City of Newark, Delaware, Department of Public Works and Water Resources – Up to 3 Positions Available.

- General Description (some or all of this in each position):
 - 1. Inventory traffic control signs within the corporate limits relative to compliance with the Delaware Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD), using GPS data collector, retroreflectometer, and other tools.
 - 2. Data collection to assist with development of City's Drinking Water, Wastewater, and Stormwater GIS databases.
 - 3. Traffic calming design and analysis, vehicle counts, warrant analysis.
 - 4. Other tasks may include administrative tasks, inspection of catch basins, and storm pipe utilizing department camera equipment, or other Public Works, Water, and Water Resources planning and support activities.
- Required Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities:
 - 1. Knowledge of Microsoft Office software (Word, Excel).
 - 2. Knowledge of geographical information systems (GIS) to produce maps and manipulate data preferred; ability to learn GIS essential.
 - 3. Ability to plan, schedule and/or coordinate with department staff.
 - 4. Must possess a valid driver's license.
- Physical and Environmental Conditions:
 - The work requires occasional moderately strenuous effort such as the lifting and handling of light to moderately heavy materials and equipment; walking or climbing around roadside and other areas; sitting or standing in a fixed position for extended periods of time.
 - The work environment involves moderate risk with occasional exposure to
 potentially dangerous conditions such as those typically found on construction
 sites. These conditions require a range of safety precautions and will likely result
 in exposure to extreme temperatures and inclement weather conditions.
