


### Percentage of Students Who have Ever Had Sex\*






## Percentage of Students Who Have Ever Had Sex by Gender and Race\*






## Percentage of Students Who Have Ever Had Sex by Sexual Orientation






### Percentage of Students Who had Sex before Age 13\*






## Percentage of Students Who had Sex before Age 13 by Gender and Race\*






### Percentage of Students Who had Sex before Age 13 by Sexual Orientation






### Percentage of Students Who've had Sex with 4+ partners (life)\*






# Percentage of Students Who had Sex with 4+ partners (life) by Gender and Race\*






### Percentage of Students Who've had Sex with 4+ partners (life) by Sexual Orientation






## Percentage of Students Who Have had Sex 1+ partner (past three months)\*






### Percentage of Students Who Have Had Sex 1+ partner (past 3 mo) by Gender and Race\*






### Percentage of Students Who Have had Sex 1+ partner (past 3 mo) by Sexual Orientation








# Percentage of Students who have been Physically Forced to Have Sex






## Percent Physically Forced to Have Sex by Race and Gender






## Trendline of Percentage of Students who have been Physically Forced to






# Of those Sexually Active, Percentage of Students Who Used Alcohol/Drugs Last Time\*






# Of those Sexually Active, Percentage of Students Who Used Alcohol/Drugs Last Time by Gender and Race\*






# Of those Sexually Active, Percentage of Students Who Used Alcohol/Drugs Last Time by Sexual Orientation






# Of those Sexually Active, Percentage of Students who Used Condom Last Time\*








# Of Sexually Active, Percentage of Students Who Used Condom Last Time by Race & Gender








### Of those Sexually Active, Percentage of Students Who Used Birth Control\*






# Of those Sexually Active, Percentage of Students Used Birth Control by Gender and Race\*






# Of those Sexually Active, Percentage of Students Used Birth Control by Sexual Orientation






# Of those Sexually Active, Percentage of Students Who Were Diagnosed with a STD





# Of those Sexually Active, Percentage of Students Who Have Ever Been Pregnant/Gotten Someone Pregnant






# Of Those Sexually Active, Percentage of Students Who Have Ever Been Pregnant Once/Gotten Someone Pregnant by Race






## Of Those Sexually Active, Percentage of Students Who Have Ever Been Pregnant Twice or More/Gotten Someone Pregnant by Race and Gender











# Alcohol, Marijuana, and Rx Painkiller Use by Forced Sex\*






### Percentage of students who had ever been physically forced to have sexual intercourse when they did not want to












#### Percentage of students who ever had sexual intercourse












### Percentage of students who had sexual intercourse for the first time before age 13 years












## Percentage of students who had sexual intercourse with four or more people during their life












### Percentage of students who had sexual intercourse with one or more people during the past three months












### Among students who had sexual intercourse during the past three months, the percentage who drank alcohol or used drugs












### Among students who had sexual intercourse during the past three months, the percentage who used a condom during the last












## Among students who had sexual intercourse during the past three months, the percentage who used birth control pills to prevent pregnancy before last sexual intercourse












### Percentage of students who had ever been taught in school about AIDS or HIV infection











- 72% of 11<sup>th</sup> grade students reported they had given or received oral sex—41% of 9<sup>th</sup> graders have.
- 11% of 11<sup>th</sup> grade girls report having been pregnant at least once—9% of 9<sup>th</sup> grade girls.
- 2% of 11<sup>th</sup> grade students reported that they had been diagnosed with a sexually transmitted disease (STD)—3% of 9<sup>th</sup> graders have.
- Remember, these are the students still in school.







