#### **COURSE OVERVIEW:**

ENTR 460 - High-Tech Entrepreneurship is a three-credit course interactive course available to undergraduate juniors and seniors and first-year graduate students enrolled in STEM disciplines (i.e., COE, CHS, CANS). The course will introduce you to the analysis and actions required to identify a genuine market need, develop a technology that addresses that need, and create a business model that delivers and sustains value. Industry experts will supplement your learning by sharing their real-world experiences pertinent to the topics being studied.
