

Resident Student Permit

Effective August 1, 2024

This is an information sheet about your permit type. Please be sure to read all the information.

Resident Students are assigned a LOT NUMBER(S) NOT A COLOR. Resident permit holders must park in their assigned lot during restricted hours (7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday – Friday).

Resident permit holders may also park in lots 1 and 88 at all times.

This permit is also valid in non-restricted and Pearson lots on weekends, holidays, and after 5 p.m. on weekdays. Resident student permits can park in Gray lots when classes and exams are not in session.

If you are assigned to Lots 39 and 40 there are two areas, please refer to the map link at the top of www.udel.edu/parking for the location of your lots.

If you are unable to find a valid space in your assigned lot during the hours of 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. Monday – Friday, your overflow lots are LOTS 1 and 88. The vehicle should be moved to your assigned lot as soon as possible.

Students are not eligible to add another student's vehicle to their permit

Permit holders agree that sharing or abusing this parking privilege will result in it being revoked without a refund, a notice of violation will be issued for fraudulent registration, and students will be referred to the Office of Student Conduct.

Permit holders agree

1. A permit is required at all times when parking on university property.
2. Parking lots are restricted by permit type or lot assignment Monday – Friday, 7 a.m. – 5 p.m.
3. Only one vehicle can be parked on campus at a time per permit.
4. Permits are not valid at Passport Spaces or pay-to-park lots.
5. The license plate of the vehicle must face the drive lane when parked on campus.
6. All vehicles must be operated safely, and vehicle operators must obey all traffic control devices on campus. Vehicles parked against the flow of traffic may be cited.
7. The University reserves the right to limit space in campus parking lots as needed. Permit holders will be directed to alternative parking areas. In non-emergency situations, the University will provide notice via electronic means.

Football Parking 2024 Fall Season

Parking lots south of Townsend Hall are reserved on home football game days from 12 AM to 9 PM. Vehicles parked in these lots will be relocated off-campus at the owner's expense. Home games are scheduled for August 29th, September 21st, September 28th, October 12th, October 26th, November 9th and November 16th.

University of Delaware parking permits are invalid during U of D home football games. Any vehicle trying to gain entry with a U of D parking permit will be directed to pay for general parking. U of D football game parking is organized by Athletics; please contact them with questions specific to football game days.
