



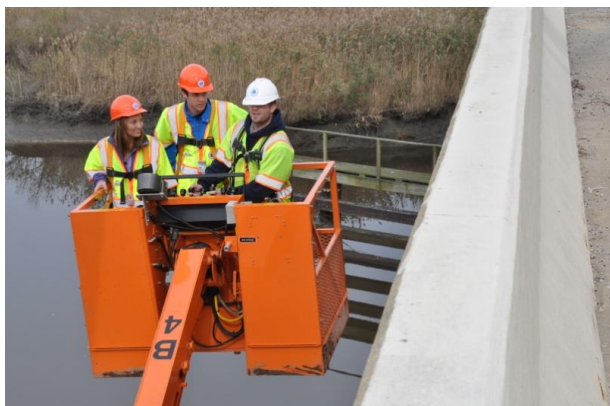

Inspection of Barkers Landing Bridge Kent County, Delaware

The Delaware T² Center coordinated an opportunity for UD student members of the American Society of Highway Engineers to see DeIDOT's inspection of Barkers Landing Bridge. The 2208' long SR1 bridge crosses the St. Jones River and was constructed in 1984. As with any bridge structure with a span in excess of 20', federal regulations require that the bridge be thoroughly inspected every two years by qualified engineers and technicians. DeIDOT's inspectors loaded the students into the Under Bridge Inspection Vehicle (UBIV) to show them the distresses they have tracked in various structural elements and what they mean as to the performance of the structure.
