

New Visions for Public Affairs

Memorandum of Understanding

1. **Grant:** Author grants to New Visions for Public Affairs (NVPA):
 - a. The exclusive right of first publication of the Article; and
 - b. The non-exclusive, royalty-free right, in perpetuity, to publish, print, reprint, photocopy, post and/or otherwise disseminate the Article, and to authorize others to do the same, in any format or medium now known or hereinafter developed, at any time after the Article's first publication in the NVPA publication.

2. **Publication:**
 - a. The anticipated date of publication is May 2018; and
 - b. Author recognizes that the "anticipated" date represents the best judgment of NVPA at the time of this Agreement, and that NVPA is not bound to publish the Article by such anticipated date.

3. **Copyright:** Author shall retain all copyrights in the Article, subject to the rights granted to NVPA in this memorandum.

4. **Author's Warranties:** Author warrants that:
 - a. The Article submitted to NVPA is the original work of Author;
 - b. The Article has not been, and will not be, first published elsewhere, in whole or in part, except as approved in writing by the Executive Director of NVPA;
 - c. Author is the exclusive owner of the copyrights in the Article, and has the right to grant NVPA the rights set forth in this Agreement;
 - d. The Article does not infringe on any copyrights, proprietary rights, privacy rights, or any other rights of any person or entity;
 - e. All named authors on the article have significantly contributed to its production; and
 - f. The Article contains no defamatory matter; and
 - g. If the Article includes any material (textual, graphic, or otherwise) that is the property of a third party and for which permission to use is required, Author has obtained the written consent of such third party for use of the material in the Article.

5. **Editorial Process:** NVPA agrees to provide editorial assistance for the Article in order to maximize the quality of the Article.

- a. Editorial assistance shall include, but is not limited to, assuring the accuracy of citations, improving overall style and organization, and suggesting and/or undertaking certain textual additions or deletions;
- b. Author agrees to timely cooperation with the requests of NVPA in implementing revisions deemed by NVPA to be necessary. Such cooperation shall include, but is not limited to, providing NVPA, when requested, with copies of sources relied upon by Author and with additional information and/or research in order to keep the Article consistent with current developments; and
- c. In the event that Author disagrees with the editorial requests, revisions, and/or requirements of NVPA for publications of the Article, Author shall so notify NVPA in writing. If NVPA determines that accommodations can be made without adversely affecting NVPA, then NVPA will make such accommodations. If NVPA determines that it cannot make such accommodations without adversely affecting the professional and academic integrity or quality of NVPA, then NVPA will notify the Author of refusal to publish the Article.
