SCHOLARSHIP OVERVIEW

The Redding Schools Support Scholarship will provide funding to cover up to the full cost of tuition and fees minus any other scholarships or state funding the student may have received.

SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

Eligible employees or student teachers who are currently working at a Redding Consortium school can apply for a scholarship towards tuition costs at a Delaware Institution of Higher Education. Individuals must be actively enrolled or planning to enroll in fall, winter, or spring semesters during the 2022-2023 academic year.



CANDIDATE ELIGIBILITY

Eligible employees include teachers, para-educators, student teachers, principals, nurses, counselors, social workers and other support staff in Redding Consortium schools.



CREDENTIALING REQUIREMENTS

There is no minimum number of credits that an eligible employee must be enrolled in to qualify for this scholarship. Eligible educator prep programs can be at the associate, bachelors, masters, doctoral, certificate, or advanced credentialing level.



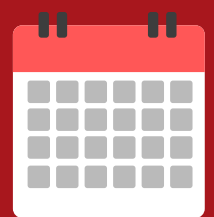
