Workshop Overview:

Reasonable accommodation for those with physical disabilities, in most instances, isn't as hard as you think. Oh, that last 8% can be challenging, but let's not allow that to distract you from the obligation to ensure that your overall Program is accessible. In this workshop, we will take a very high level look at the Americans with Disabilities Act as it applies to local government Programs.

Programs – meaning your buildings, building sites, parking lots, meeting areas and rooms, communications (written, virtual, oral), parks, playgrounds, trails, fishing piers, boating facilities, swimming pools, sports facilities, public right-of-way, public transportation (trains, planes, buses, bus shelters, etc.), schools, public housing, courthouses, jails, prisons, social services, assembly areas (indoor or out), etc.

We will explore most of these with a light touch to introduce and orient you and then, in if you want to get further into the weeds, we'll point you to other training workshops we offer and those found elsewhere, along with links to resources you can use in the future.

Target Audience: This is a non-technical to low-technical introduction for those new to local government or public works. Ideal for elected officials, city managers, clerks, and newer public works personnel. All are welcome. No mathematics and no quizzes – it's an easy morning.
