

APPLICATION

As the number of travel lanes increases, pedestrians feel more exposed and less safe crossing the street.



2 lane street
3 lane street
4 lane street

DESIGN RECOMMENDATIONS

- Safety Island should be at least 6 feet wide, and width of 8-10 feet.
- Should have a 'nose', which extends passed the intersection
- Should include curbs, bollards or other feature to protect people waiting
