CYNTHIA B. KANE, Special Assistant to the Delaware Secretary of State, is an international specialist. Her current duties include advocating for the Delaware Department of State, Division of Corporations. Ms. Kane serves as coordinator of the International Marketing Committee. She has organized Delaware trade missions and incorporation conferences and seminars in Germany, England, Holland, Japan, Chile, Argentina, Ireland, Israel, Taiwan, Thailand, Austria, Peru, China, Australia, Turkey, Viet Nam, Brazil, India, South Africa, and Columbia.

Ms. Kane served as coordinator of the National Governors Association's Seminar for new Governors, the national board meeting of Jobs for American Graduates, and Delaware's 2017 anniversary celebration symposium.

Prior to joining the Department of State, Ms. Kane was the Special Projects Coordinator at the Delaware Economic Development Office. She served as Executive Director of Delaware's Gubernatorial Inauguration. Ms. Kane has been in association with and worked in various positions with four consecutive Delaware Governors, as well as three Secretaries of State. In 2017, she was reappointed and continues to serve under The Honorable Delaware Governor John C. Carney, Jr. and Secretary of State Jeffrey W. Bullock.

Ms. Kane holds a Bachelor's degree from Boston University and has done graduate work at George Washington University in Washington, D.C.
