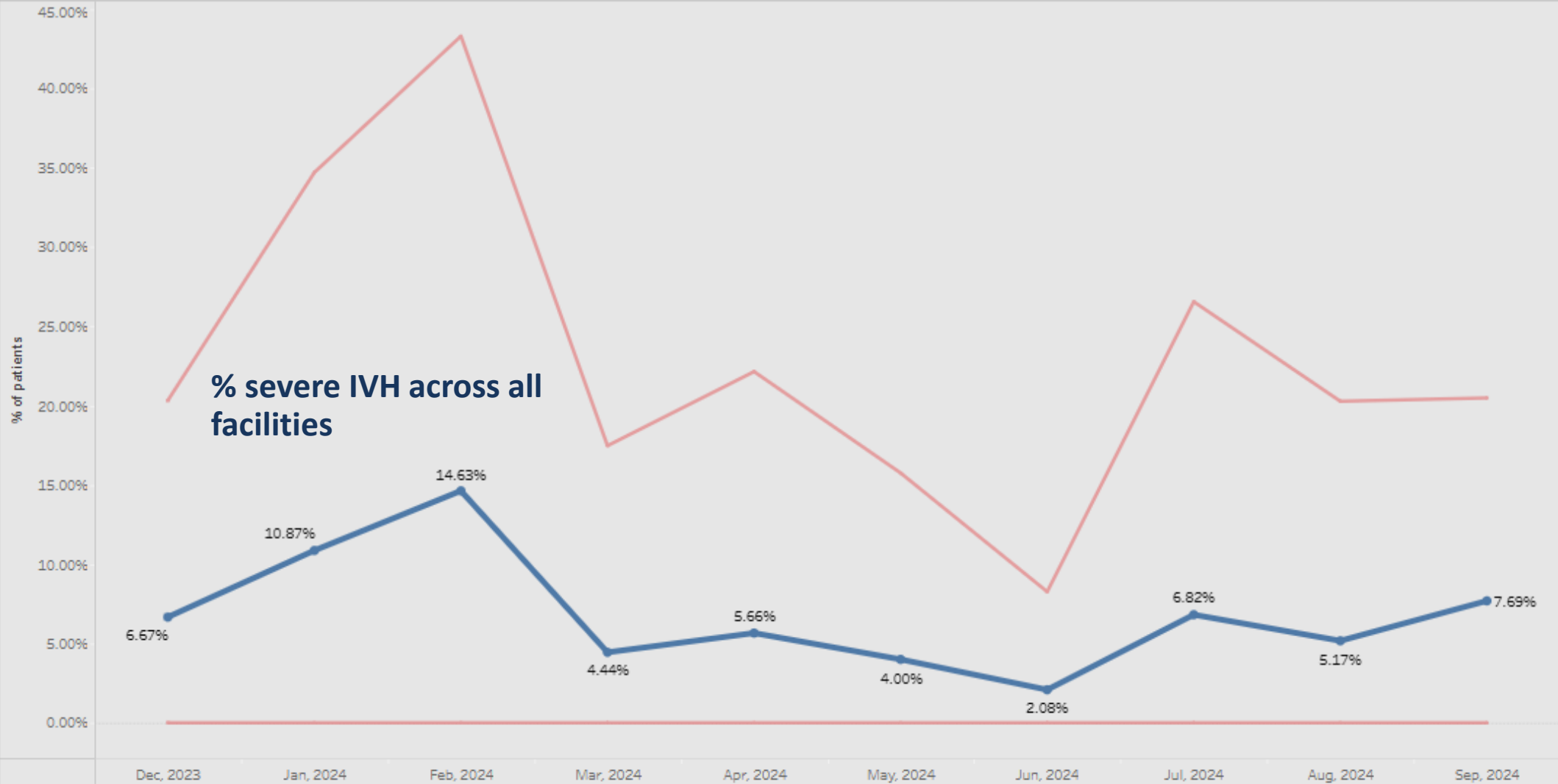

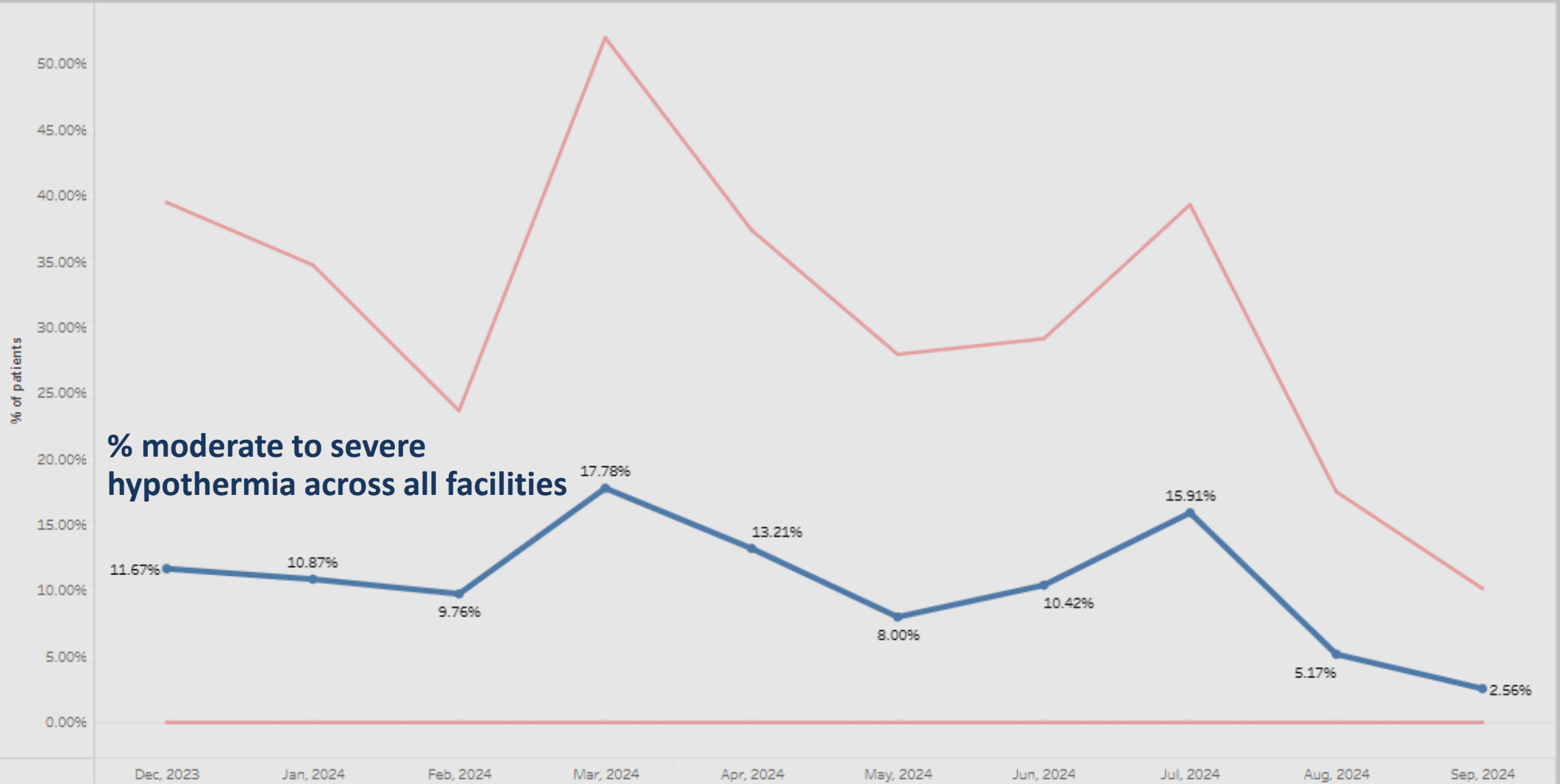

# The Alabama Maternal Health Taskforce

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- Where we started
  - The Alabama Perinatal Quality Collaborative (ALPQC) was awarded funding from HRSA to address maternal mortality and morbidity
  - The ALPQC convened the first meeting of the Alabama Maternal Health Task Force (ALMHTF) in May of 2023 with over 85 members present
- Where we have been
  - The ALMHTF launched workgroups on data, workforce development, access to care and resources, emergency obstetric medicine, and community engagement

# Key Themes – What do Moms Want?

- **Support**

- From partners, friends, peers, family, and non-medical providers;
- From clinicians throughout pregnancy and post-partum including taking concerns seriously, listening, and interacting with mothers with respect and compassion

- **Education**

- Patients desire more education on how to be prepared and what to expect during and after pregnancy on topics including:
  - Nutrition during pregnancy and breastfeeding
  - Pain management techniques during labor and delivery
  - Risks of procedures
  - CPR, car seat installation, and infant safety and care
  - Health and wellness before and between pregnancies



# Key Themes – What do Moms Want?

- **Respect**

- From providers and staff in offices and hospitals
- Desire for providers to take the time to get to know them during the pregnancy
- Participants shared instances of disrespectful or insulting language, negative assumptions based on insurance status or other demographics, and physical or verbal interactions that were perceived as too rough or otherwise inappropriate

- **Resources**

- Participants desired more places to learn what to expect, or how to navigate their pregnancy journey (centralized)
- Many shared local, state, and national resources but that folks either do not know they exist or how to access
- Emphasized the need for resources during the postpartum period
