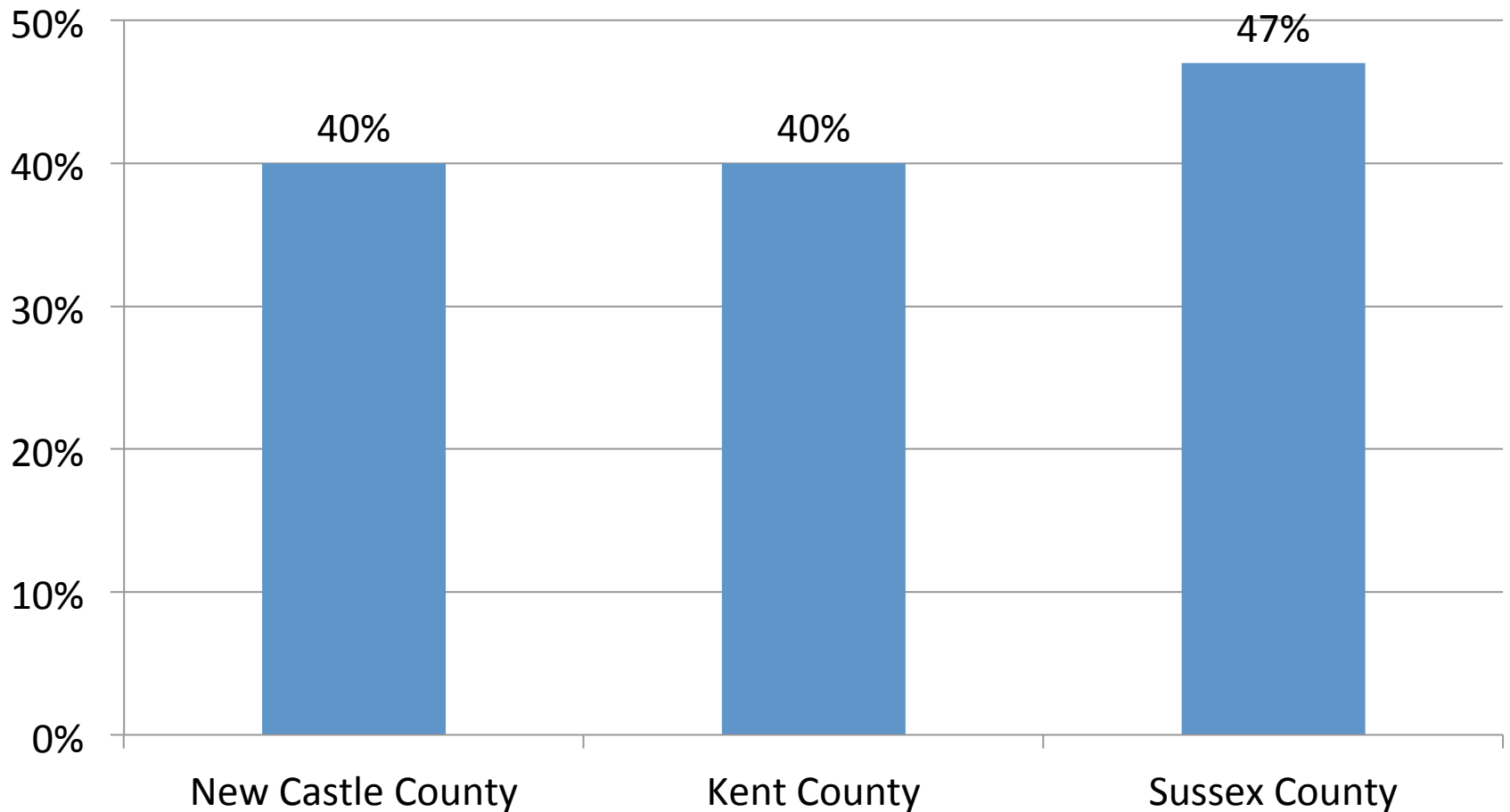

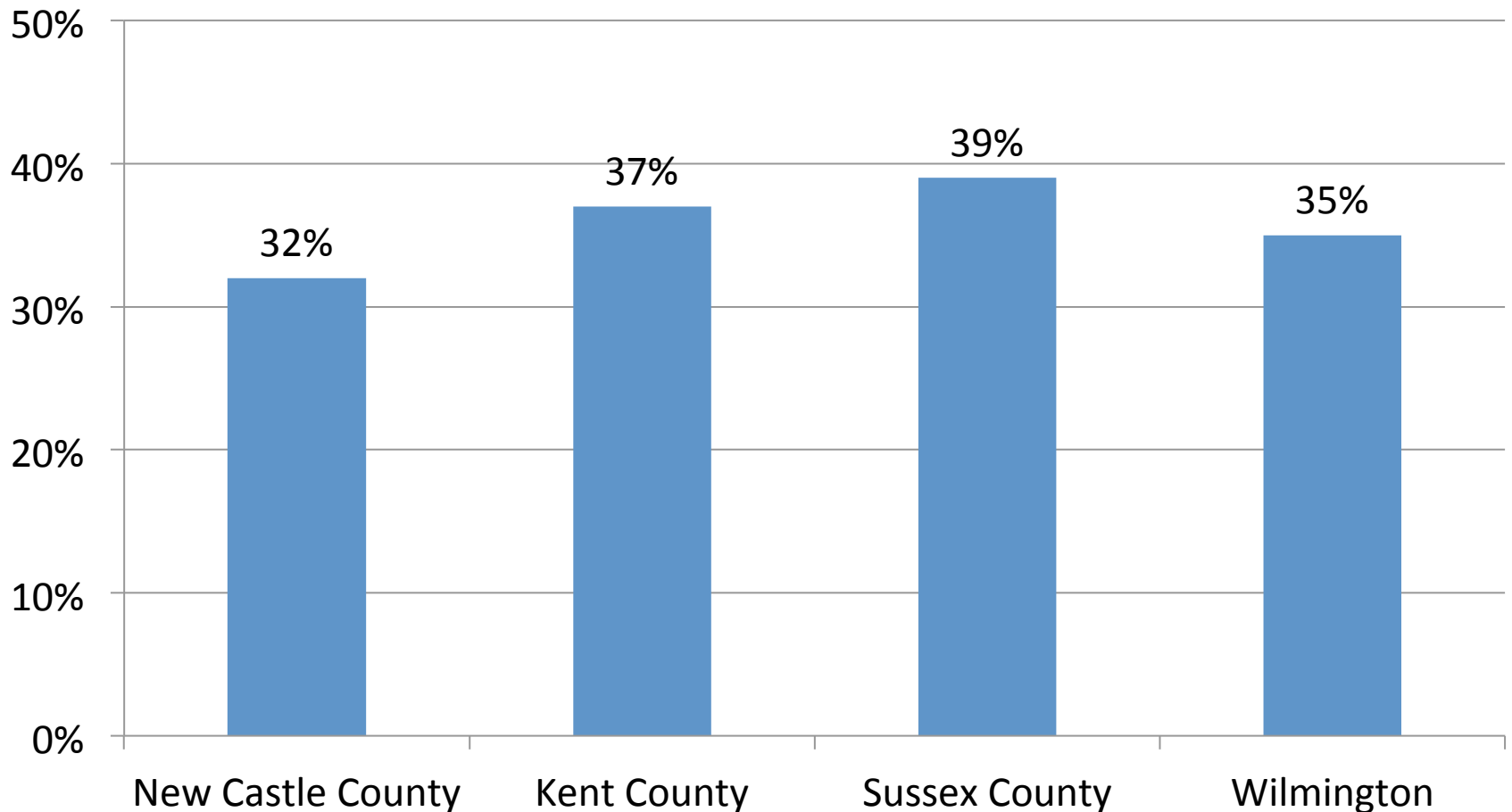

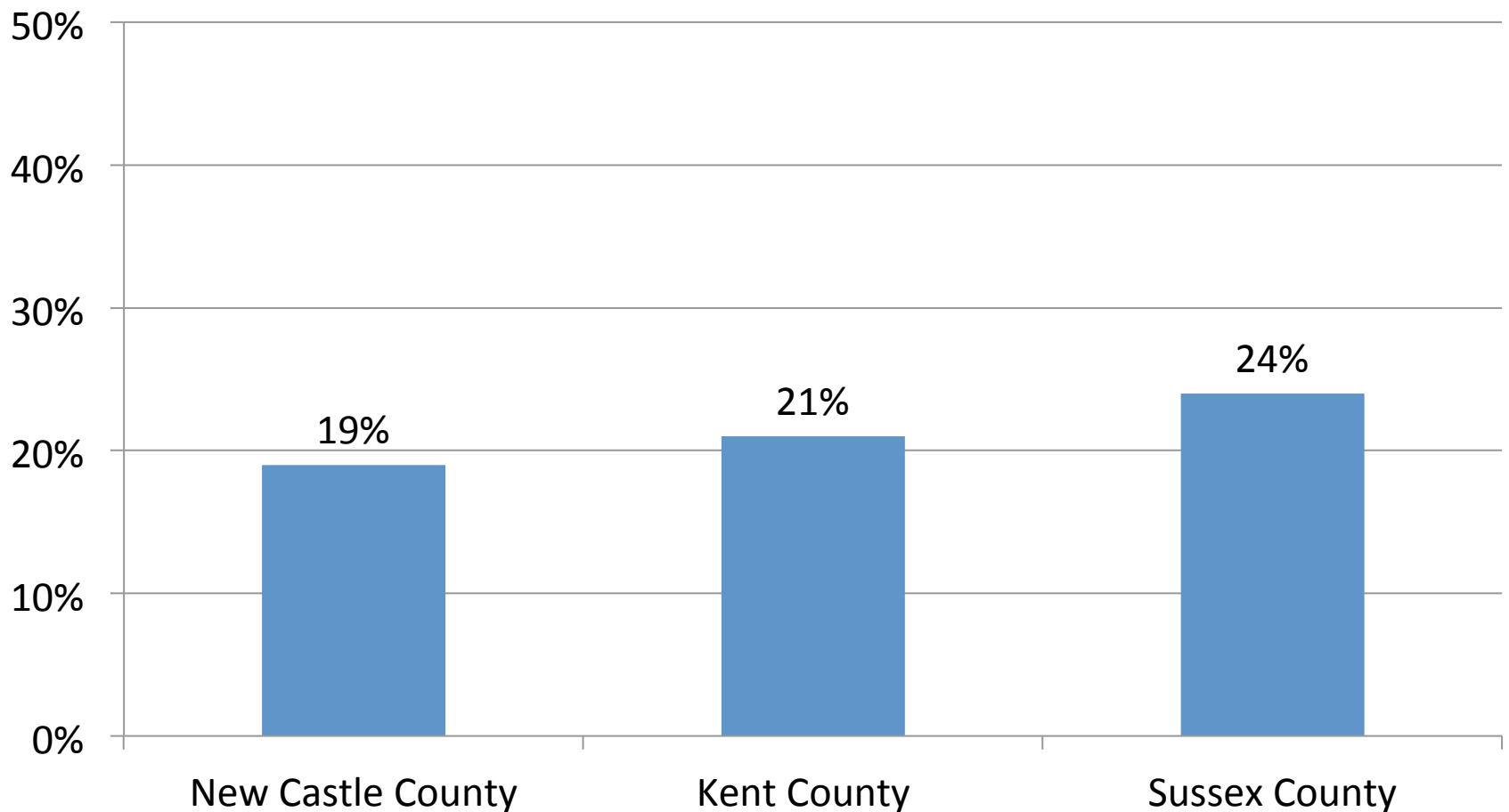
Percent of Delaware High School Students Self-reporting Alcohol Use in the Past 30 Days



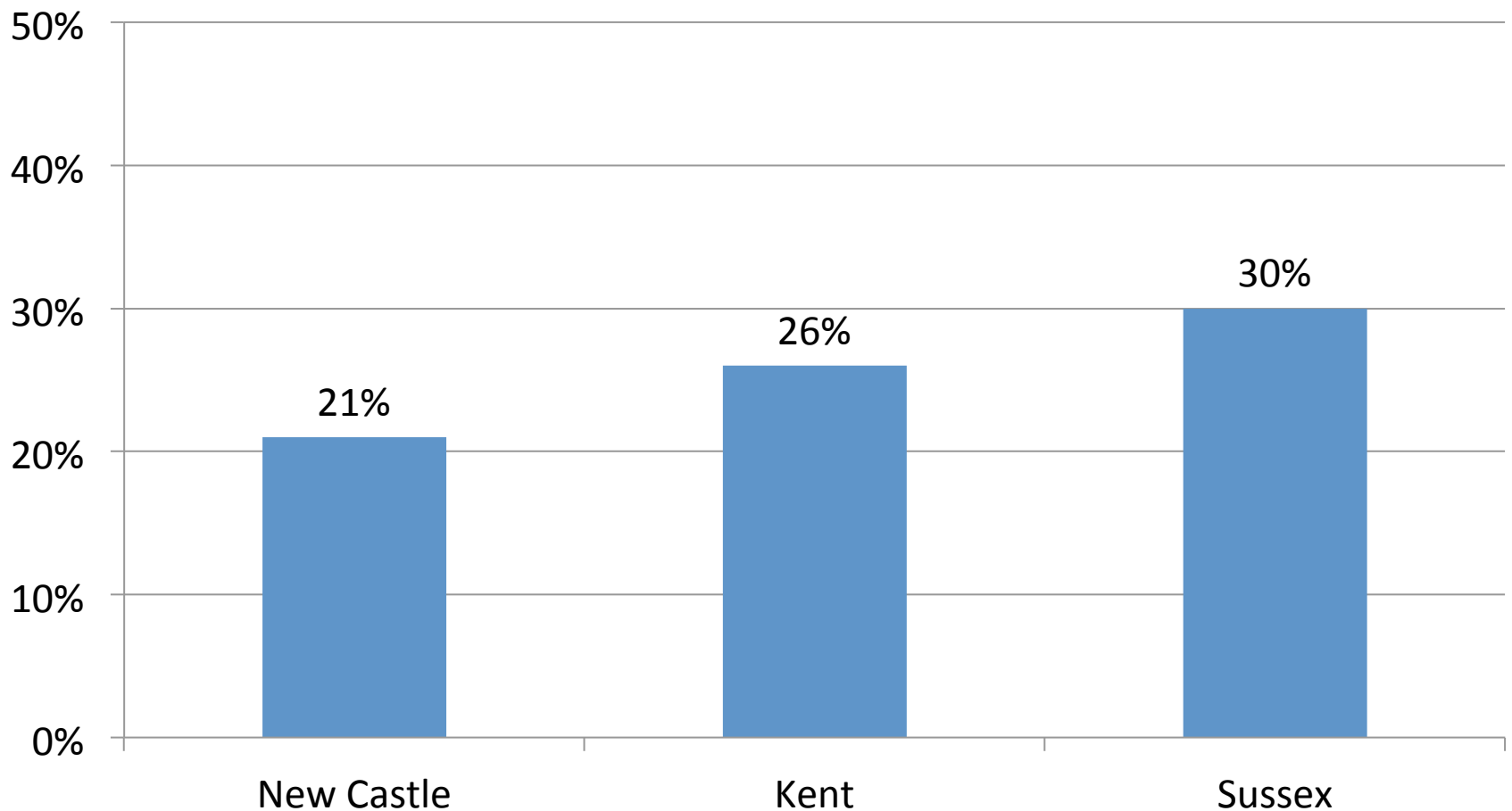
Percent of 11th Grade Delaware Students Self-reporting Alcohol Use in the Past 30 Days



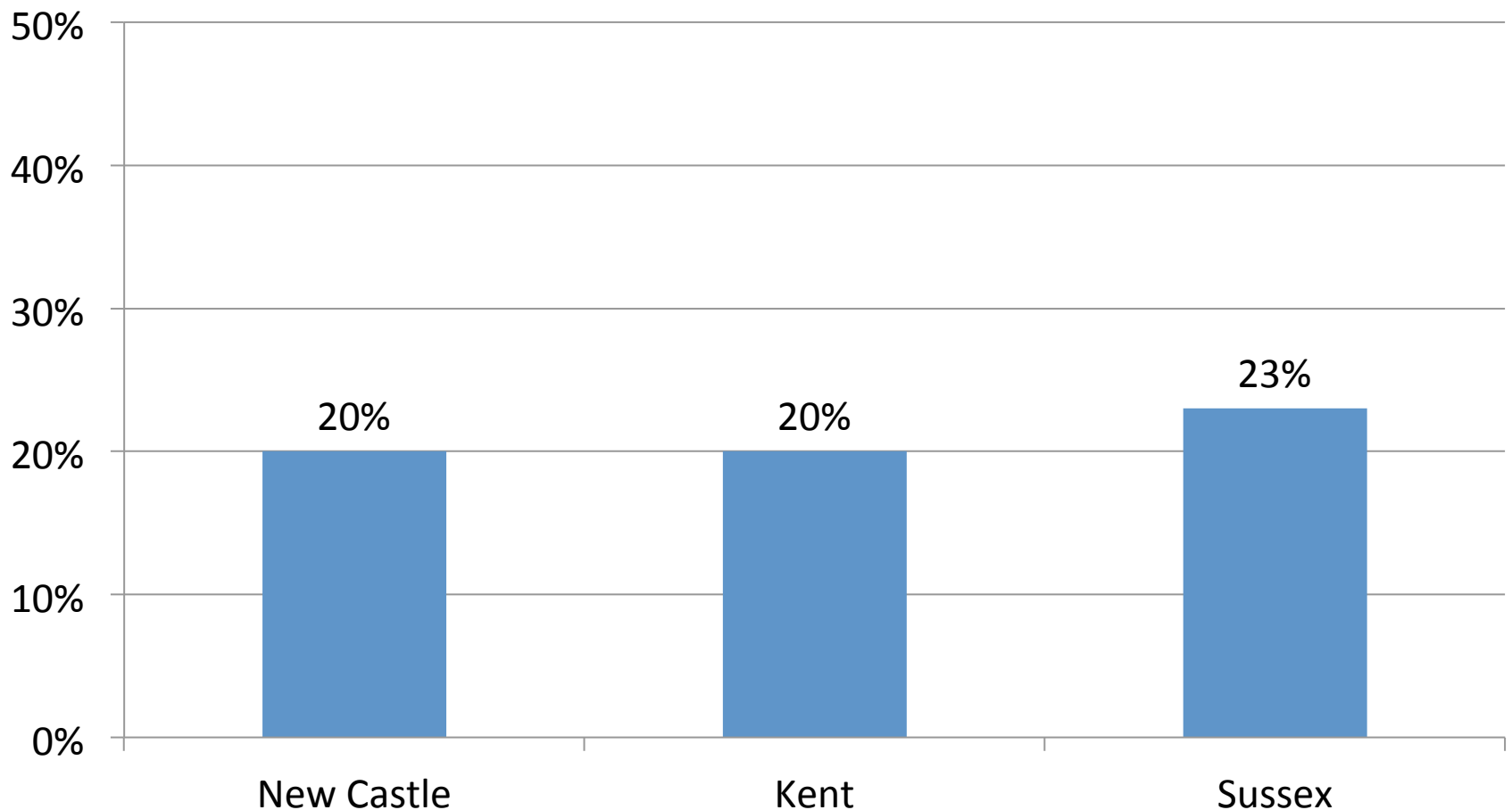
Percent of 11th Grade Delaware Students Self-reporting Binge Alcohol Use in the Past 30 Days



Percent of Delaware High School Students Self-reporting Binge Alcohol Use in the Past 30 Days

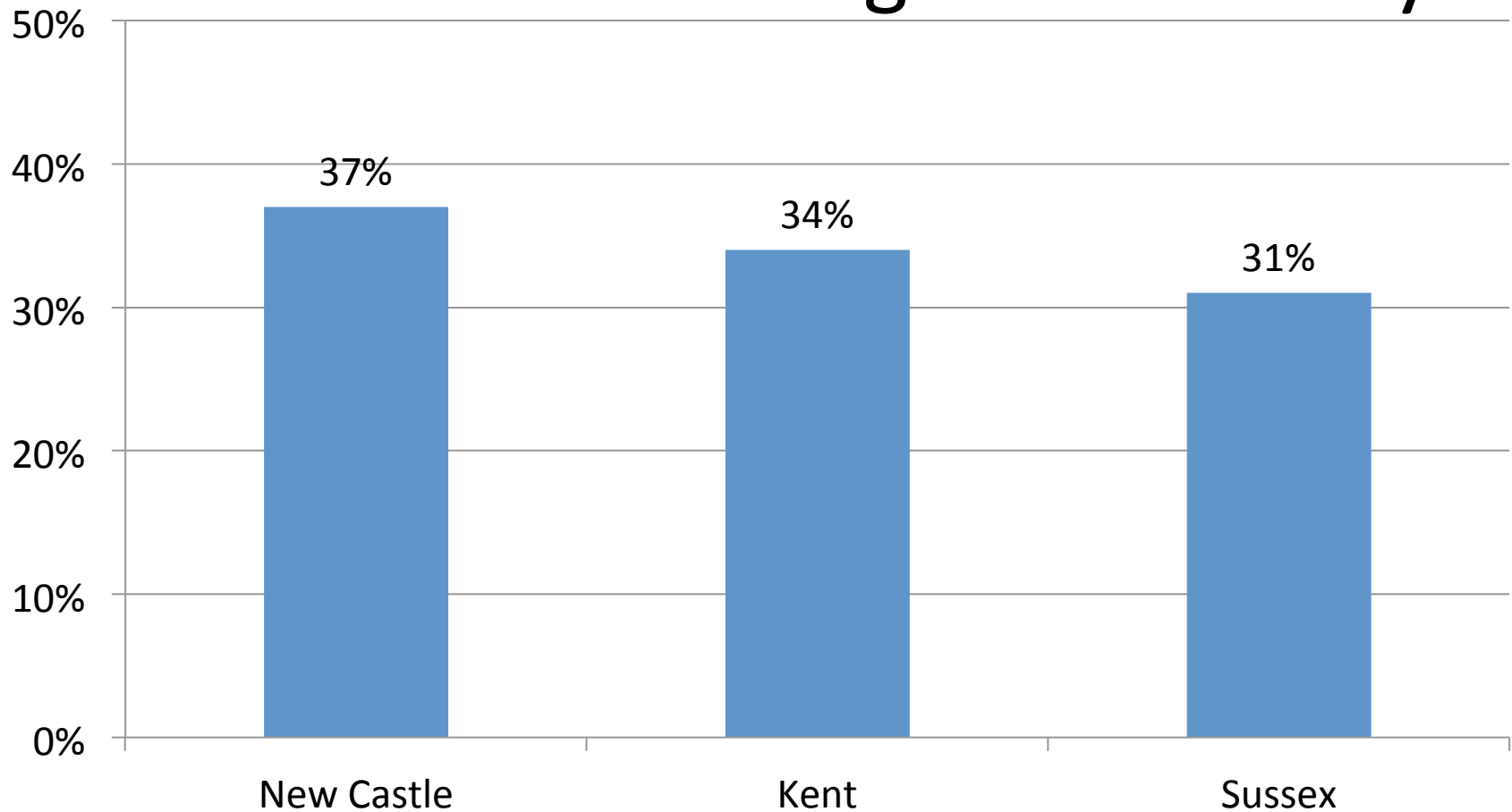


Percent of Delaware High School Students Self-reporting Alcohol Use Before the Age of 13

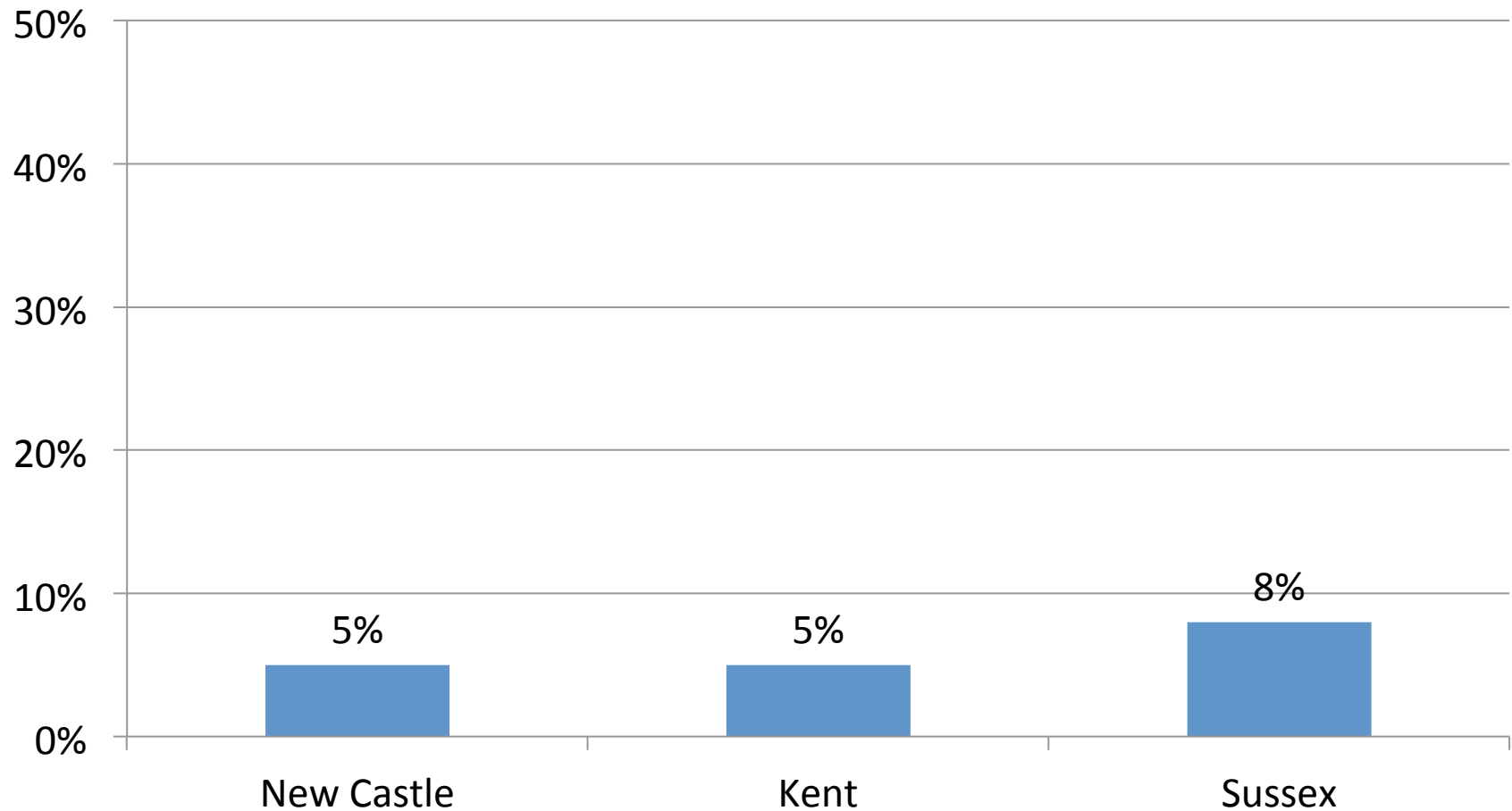

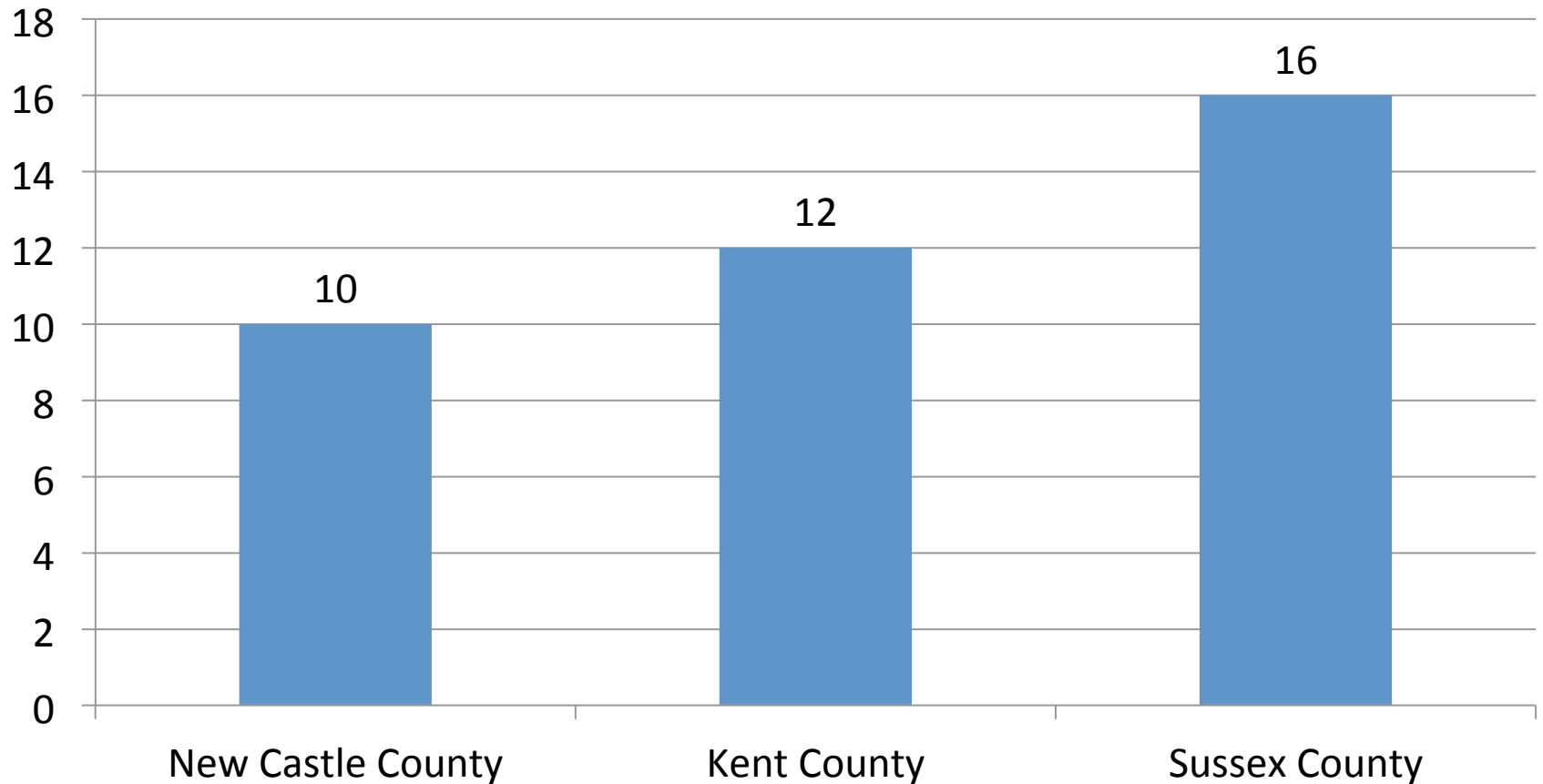
Percent of Delaware High School Students Self-reporting Perceiving Great Risk in Drinking Alcohol Daily



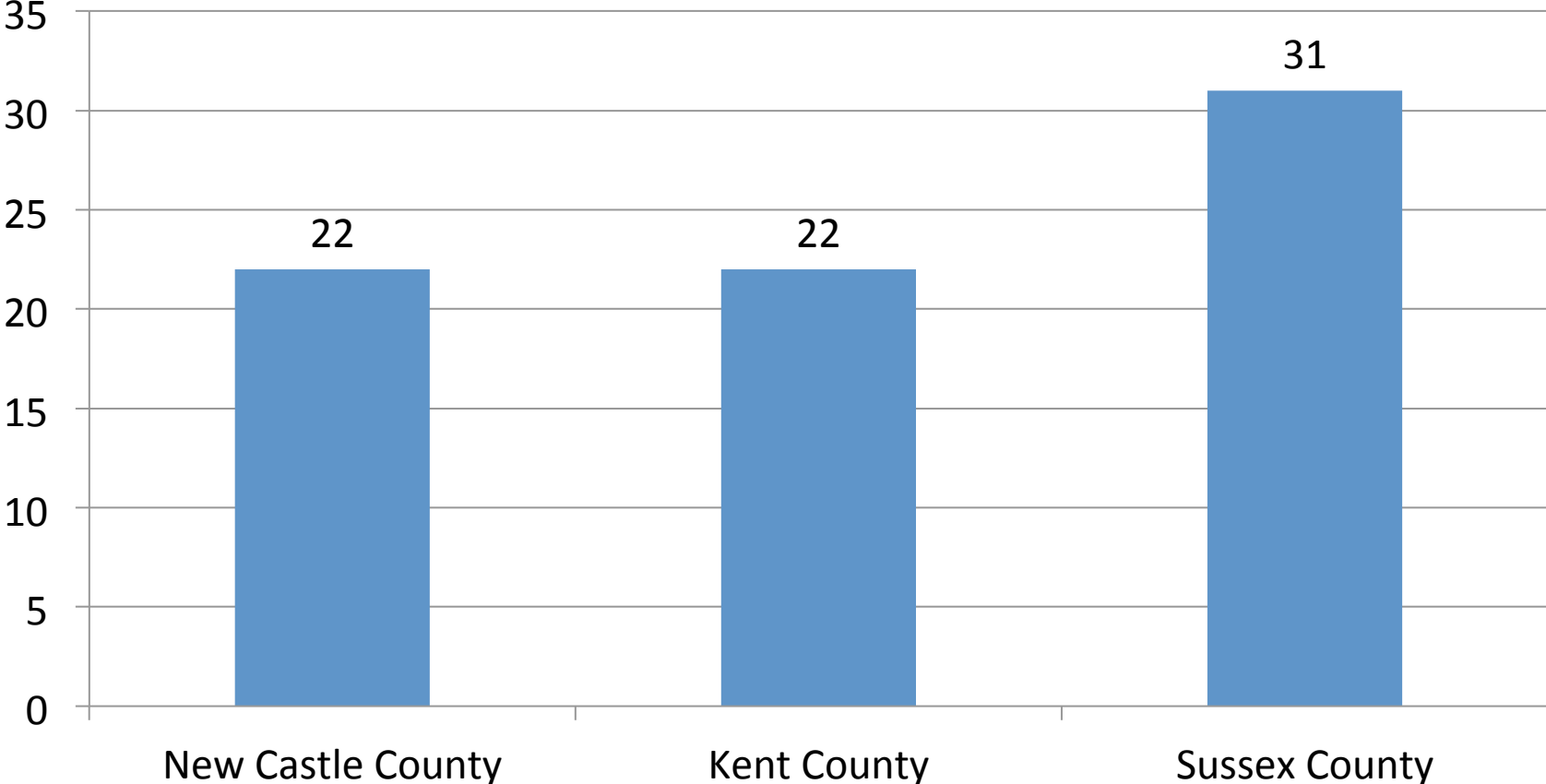
Percent of Delaware High School Students Self-reporting Lifetime Cocaine Use



Delaware High School Students Who Report Giving Someone Money to Buy Alcohol For Them

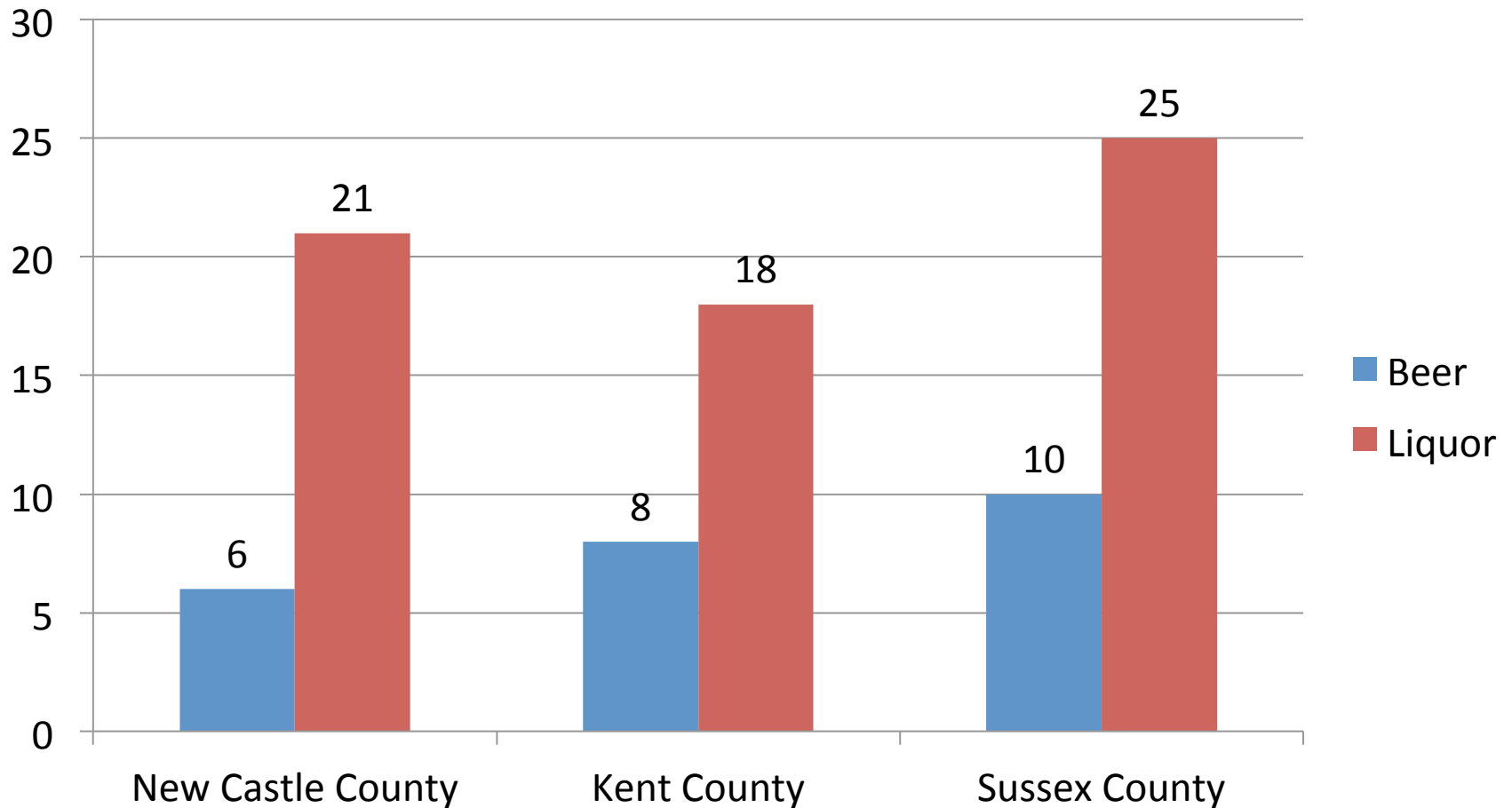


Delaware High School Students Who Report They Drank at Someone Else's House

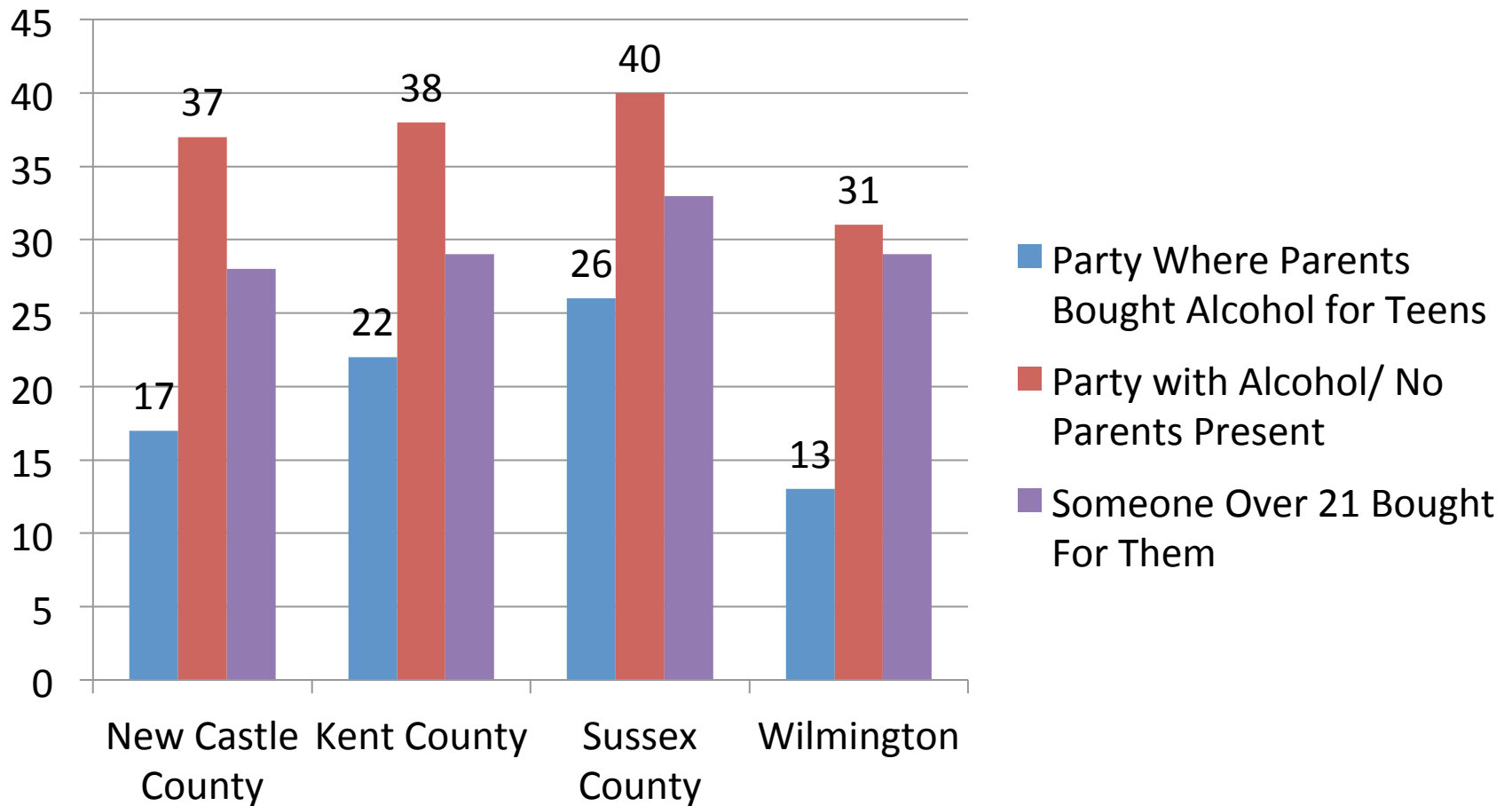

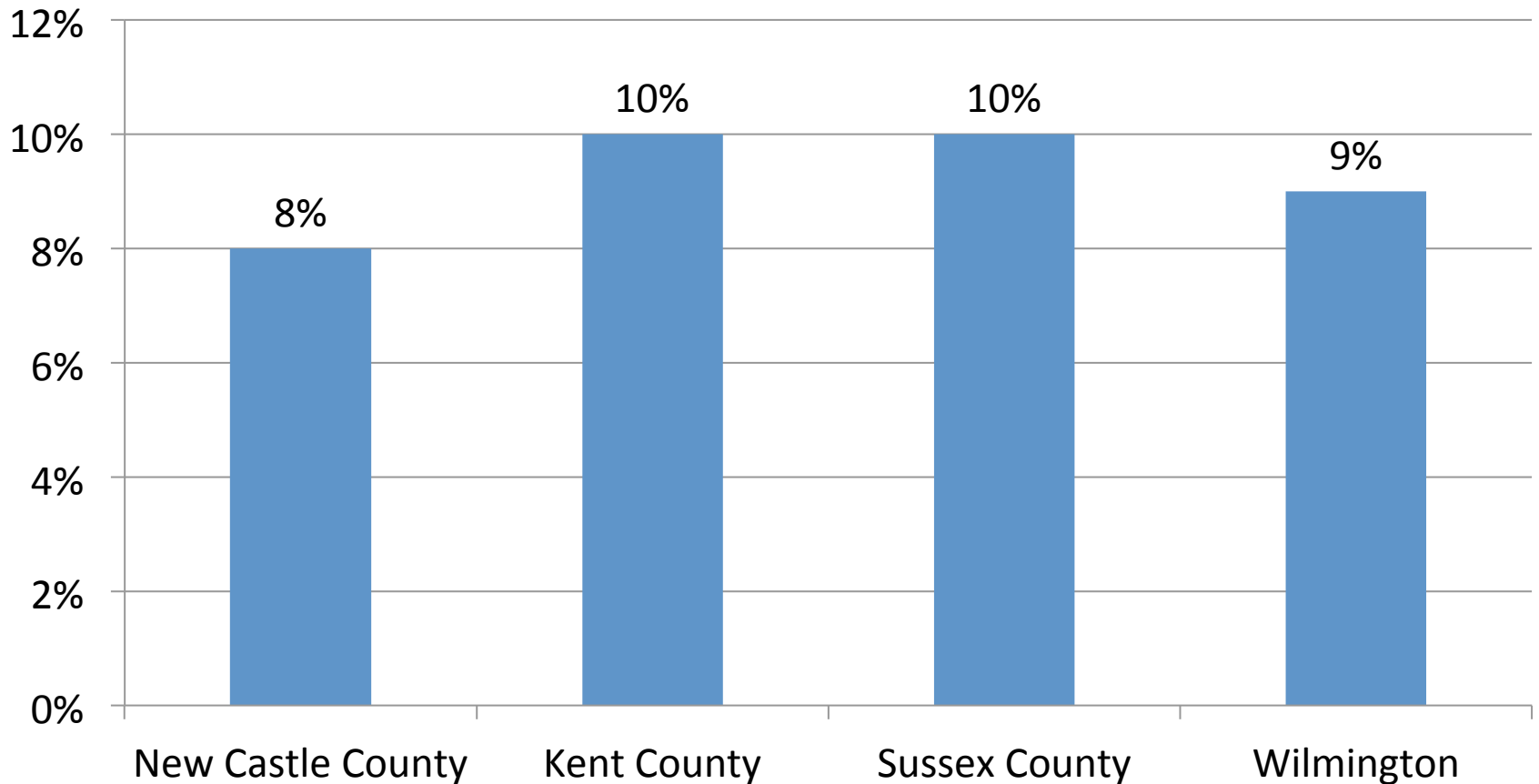
Delaware High School Students Report Types of Alcohol Drunk



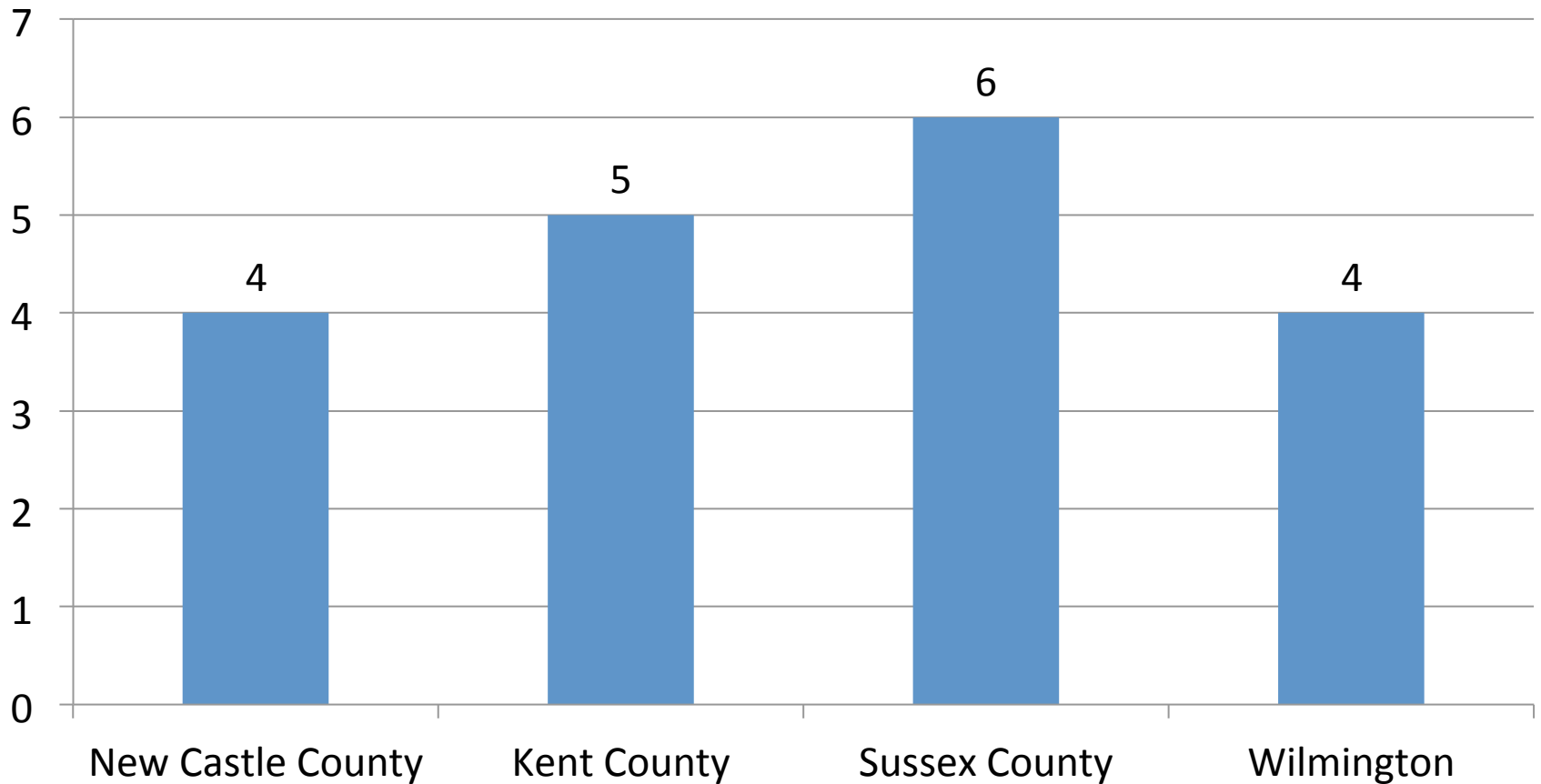
Delaware 11th Grade Students Report Sources of Alcohol



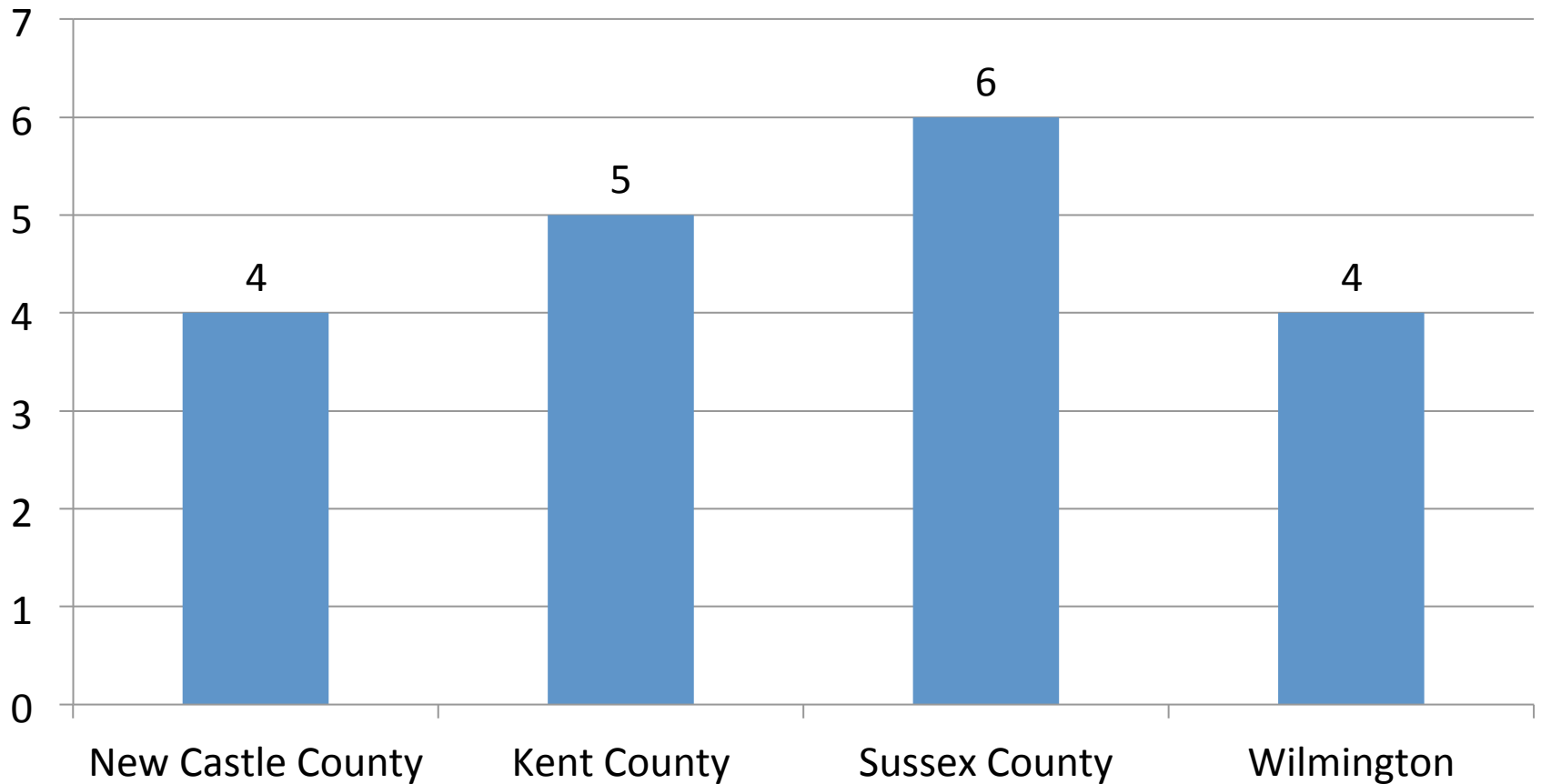
Delaware 11th Grade Students Who Report Using Prescription Drugs not Prescribed for Them in the Past Year



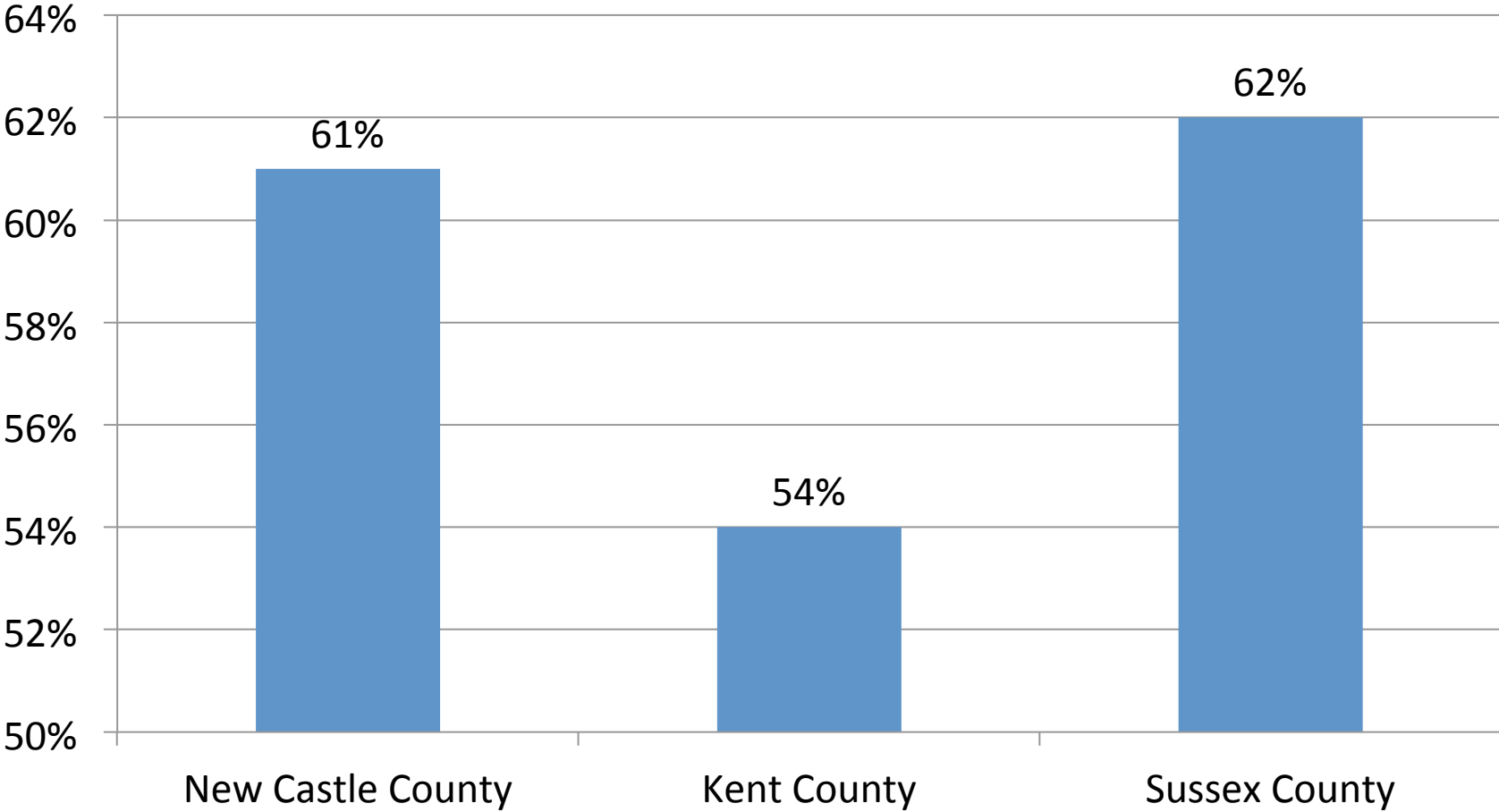
Delaware 11th Grade Students Who Report Driving Drunk

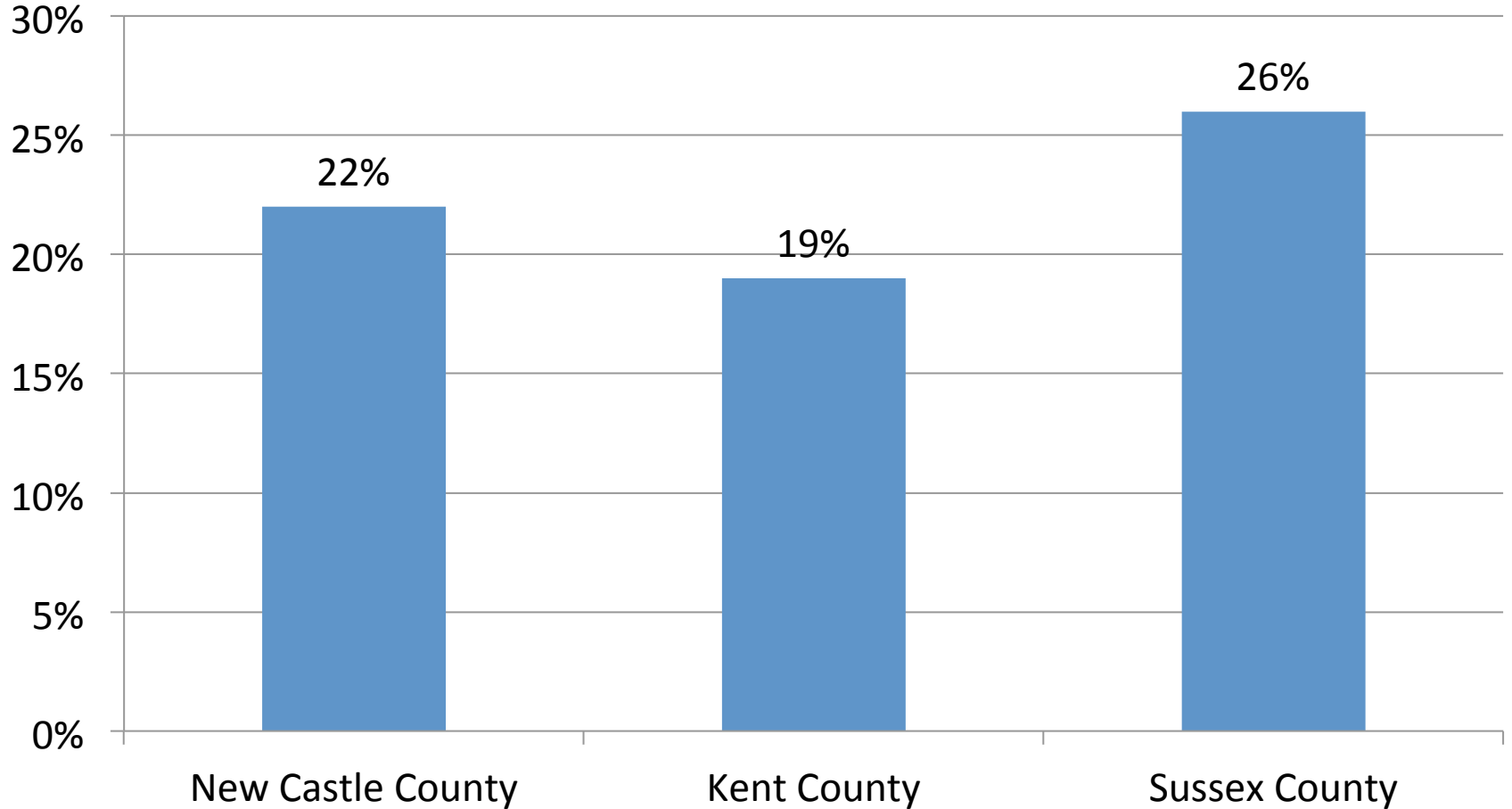


Delaware High School Students Self-Report Having Had Sexual Intercourse

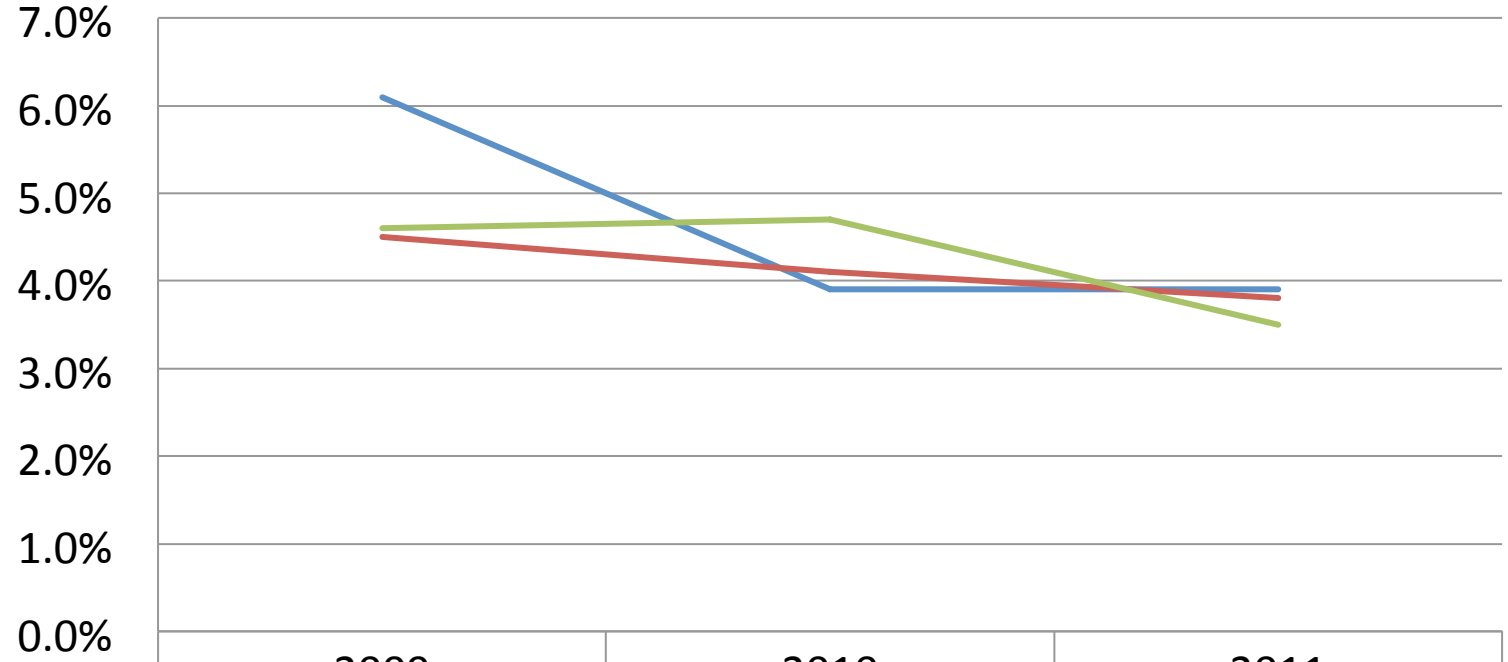

Delaware High School Dropout Rate by County (percentage of enrolled in 9th grade)

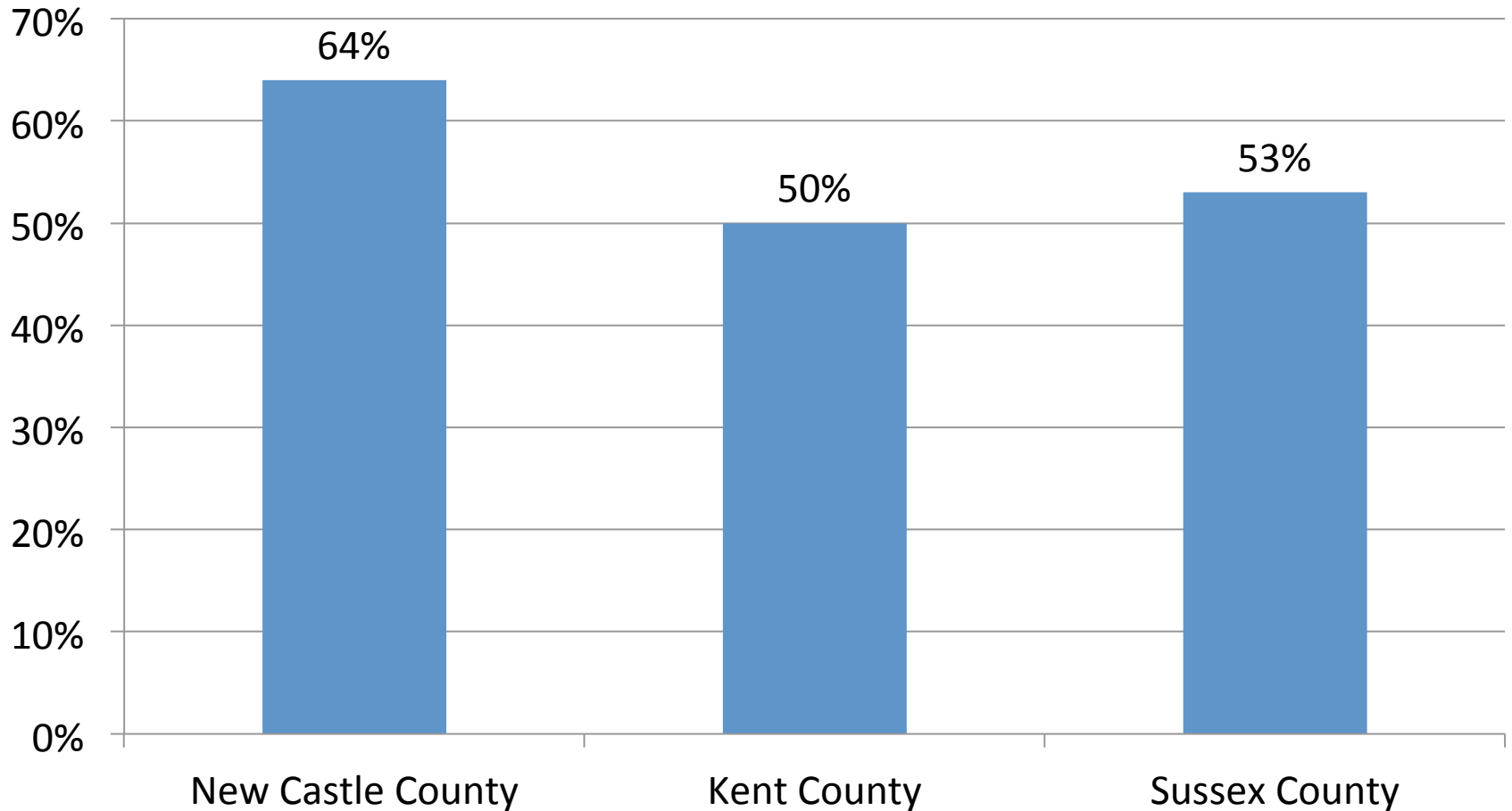

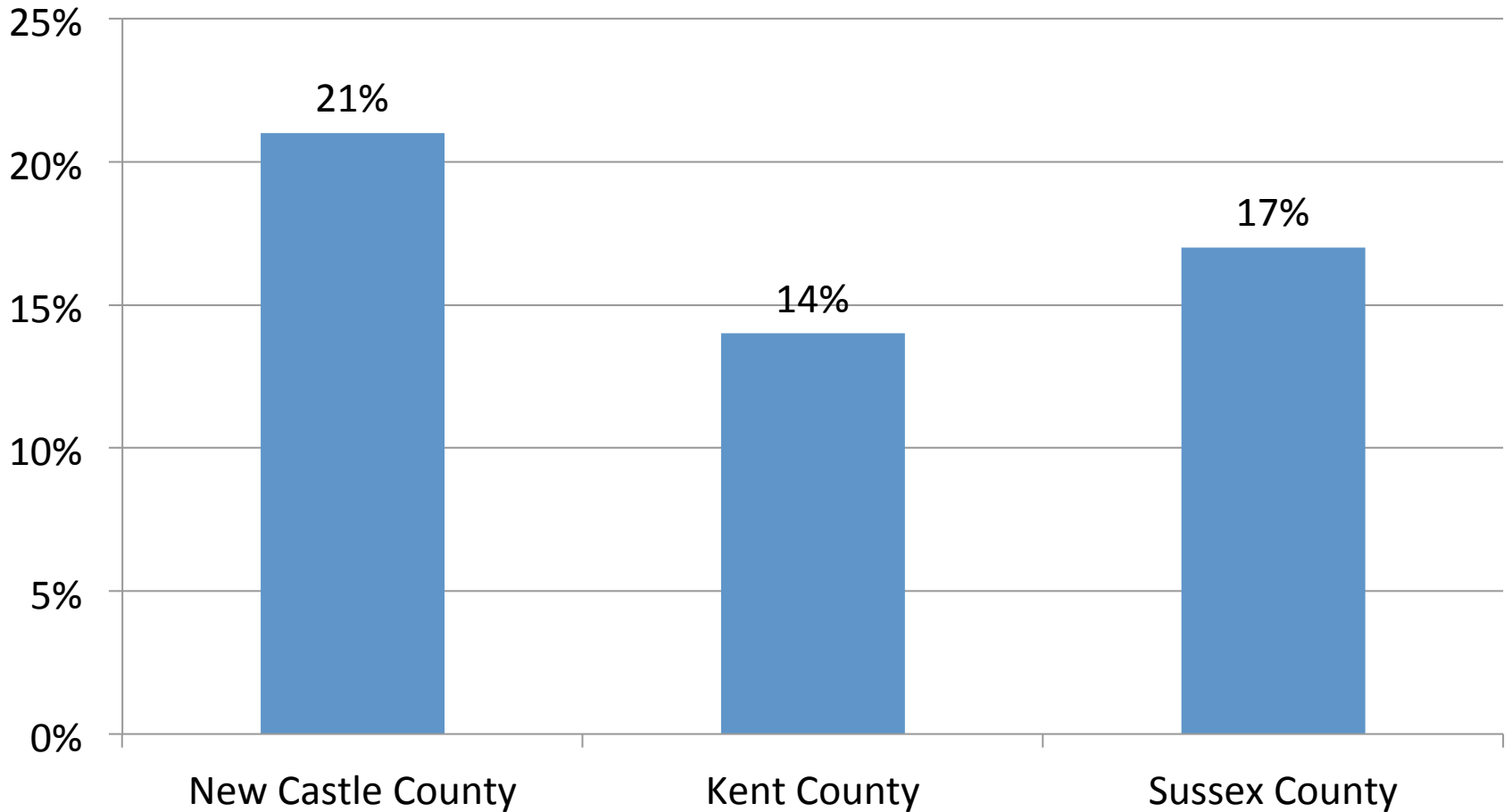

Delawareans Self-Reporting Having Drunk Alcohol in the Past 30 Days

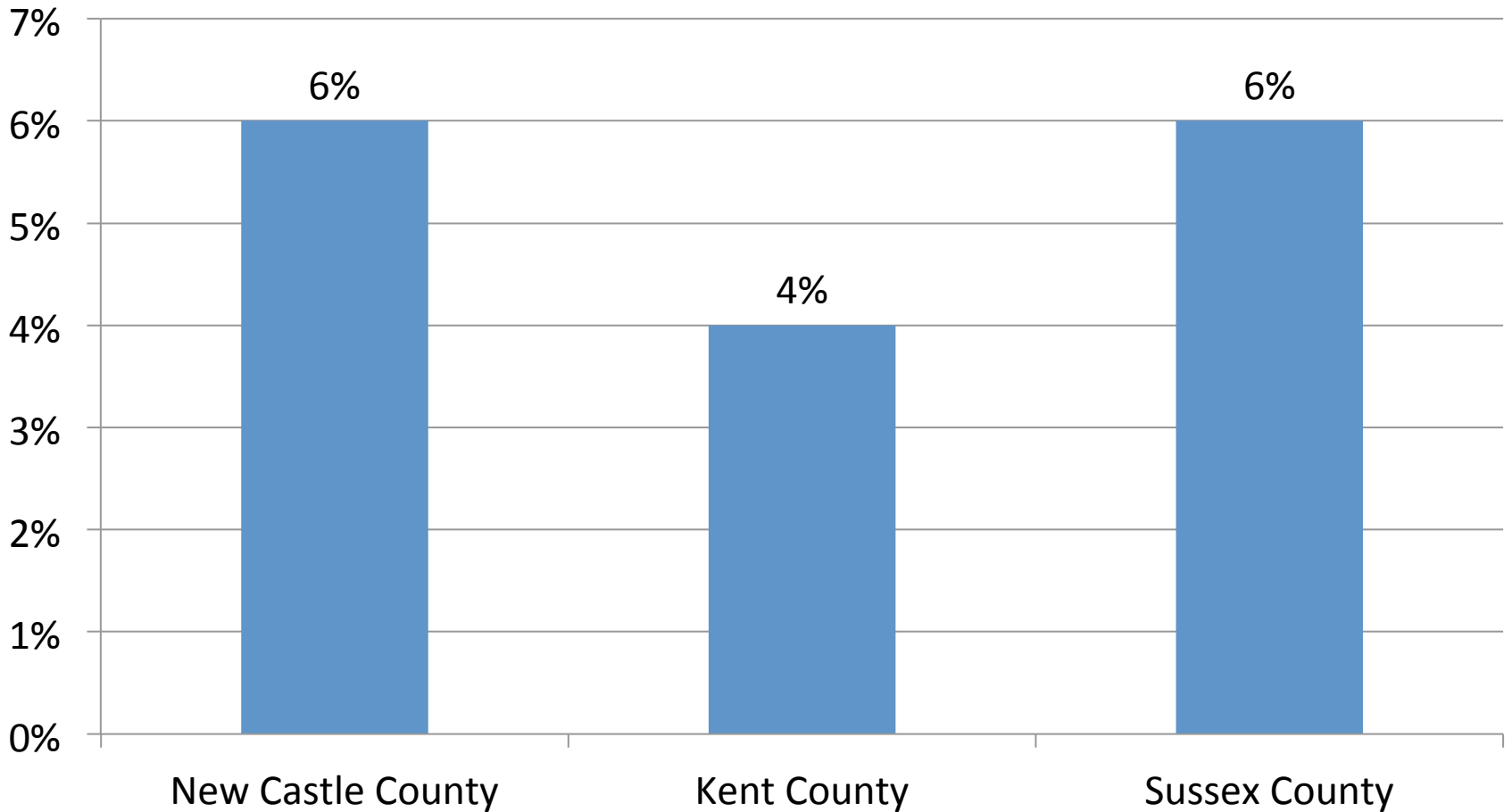


Delawareans Self-Reporting Binge Drinking



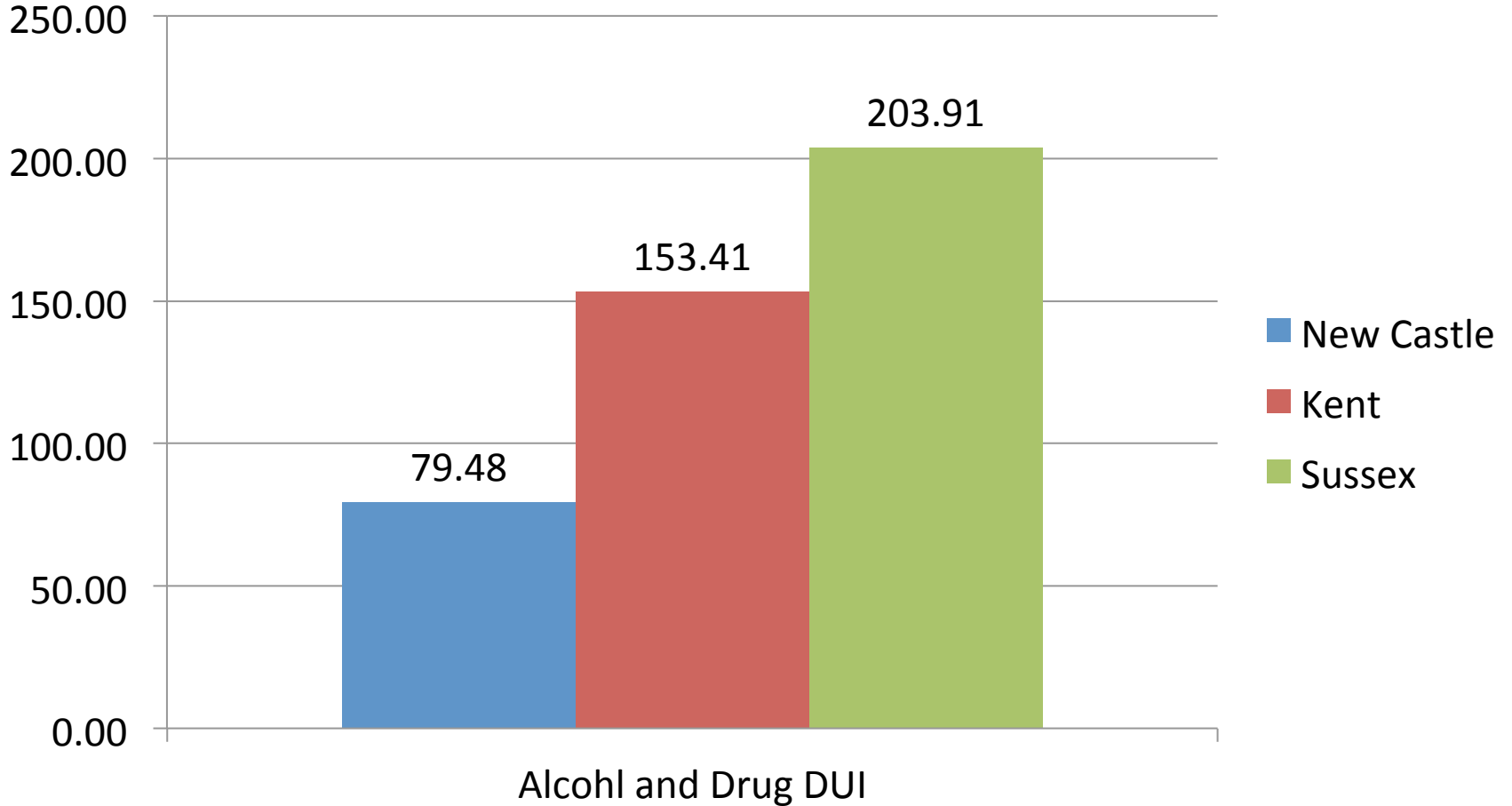

Delawareans Self-Reporting Heavy Drinking

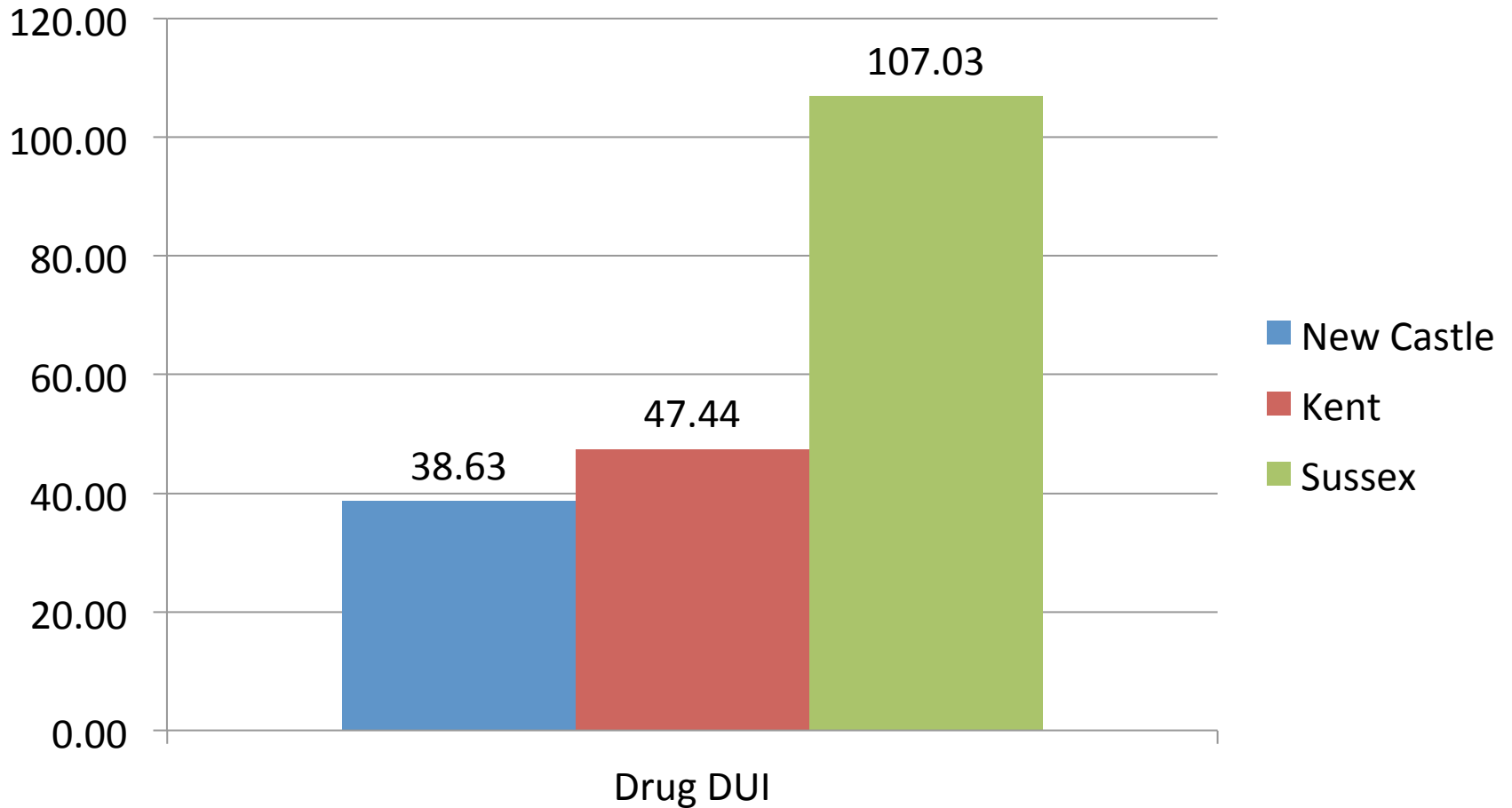

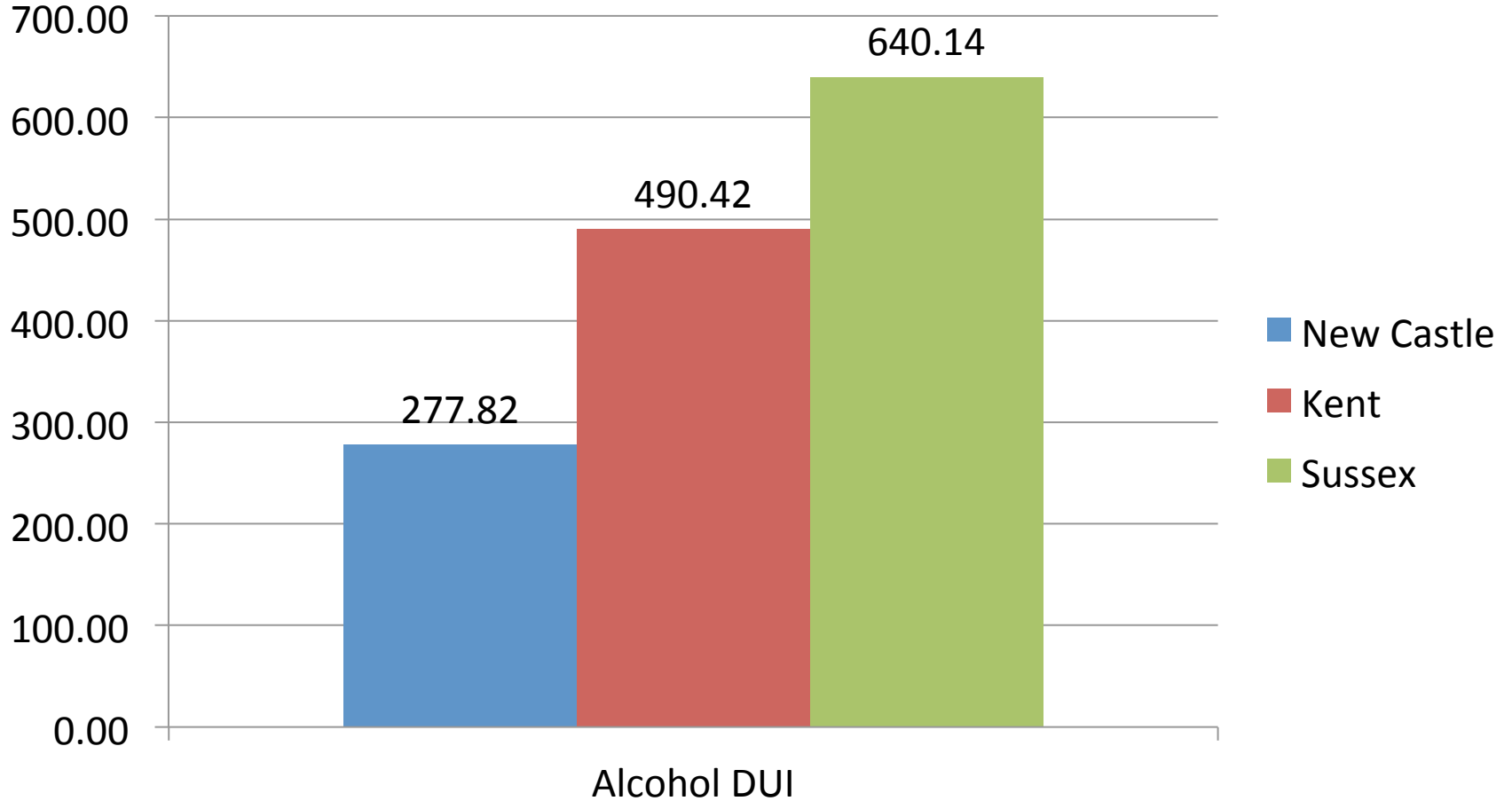
Alcohol and Drug DUI Arrests per 100,000 in Population



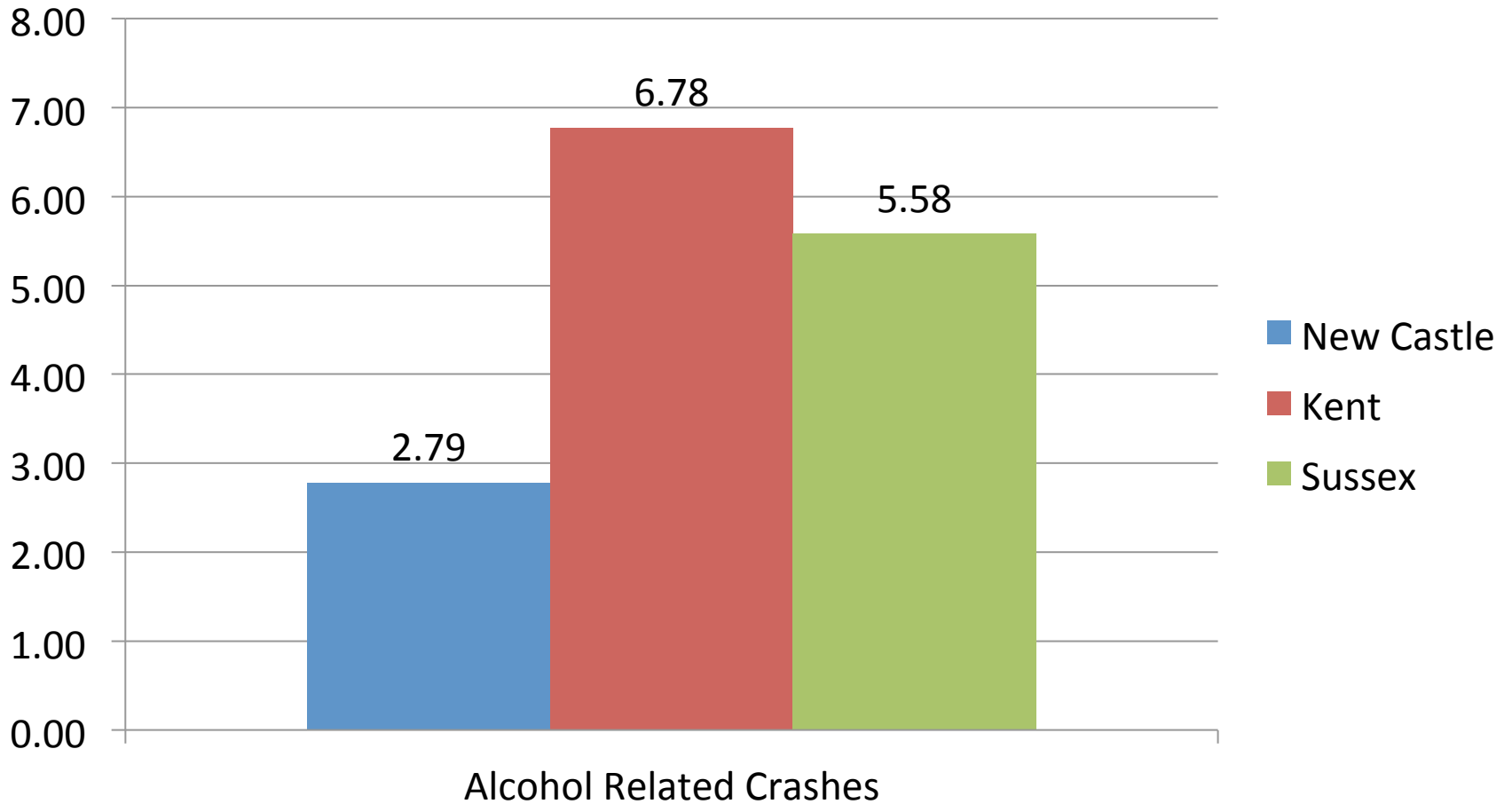
Drug DUI Arrests per 100,000 in Population



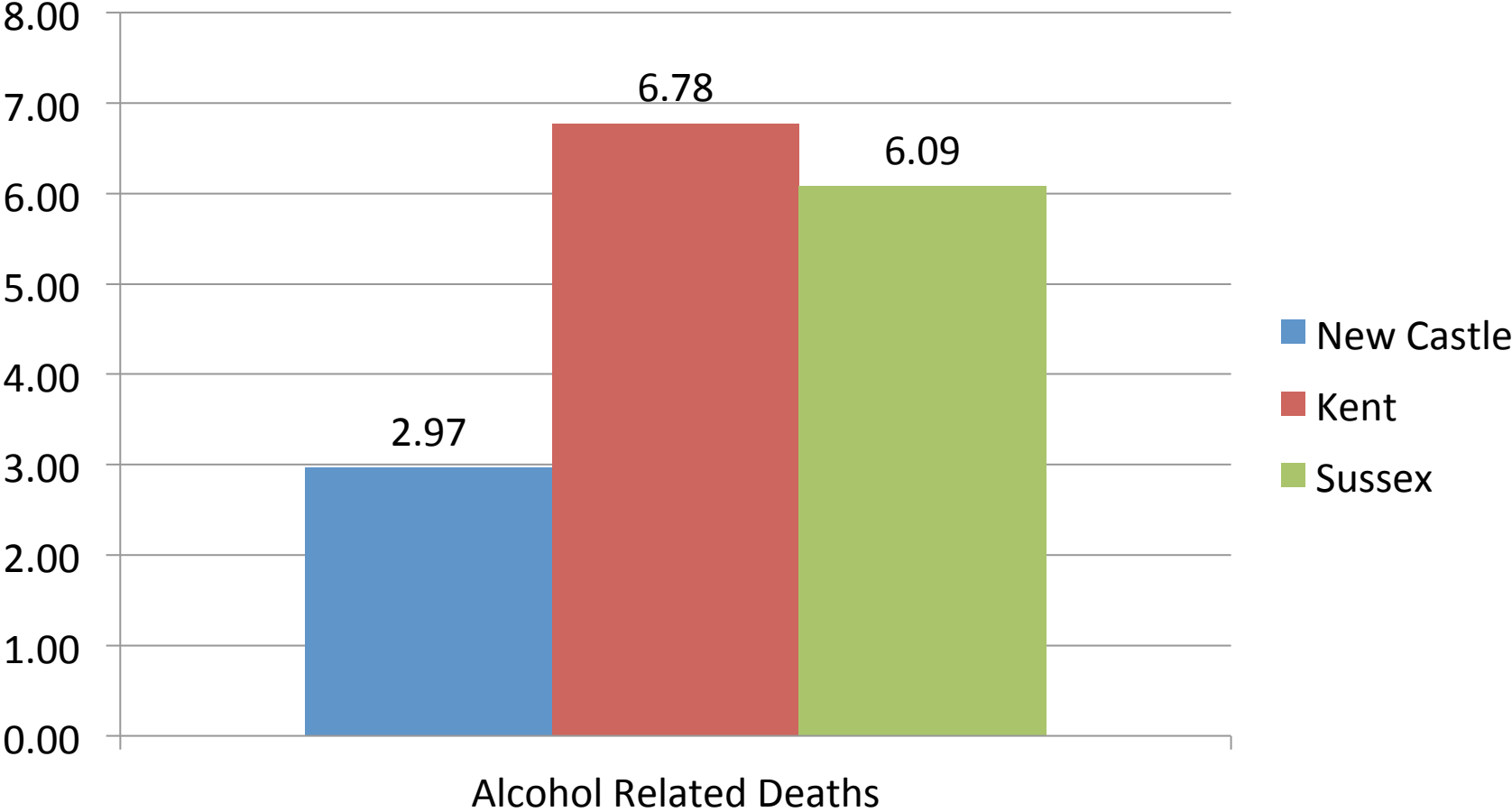
Alcohol DUI Arrests per 100,000 in Population



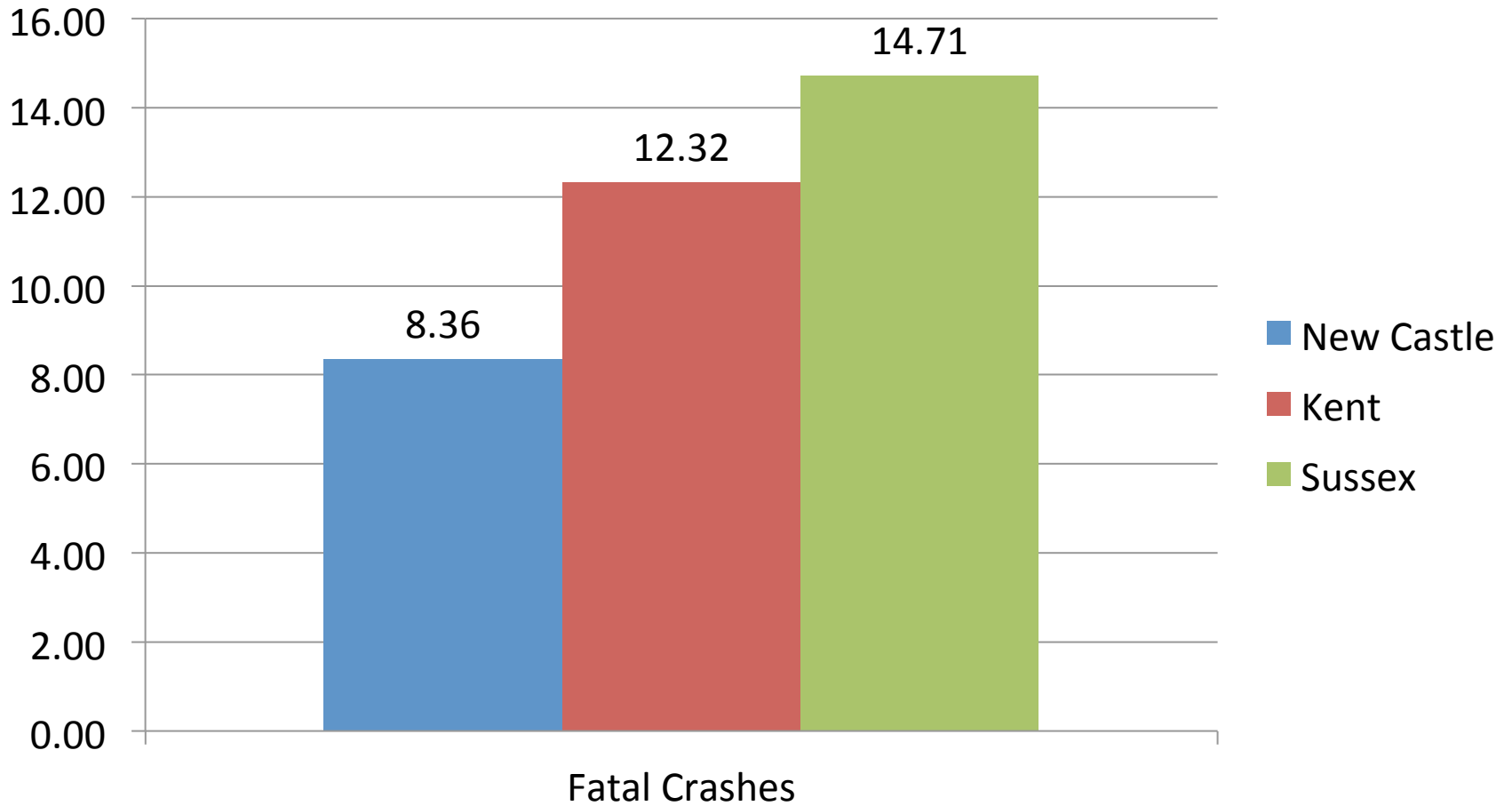
Alcohol-Involved Traffic Related Crashes per 100,000 in Population



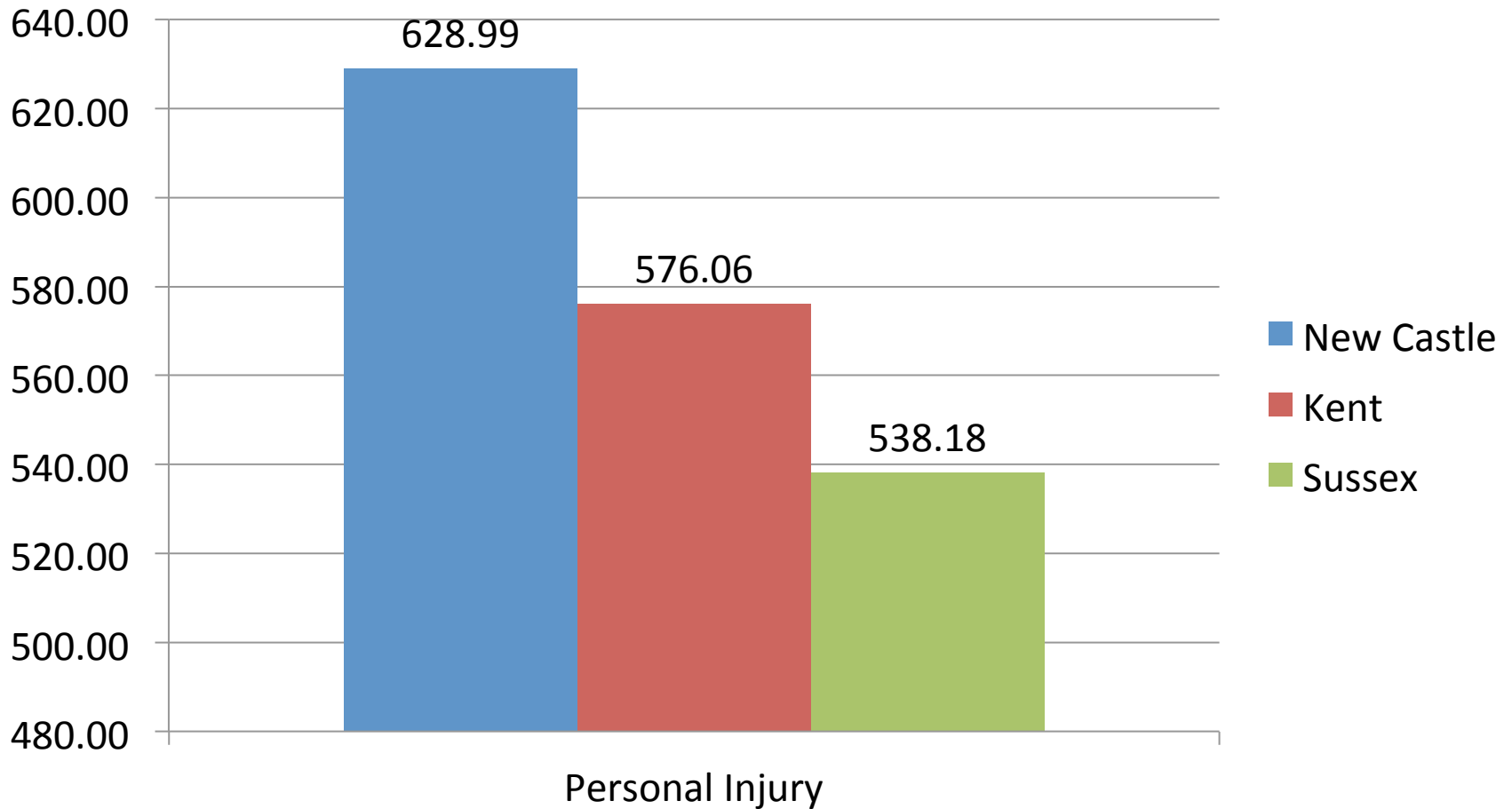
Alcohol-Involved Traffic Related Deaths per 100,000 in Population



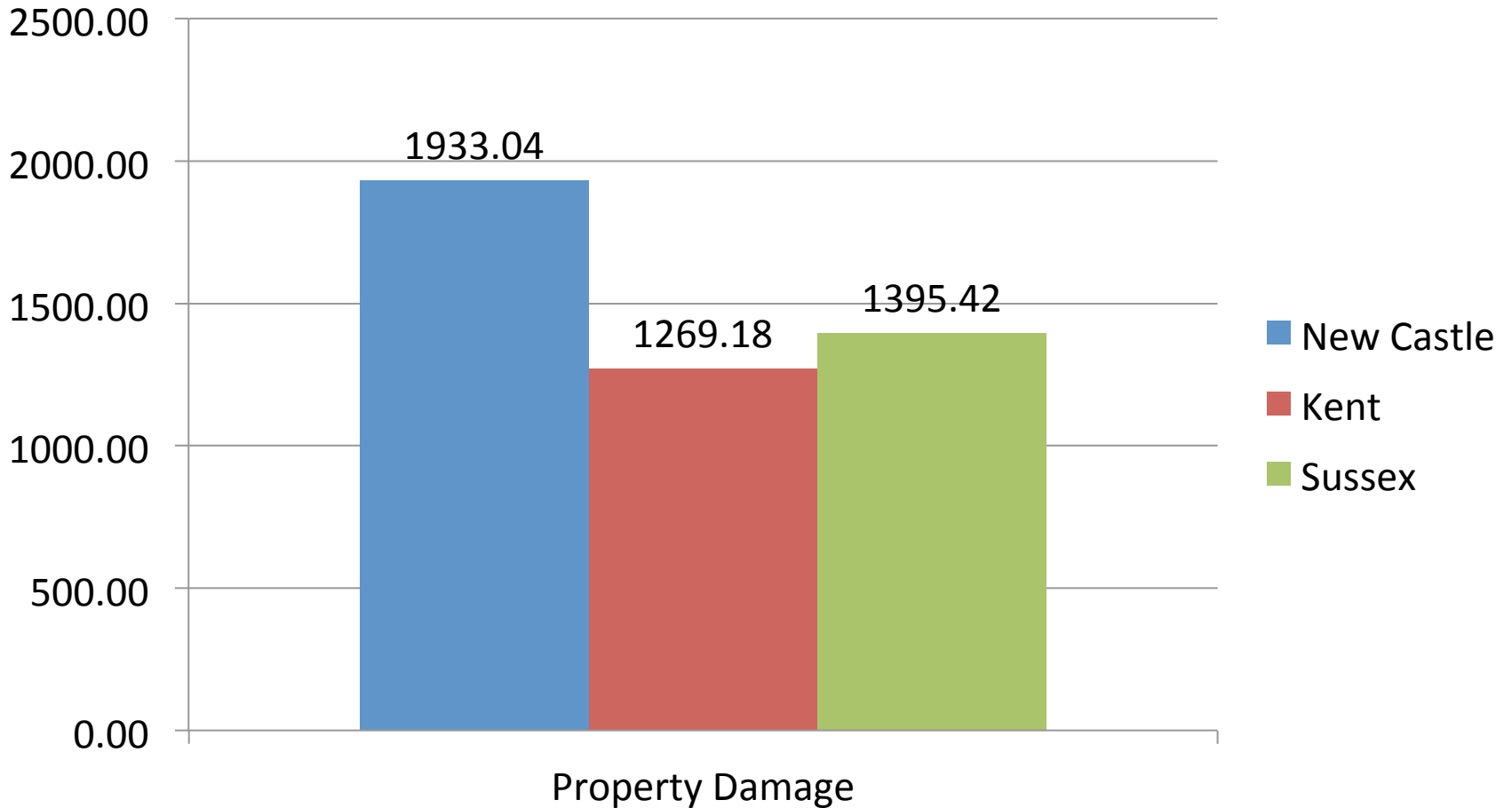
Fatal Traffic Related Crashes per 100,000 in Population



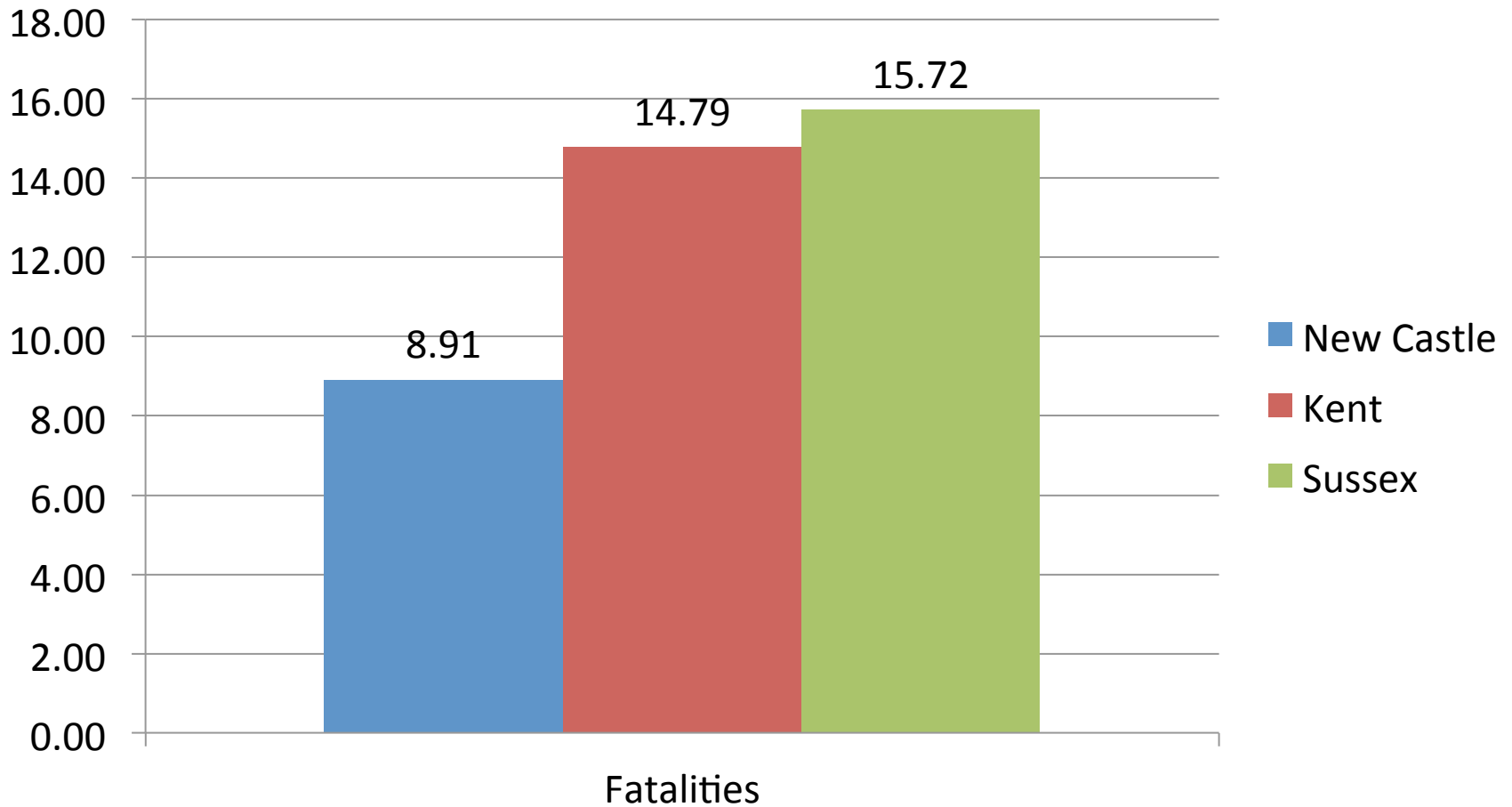
Traffic Related Personal Injury Crashes per 100,000 in Population



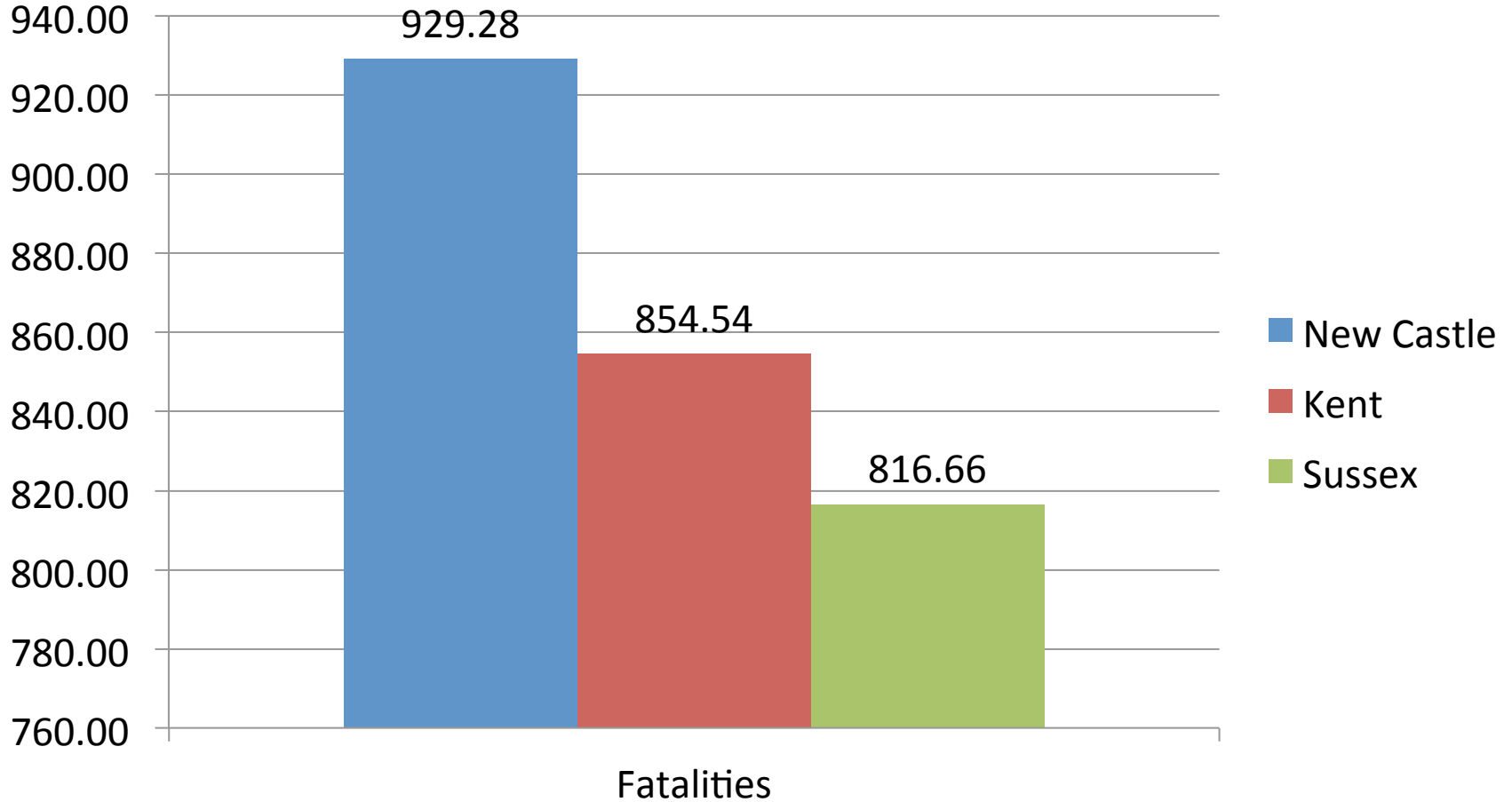
Traffic Related Property Damage Crashes per 100,000 in Population



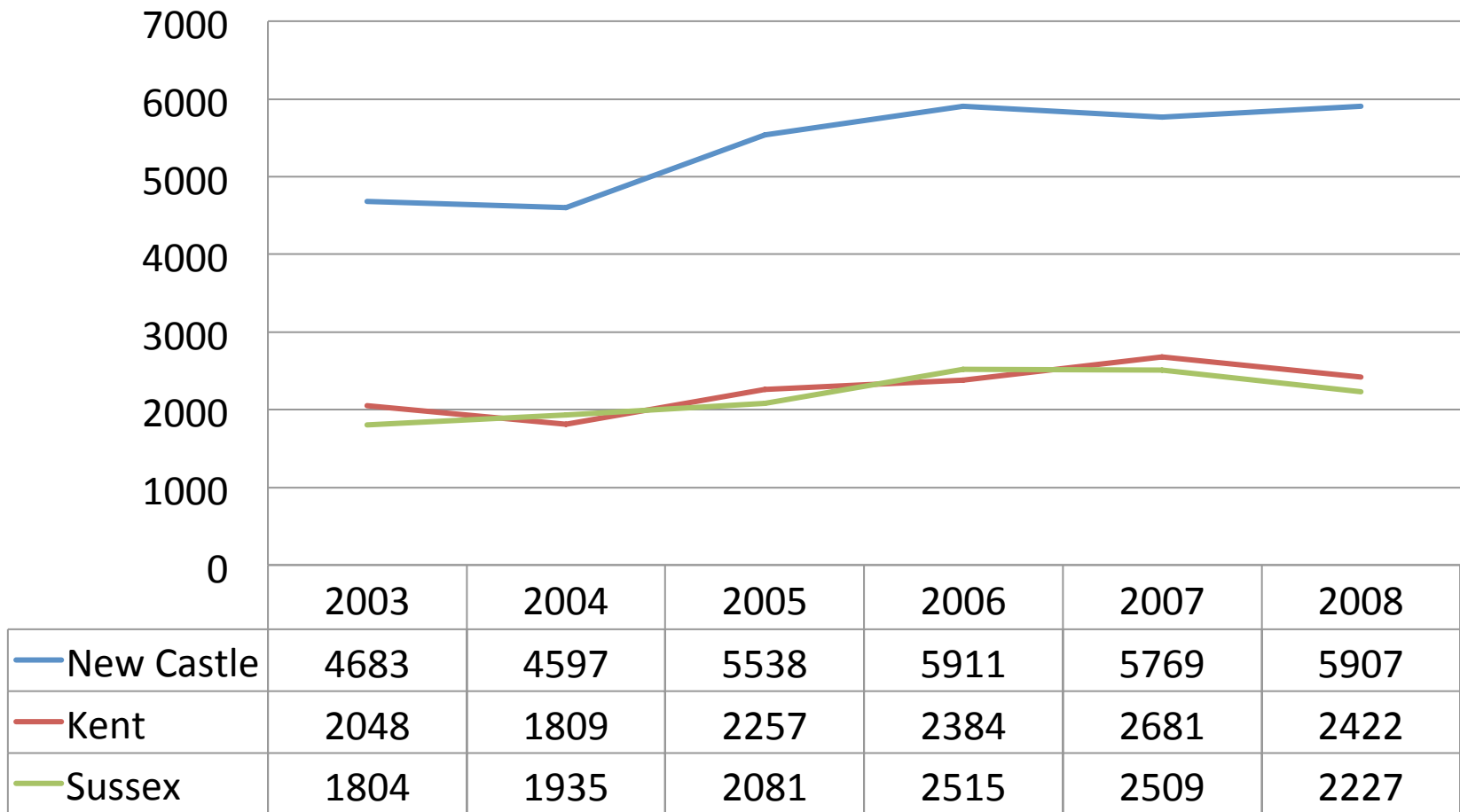
Traffic Related Fatalities per 100,000 in Population



Traffic Related Injuries per 100,000 in Population

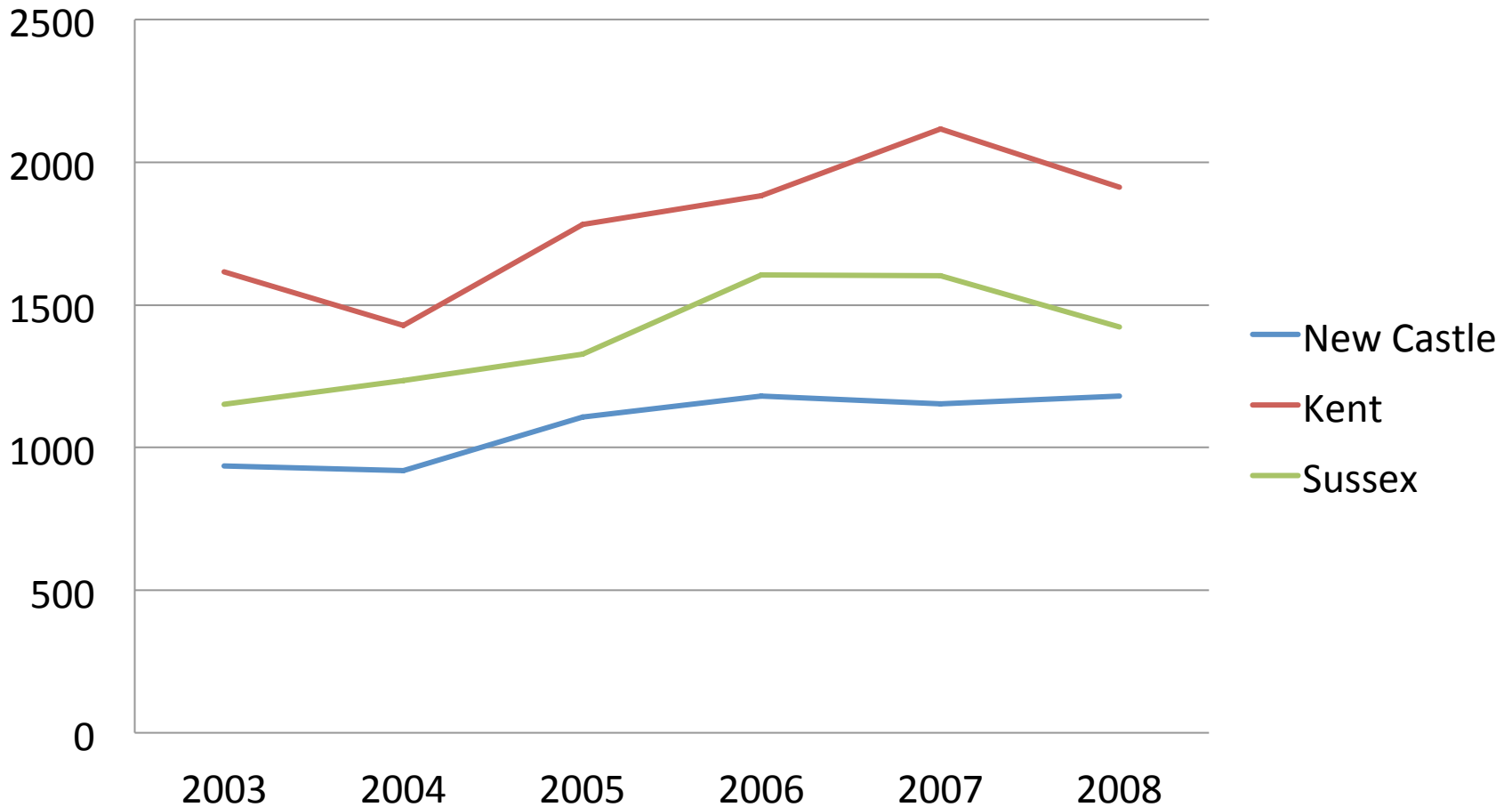


Number of Drug and Narcotic Offenses Received by Police by County



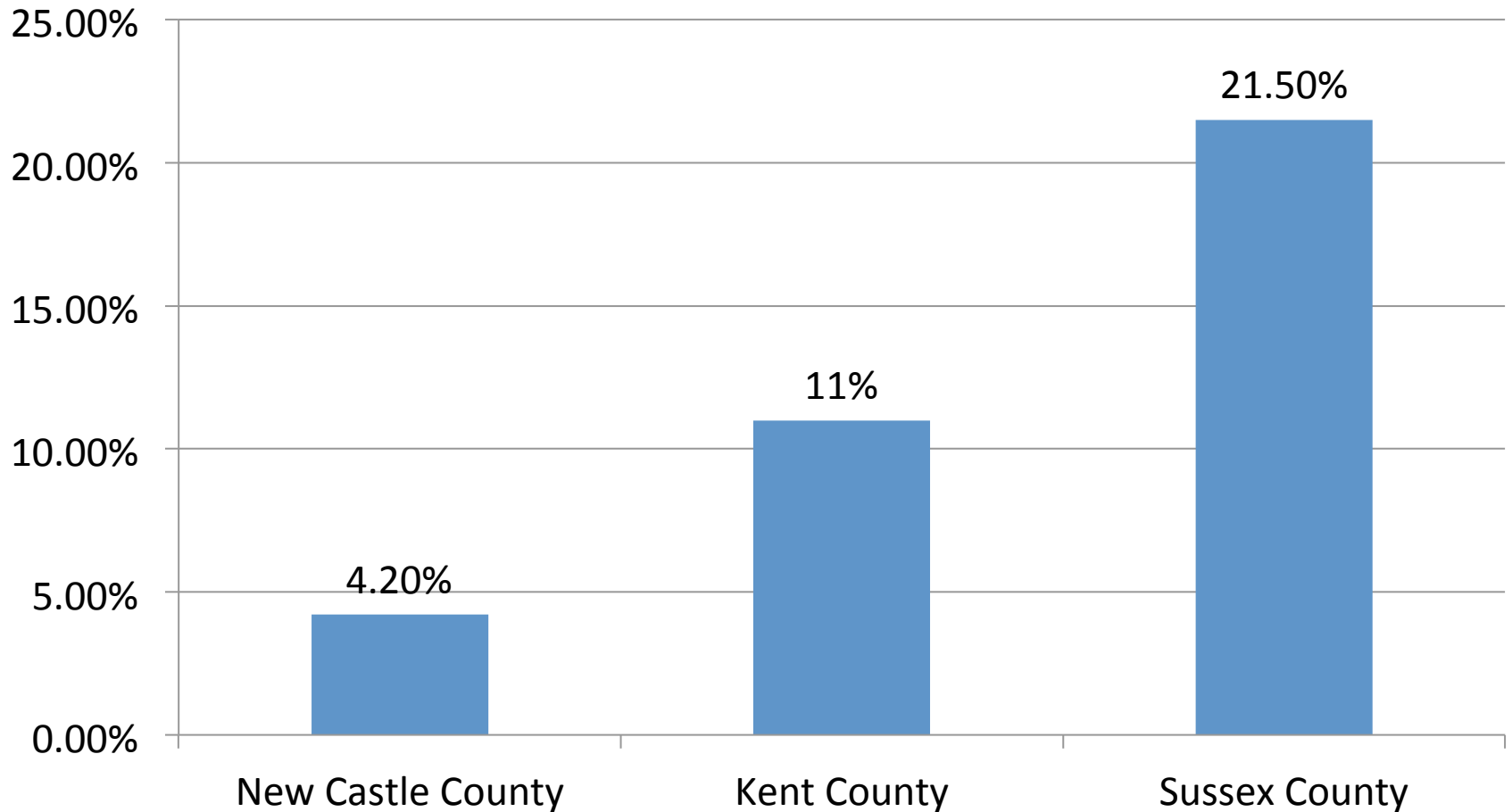

Drug and Narcotic Offenses per 100,000 People Received by Police by County



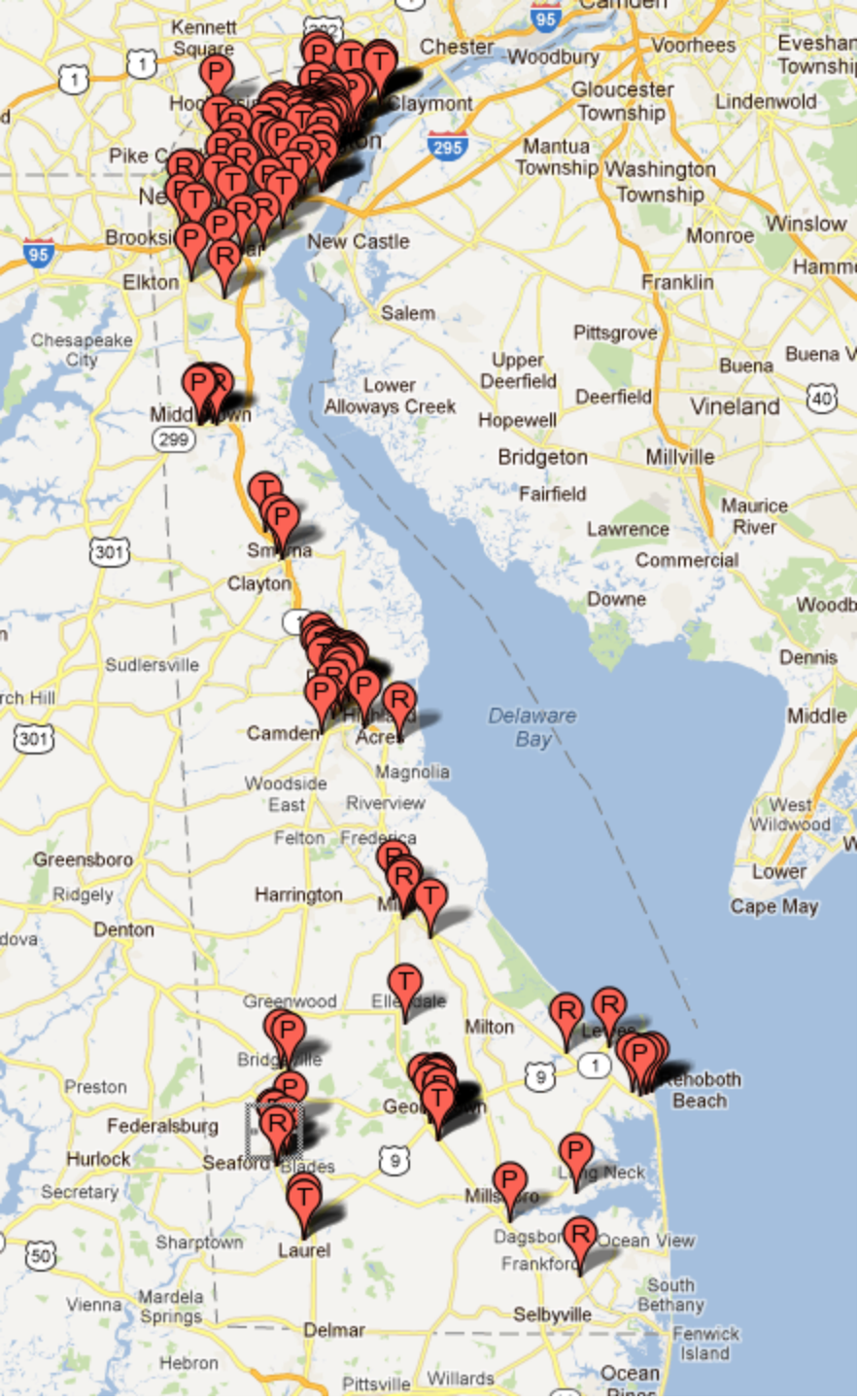
