What do Level Up Academics students do every day?

All students take 2 courses in the morning: a Leadership or STEM course* and academic writing skills course. These courses meet from 8:15 a.m. until approximately 12:10 p.m. each day (Monday to Friday). Every afternoon, students have structured cultural programs from approximately 1:30 to 3:30 p.m. that may include the following:

- American sports: baseball, basketball, football, skateboarding
- UD College tours
- Career planning
- Intro to photography
- Book club
- Ice-cream making

Students must place into Level 4, 5, or, 6 (i.e., intermediate-advanced levels) on the ELI English placement exam to enroll in Level Up Academics (This is approximately 5.0 or higher on the IELTS).. If students place into Level 1, 2, or 3, they can participate in the Language Adventure USA program.

Students also participate in a fun-filled schedule of activities and excursions.

We take advantage of Delaware's convenient location to offer bus trips to:

- New York City
- Washington, D.C.
- Delaware beaches

There are also many other local activities that students could do while in Delaware, such as:

- Nature hikes
- Picnics
- Pool parties
- Guitar club
- Paint parties (step-by-step painting instruction)
- Visits to local attractions
- Afternoon train ride to historic Philadelphia
- Shopping trips to the mall (Delaware has no sales tax!)

CLASSES:

*Leadership Class: Students learn about different leadership styles and engage in leadership projects with their classmates.

*STEM Class: Students take an introductory course in physics, biology, chemistry, and/or computer science.

English Writing Skills Class: Students learn research skills and how to write about the information they find.

UD Colleges Tour: Each week, students will get to tour a different college to see the facilities and hear about the majors available. Intro to American Sports: Each week, students will be taught the rules, learn idioms & terminology, and get to try playing a popular American sport: baseball, football, basketball, or skateboarding.

AFTERNOON ACTIVITIES:

* Optional Hub Programs: Book club, Intro to e-gaming, and tutors.

** ELI activities could include these structured/guided activities: Pool party, Movie-viewing party to prepare for a weekend cultural excursion, Picnic, Team building challenges, Ice-Cream Making, Trail hiking, Painting Party (step-by-step painting instruction), Guitar Club/American music, Intro to Photography, Downtown Photo Scavenger Hunt.

*** Activities around campus: Gym, weights, indoor track, pool, table tennis, badminton, basketball, volleyball, or the Hen Zone (UD Student Center which has billiards, video games, board games, table tennis, QuadAir Hockey).
