- Evaluate field conditions and communicate situation to Field Representative on an as needed basis.
- Perform systematic crop surveillance, record keeping, and diagnostics.
- Collect and submit soil and tissue samples.
- Ability to communicate issues quickly and effectively with the salesperson that you are working with in daily activities to enhance sales growth.

Qualifications for an internship would include:

- Attendance at a college or university in an agricultural curriculum.
- Ability to safely operate and maintain vehicles/equipment assigned.
- Must be a self-starter with a positive attitude.
- Understanding of crop production business.
- Be able to read and understand aerial field maps.
- Basic knowledge of field crops and pest identification.
- Flexibility and ability to take direction.
- Strong communication, problem solving and collaboration skills.
- Ability to follow instructions and ask questions when clarification is necessary.

- Ability to lift up to 40 pounds.
- Ability to work alone unsupervised.
- Workings as an intern requires a lot of walking.
- Ability to work a variety of tasks outdoors in all types of weather conditions in possible 90+ weather.
- Ability to work Monday to Saturday and possibly but rarely on Sundays and extended hours during peak busy seasons 8 hours+ shifts.
- Ability to work in conditions like mud, dust, wet crops, etc.
- Ability to bend over and perform physically demanding and repetitive tasks like stand counts for multiple hours at a time.

What to Wear:
